### LAST GAME

The Bowie Baysox salvaged a split on Sunday afternoon with a 5-2 victory over the Altoona Curve. Coby Mayo had three RBI on the afternoon for Bowie, including a two-run, opposite-field home run to open the scoring in the bottom of the first. Right-hander Justin Armbruster would throw five strong frames of one-run baseball on the mound for the Baysox, only surrendering a solo home run to Mason Martin in the top of the fourth. Armbruster took the win on Sunday, improving his record to 2-1 on the season. Mayo notched his third RBI of the contest on a single in the fifth inning - the first of three consecutive two-out RBI hits for Bowie. Heston Kjerstad followed with a single to plate Mayo from second following a wild pitch. John Rhodes would drive in Kjerstad with a double into the left field corner, giving the Baysox a 5-1 edge. Bowie's bullpen held serve, as Carlos Tavera yielded just a single, unearned run in 2.2 innings. Right-hander Tyler Burch nabbed the final out of the eighth inning before right-hander Wandisson Charles pitched a 1-2-3 ninth for his second save of the season.

### TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Akron RubberDucks enter the week with a record of 19-19. Akron sits in a tie for third in the Eastern League Southwest division, but just a single game out of first place. The RubberDucks split their six-game series in Richmond last week and took four of six from the Baysox in Bowie last month. Both sides enter the series struggling defensively. Akron's 40 errors on the season are the second-most in the Eastern League. Only the Baysox (42) have more. Akron's roster is highlighted by six of the Guardians' Top 30 prospects, via MLB Pipeline. Positioned prospects include INF Angel Martinez (No. 9), OF Petey Halpin (No. 15) and INF Jose Tena (No. 21). On the mound, the RubberDucks' staff is led by right-handers Tanner Burns (No. 20) and Jack Leftwich (No. 30), along with southpaw Doug Nikhazy (No. 28).

### TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-hander Jack Leftwich is set to open the series for Akron. The No. 30 Guardians' prospect, per MLB Pipeline, Leftwich has had a rollercoaster month of May. The right-hander allowed a career-high eight earned runs on eight hits in 3.2 innings on Wednesday against Richmond, including two home runs. He also allowed four earned runs, while only recording two outs on 5/5 in a start against Portland. However, sandwiched in between was four innings of one-run baseball in relief on 5/11 in Altoona. In total, Leftwich has yielded 12 hits and four home runs in 8.1 innings in the month of May, after only surrendering six hits and zero home runs across the same amount of innings in April. Leftwich made his Double-A debut on 4/12 in Bowie against the Baysox, as he took a no-decision in the start after allowing two earned runs on four hits across three innings with a single strikeout. Originally a seventh-round selection for the Guardians out of the University of Florida in 2021, Leftwich features a mid-90s fastball, a low-80s slider with depth, and a low-80s changeup with fade.

### GETTING BACK TO WINNING WAYS

The Baysox are hoping to string together consecutive victories for the first time since the opening two games of the season. Bowie is the only team at the Double-A level yet to have a winning streak of at least three games this season. The Baysox are also the only team in the Eastern League to not win consecutive games at least three times in 2023 (Bowie has only done so once). Overall, the Baysox are 1-10, averaging just 2.9 runs per game, following a victory this season.

### HAIL CESAR

INF Cesar Prieto continues to pace the Eastern League with 55 hits and a .382 average - 64 points above the next highest qualified average (Heston Kjerstad - .318). Prieto is hitting .412 in the month of May with a .444 on-base percentage. He has collected hits in 16 of his 17 games this month, and has 17 multi-hit games in his first 36 contests of 2023. The No. 17 O's prospect also ranks third in the league in on-base percentage (.427) and fifth in OPS (.964).

### HESTON IS BESTON

OF/1B Heston Kjerstad has shown out as one of the top bats in the Eastern League so far this season. The Orioles' No. 5 prospect has demonstrated plenty offensive consistency - sitting second in the Eastern League in average (.318), along with third in slugging percentage (.621) and second in OPS (1.021) among qualifiers, while also ranking second in extra-base hits (19), fourth in hits (42) and third in total bases (82), and sitting tied for the league lead with three triples. Kjerstad is in the midst of a 24-game on-base streak - the longest streak in the Eastern League this season. His current nine-game hitting streak is the third-longest by a Baysox player this season (Prieto - 10 games, 11 games) Kjerstad has reached base safely in 33 of his first 34 Double-A contests.

### THE RHODE LESS TRAVELED

OF John Rhodes has continued to catch fire at the plate for Bowie in the month of May. Rhodes has reached in 11 consecutive games for the Baysox, with hits in nine of his last ten contests overall. The on-base stretch for Rhodes is the second-longest by a Baysox player this season. Since his return from the injured list, Rhodes is hitting .393 (11-for-28). Rhodes has also proved to be one of Bowie's most consistent run-proud-ers, with his 18 RBI ranking second on the Baysox (Heston Kjerstad - 19). While hitting .236 overall on the season, Rhodes is hitting .273 with runners in scoring position - the fourth-best average in such situations on the team.

CAREER NOTES

- Went 2-2 with a 6.94 ERA in 6 appearances (5 starts) for the Baysox last season.
- Had a sensational start to his time in the Orioles' system, winning the organization's Pitcher of the Month honors after 4-0 with a 2.57 ERA with 34 strikeouts to just 7 walks across 28 innings, between Aberdeen and Bowie
- Struggled in September, as he allowed 10 ER in 7.1 IP in the month, including allowing 4 in 1.2 innings against Akron in the season's final game on 9/18, in what would be a loss to eliminate the Baysox from postseason contention.
- Had a 4.08 ERA in 20 appearances (19 starts) for the Twins' organization across two seasons.
- Spent parts of two seasons with the Nebraska Cornhuskers, only full season was 2021, where he finished 6-1 with a 3.11 ERA in 81 innings.

NOTES BY OUTING

- 4/8 Allowed two early baserunners in the first with none out, but stranded both. Got two quick ground outs in the second inning, but allowed the next four batters to reach, including three hits, needing 28 pitches in the inning. Faced the minimum in the third.
- 4/15 Struck out five of the first eight batters faced. Allowed two baserunners in the third, only inning to allow multiple runners.
- 4/21 Allowed three runs in the first inning on two walks and two hits, needing 32 pitches for the frame. Two more runs in the third inning on a single, triple, and passed ball.
- 4/29 Front end of a doubleheader, struck out seven batters in his first trip through the order. Only hit allowed was a two-out double in the third. **Eastern League Pitcher of the Week**
- 5/5 Struck out three batters over first two innings, but allowed two runs in the third including a solo home run. Struck out four more batters, but back-to-back two-out base hits in the fifth forced his exit.
- 5/11 Struck out seven of first 11 batters faced. Faced one over the minimum through four innings, but allowed two singles to start the fifth inning before striking out the side. **Eastern League Pitcher of the Week**
- 5/17 Allowed each of the first three batters to reach base, and all to score on two sacrifice flies and a double. Allowed two more runners to move into scoring position, but none to third base.
