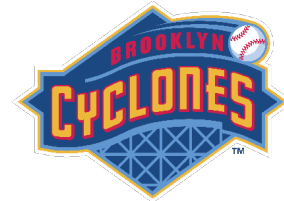

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Trailing 7-0 and 8-3, Brooklyn mustered a furious comeback to tie the game at 8-8 in the top of the ninth. However, Bowling Green 2B **Tanner Murray**, who made two throwing errors during the Cyclones rally in the ninth, hit the second pitch of the bottom of the ninth inning for a walk-off solo home run against RHP **Justin Courtney**, giving the Hot Rods a 9-8 victory. OF **Brandon McIlwain** led Brooklyn, going 4-4 with two runs scored, while INF **Jose Peroza** blasted his second home run of the season.

MAY FLOWERS: INF **Jose Peroza's** month of May has reflected the talent of the No. 29 prospect in the Mets system, according to *MLB Pipeline*. After an April in which the Venezuelan hit .155 with no extra base hits and three walks, Peroza is hitting .306 in May with seven walks, four doubles, and two home runs, including one home run in the series.

THE SUOZZINATOR: Brooklyn OF **Joe Suozzi** has been on another level since going through a development program in early May. Since returning to action on May 19, the Long Island native has hits in six of eight games, hitting .375. The former Boston College Eagle is 9-24 with two doubles, two home runs, four walks, and just three strikeouts. Prior to the stint on the development list, Suozzi was hitting just .111 over his first 13 games with a 42% strikeout rate and three walks prior to the break.

BOMBOSAS: Since last Sunday's doubleheader against Hudson Valley in New York, the Cyclones have completely turned around their power at the plate. Since last Sunday, the Cyclones have run into 13 home runs in seven games after just seven over the team's first 34 games. In the span, the Cyclones lead the South Atlantic League in homers.

PALM PILOT: OF **Jaylen Palmer**, the Mets No. 14 prospect, according to *MLB Pipeline*, has found his stroke in the month of May with a .826 OPS after a

vs. BOWLING GREEN: The Tampa Bay Rays affiliate currently leads the South Division of the South Atlantic League with a 26-17 record. Bowling Green has won six of the 11 games with the final game coming today. The Rays have four of their Top 30 prospects with the High-A club, including RHP Seth Johnson (8), OF Heriberto Hernandez (16), 1B Kyle Manzardo (26), and SS Osleivis Basabe (28).

.423 OPS in April. Palmer has hit four home runs in his past nine games and sits three shy of tying his career-high of seven home runs with Rookie-level Kingsport in 2019. At just 21 years old, Palmer is the youngest player on the team and the highest-rated Mets prospect.

FLY ME TO THE MOON: Brooklyn took its first-ever flight on Monday en route to Bowling Green, Ky. for the first-ever series at Bowling Green Ballpark, flying into Nashville and driving north. The Cyclones have also never played at Greensboro, Rome, Hickory, or Winston-Salem -- all new Brooklyn opponents since the shift to High-A in 2021. The Cyclones fly back to NYC on Monday before heading down to Jersey Shore next week to face the BlueClaws.

MUCHO POWER MENA: C **Jose Mena** is enjoying the best season of his career, hitting .293 with a .728 OPS. With 87 plate appearances already, Mena looks to smash his previous high for plate appearances in a season when he had 112 in 2017 as a member of the GCL Mets. Mena's wOBA sits at .347, while his wRC+ is 106.

ARM ASSISTANCE: RHP **Mike Vasil** and RHP **Carson Seymour** have joined the team in Bowling Green after earning their respective promotions from Low-A St. Lucie. Vasil, the No. 21 prospect in the Mets system, according to *MLB Pipeline*, was drafted out of Virginia in the 8th round last season, while Seymour was selected in the 6th round out of Kansas State last year.

THE HIGH-A DEBUT: Sunday in Bowling Green marks Vasil's Brooklyn Cyclones and High-A debut, earning the promotion on Monday ahead of the trip to Kentucky.

TOP 30: Vasil ranks as the No. 21 prospect in the Mets organization, according to MLB Pipeline, after his draft selection in 2021. The righty signed for \$181,200 after his 8th-round selection by New York (NL).

FLORIDA PHENOM: Vasil dominated his time in St. Lucie, pitching with the Low-A affiliate of the Mets. In eight starts with the Baby Mets, Vasil compiled a slim 1.80 ERA over 35.0 innings. Amongst qualified arms, Vasil departs the Florida State League with the lowest ERA (1.80) and a 2.29 FIP, marking the best metrics in the circuit at the time of his promotion.

TAMP DOWN: In his penultimate appearance with the St. Lucie Mets, Vasil struck out 11 Tampa Tarpons hitters over a career-high seven innings on May 17.

VASIL AT VIRGINIA: The 6-foot-5 Vasil pitched in the ACC with Virginia, making 34 career appearances and 32 starts. He posted a 4.74 ERA in 161 1/3 innings. In his 2021 season, his junior year on campus, Vasil made 16 starts which tied for second-most in the ACC, ranking fifth in strikeouts looking (33).

MASSACHUSETTS MIKE: The righty pitched at the University of Virginia after earning No. 1 overall player in the state of Massachusetts by Perfect Game in 2017. He was a First Team All-State pick by USA Today and the 2017 Massachusetts Player of the Year.
