NOTES AND NUGGETS

GOOD TIMES, BAD TIMES

2026 has been a roller coaster ride for Omaha, with up and down stretches.

- Of 12 series played this season, Omaha has won 5, lost 6 and split 2 ... the Storm Chasers have a 6-4 record over their last 10 games, with a chance to win a series today, for the first time since taking 4 of 6 from May 19 to 24 @ St. Paul
- Omaha had a winning April, with a 13-12 record on the month ... with a 13-14 record in May, the Storm Chasers were one win away from having a winning record in back-to-back months for the first time since July and August 2024.

COMEBACK KIDS

The Chasers have 21 comeback wins and have blown a lead in 23 losses this year.

- 21 comeback wins are tied for the 5th-most in the International League, tied 8th in Triple-A ... 23 blown leads are tied for the 3rd-most in the league, tied 5th in Triple-A.
- The Storm Chasers have led at some point in 11 of their last 18 losses, including 3 games where the team led for over half the game.
- In the last 44 games (since May 9), Omaha is 21-23 ... the Chasers have trailed at some point in 14 of 21 wins and led at some point in 13 of 23 losses, meaning 27 of Omaha's last 44 games have been a comeback win for one of the teams ... in this stretch, 31 of 44 games have been decided by 3 runs or less ... Omaha's 16 losses by 1 run are the 2nd-most in the International League.

SUMMER SWINGING

The Storm Chasers come to the end of June with one of the hottest offenses in the International League.

- Omaha's 94 extra-base hits in June lead all Triple-A clubs and are tied for the 3rd-most in the Minors ... a .289 team batting average this month ranks 4th in Triple-A and .490 slugging percentage ranks 3rd and a .941 OPS is 5th ... 141 runs scored by the Storm Chasers in June are the 5th-most in the league.
- Omaha has scored 6+ runs in 13 of 23 games in June, tied for the most in the International League (tied with Rochester & St. Paul) ... additionally the Storm Chasers have 12 double-digit hit games this month the 2nd-most such games in the IL (1st: Charlotte, 13).

JUNE BUGS

Individually, there have been many key offensive contributors in the month of June.

- Since rejoining Omaha June 18, **Brandon Drury** has reached base in all 8 games, batting .400 (12-for-30) with 4 doubles, 2 homers and 8 RBI for a 1.204 OPS.
- Abraham Toro** has hits in 17 of his 21 games in June, batting .341 (28-for-82) with 5 doubles, 3 triples, 6 homers and 22 RBI for a 1.081 OPS ... his 57 total bases this month rank 4th-most in the International League, while tied 4th in RBI.
- Matthew Lugo** was acquired by the Royals on June 2 and in his first 20 games with Omaha, has hit .321 (25-for-78) with 7 doubles, 7 homers and 21 RBI for a 1.036 OPS ... his 53 total bases this month rank 5th-most in the IL.
- Peyton Wilson** has hits in 16 of his 20 games this month, batting .333 (28-for-84) in June with 11 doubles, 10 RBI and 7 walks for an .849 OPS.

HONEST ABE

Abraham Toro started the season slow, but has been one of the International League's best hitters since mid-May

- Since May 12, Toro has a .336 average (42-for-125) ... he ranks 2nd in the IL in OPS (1.028), 3rd in SLG (.624) and tied 3rd in AVG ... his 33 RBI over 34 games since May 12 are tied 5th-most in the league.
- From March 27 to May 10, Toro hit .189 (21-for-111) with a .650 OPS and hits in 16 of 33 games ... since May 12, Toro has hits in 26 of 34 games, with 4+ hits in 3 games.

CROSS ME UP

Gavin Cross had one of the league's slowest start to the season, but has heated up with the weather as the season has gone on.

- Over his first 36 games (March 27 to May 15), Cross hit just .128 (15-for-117) with 3 XBH and 6 RBI, with 1 multi-hit game ... but in his last 33 games (since May 16), he's hitting .297 (33-for-111), with 8 XBH and 12 RBI, with 10 multi-hit games.

- ✓ Bailey Falter is making his **3rd start with the Storm Chasers** this year, his **13th appearance with Omaha** and his **18th overall appearance** in 2026.
- ✓ Playing his **12th professional season** this year, the Royals are his 3rd MLB organization ... has played parts of 6 Major League seasons with Philadelphia (2021-23), Pittsburgh (2023-25) and Kansas City (2025-26).
- ✓ Falter will be making his 4th start against the Clippers but 8th appearance against the Guardians or an affiliate ... he's faced Cleveland once in the Major Leagues and had 2 rehab starts in Columbus last year.

THE FALTER FILES

- ✓ **GETTING BACK ON TRACK:** Falter made the Royals' Opening Day roster and pitched in 2 games before he landed on Kansas City's injured list (*left elbow inflammation*) ... he appeared in 9 games with Omaha on a rehab assignment, but pitched to a 14.21 ERA (10 ER in 6.1 IP) in 3 games after returning to Kansas City and was subsequently designated for assignment and sent outright to the Minors.
- ✓ **TRIPLE-A TALENT:** Falter pitched in 9 games for the Storm Chasers while on a rehab assignment from April 15 to May 14 ... he struggled in his first game, but in the next 8 (April 19 to May 14), he worked a 1.46 ERA (2 ER in 12.1 IP) and ended his rehab stint with three straight scoreless appearances.
