### LAST TIME OUT

The Pelicans grabbed their third win of the week with an 8-4 victory over the Fredericksburg Nationals on Saturday evening. **1B Fabian Pertuz** lifted two home runs with a three-run shot in the second and solo homer in the fourth. **CF Jacob Wetzel** also provided a solo homer in the seventh. For the first time this season, **RHP Juan Bello** lasted five innings to take the win with four earned runs allowed. **RHP Ty Johnson** closed out the final four frames by retiring all 12 batters he faced for his first save of the year. The Birds have a chance to win their first series of the season with a victory on Sunday.

### THE SILVER SEASON

The Pelicans will be celebrating their 25th season in 2024. After the departure of the Myrtle Beach Hurricanes in 1992, the Pelicans were established in 1999 following the relocation of the Durham Bulls to Myrtle Beach. During their 25 seasons, the Pelicans have won four Carolina League titles in 1999, 2000, 2015, and 2016. Myrtle Beach has been affiliated with three teams in their 25 seasons, including the Atlanta Braves (1999-2010), Texas Rangers (2011-2014), and the Chicago Cubs (2015-present).

### 2023 IN REVIEW

Last season saw the Pelicans make their second consecutive trip to the playoffs and the 13th in franchise history. After starting 17-19, the Pelicans went on to win 19 of their next 25 games to claim the Carolina League South Division first-half championship for the second straight year. The success continued in the second half as the Birds finished second in the South Division, setting up a rematch with the Charleston RiverDogs in the first round of the playoffs. Myrtle Beach dropped game one 2-1, but came back and won their first playoff game since 2016 with a 3-0 shutout in game two at home. The RiverDogs took the decisive game three 18-4 to advance to the Carolina League championship. The Birds topped the Carolina League in the regular season with a 75-55 overall record, leading the league in winning percentage for the first time since 2015.

### TOP BIRDS

Currently, the Pelicans roster features two of the Cubs' top 30 prospects by MLB Pipeline. Interestingly, both prospects are brothers as **INF Cristian Hernandez** and his younger brother **INF Alexis Hernandez** enter the season as the No. 18 and No. 19 Cubs prospects, respectively. 20-year-old Cristian led the Pelicans in games played last year with 106, hitting .223 with four home runs

while splitting time between shortstop and second base. 19-year-old Alexis hit .315 across 37 games in the Arizona Complex League last season while playing second, third, and shortstop. The 2024 Opening Day roster also features four 2023 draft picks with 12th-rounder **C Carter Trice**, 15th-rounder **RHP Ty Johnson**, 19th-rounder **RHP Nick Dean**, and 20th-rounder **INF Drew Bowser** all beginning the year with Myrtle Beach.

### BUDDY IS BACK

A familiar face will be leading the Pelicans in 2024 as **Buddy Bailey** returns to manage the club for his seventh year in Myrtle Beach. Bailey previously led the Pelicans from 2016-18 and 2021-23, and will be coaching his 18th season in the Cubs organization. During his Pelicans tenure, Bailey has recorded 444 wins, the most in franchise history. He has also guided the Birds to four half-season Southern Division Championship titles, one Southern Division Championship title, and the Carolina League Championship in 2016. In 2017, Bailey became just the 11th minor league manager to reach the 2,000-win plateau- he currently sits with 2,371. Bailey currently trails Mike Kelley (managed from 1901-1931) by 19 for third-place all time on the MiLB managers wins list. 2024 will be his 36th season as a minor league manager.

### PELICAN POINTS

The Pelicans returned home to Myrtle Beach for a two-week homestand following their 12-game road trip against Lynchburg and Salem. In their first series against Augusta, the Pelicans won three of the six games. The Nationals come to Myrtle Beach for the back end of the homestand after dropping four of their six games at Pelicans Ballpark last year. The Birds clinched the Carolina League first-half South Division championship in the series finale against Fredericksburg last year with an 8-2 win on June 18th.

Through the first 37 games, the Pelicans lead all of Minor League Baseball with 72 wild pitches

Pelicans' **INF/OF Reggie Preciado** ranks 6th in the Carolina League with 35 hits.

Pelicans' **OF Andy Garriola** is currently fourth in the Carolina League with 5 HR and 28 RBI. His 15 extra-base hits are tied for second in the league.

The Pelicans have won four Carolina League championships in team history, with the last one coming in 2016. The Birds have also won in 1999, 2000, and 2015.

- The Pelicans made back-to-back playoff appearances after winning the Carolina League South First-Half Championships in 2022 and 2023.
- This year's opening day roster features two of the Cubs top 30 prospects (Cristian and Alexis Hernandez)
- The Pelicans did not allow a single home run to Augusta in the last series 5/7-5/12
- The 23 strikeouts by the Pelicans pitching staff in the 12-inning game against Augusta on May 9th were the most strikeouts by a team in all of MiLB this season, the most by a Carolina League team since 2017, and the most for the Birds since they struck out 32 batters in a 23-inning game against Kinston in 2011
- Through the first 37 games, the Pelicans pitching staff leads all of MiLB with 72 wild pitches
- The Pelicans turned a triple play on May 7 against the Augusta GreenJackets
- Andy Garriola is currently fourth in the Carolina League with 5 HR and 28 RBI
- The Pelicans walked 17 batters on 4/17 setting a new single-game franchise high
- After collecting 8 walk-off wins in 2023, the Pelicans already have 3 in 2024
