Today: The Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play the third game in a 12-game, 13-day road trip at the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers, High-A affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers. These are the only meetings between the Nuts and Timber Rattlers this season. The Lugnuts, who won four of six games in Appleton last season, have split the first two games of this series.

Yesterday: Locos 7, Cascabeles 1. In a Copa de la Diversión matinee, first baseman Jack Winkler became the eighth player in Lansing Lugnuts franchise history to hit for the cycle, collecting an RBI double in the second inning, a single in the fourth inning, a two-run homer in the sixth inning and an RBI triple in the seventh inning. Of the four runs, Winkler drove in, one was himself (via roundtripper) and the other three were Junior Pérez, who went 3-for-5 with three doubles.

On the Air: Today's game is available on Bally Live and MiLB TV with Chris Mehring, and an audio-only broadcast via StreamGuys with Jesse Goldberg-Strassler and Adam Jaksa.

On Deck: The Lugnuts play the Timber Rattlers through Sunday, take a day off on June 26, and then continue this two-week road trip with a six-game series at Great Lakes. The next Lugnuts home game will be on the 4th of July against the Lake County Captains.

Lug•Notes

The Cycle: Jack Winkler's cycle last night was the first for Lansing since Ryan Gold achieved the feat vs. Dayton on April 18, 2019. The other cycles in team history: Corey Patterson (7/5/99 at South Bend); Donnie Hood (4/21/03 vs. Dayton); Chip Cannon (6/2/05 vs. Clinton); Travis Snider (7/7/07 at Fort Wayne); Brad Glenn (7/26/10 vs. Clinton); Edward Olivares (4/24/17 vs. South Bend).

Streaks: Winkler has now hit safely in his seven consecutive games, batting .481 (13-for-27) over that span to tie his season long hitting streak. Additionally, he has reached base in nine straight games. Outfielder Junior Perez also enters tonight on a nine-game hitting streak.

Brady's Bunch (of Innings): Southpaw Brady Basso tied a professional high with four innings worked yesterday, matching a four-inning stint from his first appearance of the season on May 4, 2021. Basso was shut down two months later, underwent Tommy John surgery, and waited 687 days to return to professional baseball earlier this season with the Lugnuts. He has not allowed more than one run in any of his eight appearances this season, with yesterday's scoreless outing lowering his ERA to 2.18 and his opponent batting average to .213.

The Butler Did It: Outfielder Jonny Butler smashed his team-leading eighth home run of the season in last night's win. Butler is slashing .254/.353/.576 in June with two doubles, one triple and five roundtrippers alongside five stolen bases. He is tied for tenth in the league in homers (8), second in triples (6), tied for ninth in the league in steals (16) and tenth in slugging percentage (.442).

Born to Run: The Nuts have stolen three bases in each of the first two games of this series, giving them 94 steals for the year, third most in the league. Lansing leads the MWL with 35 steals this month (swiped in 17 games).

Turn the Page: Today marks the final day of the first half of the Midwest League season. Each team's record will reset starting tomorrow. with the second half determining who will meet first half champions Great Lakes and Cedar Rapids in the first round of the postseason.

They Know Their Trade: Lansing has four players acquired by the Oakland Athletics via trade on its roster: Christian Fernandez (Tampa Bay Rays, 7/9/22, for Christian Bethancourt); Euribiel Ángeles (San Diego Padres, 4/3/22, for Sean Manaea); Junior Pérez (San Diego Padres, 6/30/20, for Jorge Mateo); and Alexander Campos (Seattle Mariners, 11/15/17, for Ryon Healy).

First-Round Pedigrees: The Lugnuts' roster boasts Oakland's last two first-round selections. Max Muncy was the 25th overall selection in the 2021 draft and entered the season ranked the A's No. 1 shortstop prospect by MLB Pipeline. Daniel Susac was taken 19th overall in 2022 and is the A's No. 2 catching prospect.

Big League Nuts: Five former Lansing Lugnuts have made their MLB debuts this season, bringing the total to 178 all-time. Four have debuted with Oakland: Ryan Noda, 3/30; Hogan Harris, 4/14; Mason Miller, 4/19; and Garrett Acton, 5/14. On June 18, Samad Taylor debuted for Kansas City with a walk-off RBI single.

History vs. Wisconsin

The Lugnuts are 83-60 all-time vs. the Timber Rattlers, 44-25 at home and 39-35 in Appleton. After not meeting in 2021, the Nuts won four of six at Wisconsin in 2022.

That series included the Midwest League debut for Mason Miller on August 28, allowing one run (a Ben Metzinger HR) in two innings. Miller made three appearances total for the Nuts last year; this year, he made his MLB debut on April 19. Unfortunately, he was placed on the Injured List on May 8 (UCL sprain).

Profile

Last Outing: In his Midwest League debut, June 15 vs. Peoria, tossed 1-2-3 first inning... gave up leadoff home run in the second inning to Jimmy Crooks... pitched perfect third and fourth innings... departed after allowing two one-out singles and a walk in the fifth... reliever Kumar Nambiar allowed one inherited runner to score, giving Peoria a 2-1 lead... Lugnuts went on to rally for 4-3 victory over the Chiefs.


Rave Reviews: Dicochea was promoted from Single-A Stockton to Lansing on June 13 to replace Jack Perkins, who was transferred up to Double-A Midland... coincidentally, an article about Dicochea had just been written by MLB.com A's beat writer Martín Gallegos a day earlier, quoting A's GM David Forst in including Dicochea's name among the top pitching prospects in the system (Royber Salinas, Gunnar Hoglund, J.T. Ginn and Joey Estes). Wrote Gallegos about Dicochea, "Dicochea, an eighth-round selection by the A's in the 2019 MLB Draft out of Sahuarita (Ariz.) High School, ranks just outside Oakland's Top 30 Prospects list. But his inclusion in that group from Forst speaks volumes about how highly he is viewed. In nine games (seven starts) for Single-A Stockton this season, Dicochea holds a 3.20 ERA with 47 strikeouts against 17 walks in 39 1/3 innings. He has held opposing batters to a .163 average, which ranks lowest among all California League pitchers with at least 30 innings pitched. Dicochea's development hit a snag early in his pro career after he underwent Tommy John surgery in 2021. Since his return from injury, the 22-year-old right-hander is taking a big step forward this season, showing off a fastball that consistently hits 95 mph along with a solid slider and a changeup he's recently added to his mix. A's assistant general manager and director of player personnel Billy Owens added, "He's off to a promising start. Averaging well over a strikeout per inning. Overall, his command has taken a step forward. He's definitely an interesting arm on the horizon."

Home Cooking: Also from Tucson: Alex Verdugo, four-time All-Star Ian Kinsler, two-time All-Star J.J. Hardy, Cardinals All-Star catcher Tom Pagnozzi and Ron Hassey... in all, Tucson ranks second behind Phoenix in producing Major Leaguers from the Grand Canyon State.

Glory Days: Boasting a 96 mph fastball, Dicochea was highly regarded coming out of Sahuarita High School, ranked the No. 1 prep prospect in Arizona by Baseball America entering the 2019 draft... twirled a no-hitter in the state semifinals... signed for \$400,000... signing scout: Scott Cousins... signed away from commitment to University of Arizona... senior year stats: 1.30 ERA, 54 IP, 24 H, 10 ER, 11 BB, 86 K... in addition to pitching, also starred at shortstop.

Minor League Path: Dicochea opened his professional career in the 2019 Arizona League after signing, but his 2021 campaign was halted in Single-A Stockton due to injury on June 6 after only six appearances, five starts... returned from Tommy John surgery on August 12, 2022, and made two appearances in the Arizona Complex League before returning to Stockton on August 26, 2022... finished the year with three appearances for the Ports.

Bagels in April: Opened 2023 as the Ports' No. 4 starter, firing four scoreless innings at Fresno on April 11... that was the start of three consecutive scoreless outings to begin the year, finishing April with 13 2/3 scoreless innings... didn't allow first run until May 3 vs. Fresno, entering in relief in the fifth inning and allowing two runs in the fifth and two more in the seventh in a 5-4 Ports win... in total with Stockton, posted a 2.42 ERA with a .132 average against in five road starts (22 1/3 IP) compared to 4.24 ERA, .200 avg. in four home appearances (17 IP)... lefties hit .111/.243/.175 compared to righties' .205/.279/.308... base stealers went 2-for-2.


