TODAY'S GAME: The M-Braves conclude a sixgame home series against the Biloxi Shuckers at Trustmark Park, This is the third of five series between the two clubs who will meet a total of 27 times (15 at Trustmark Park, 12 at MGM

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The M-Braves took at three-games-to-two series lead with a walk off home run by Landon Stephens to win it 4-3.

Five pitchers combined to allow one earned run. Down 3-0, Tyler Tolve and Cade Bunnell hit back-to-back homers in the seventh to spark the comeback. The game started at 8:04 pm due to a 1:59 rain delay.

TURNING THE SHIP AROUND: Since May 9, the M-Braves are 18-10. In the last four series, the M-Braves have two wins, including a five-game sweep of Chattanooga, and two splits. After starting the season at 3-10 on an eight-game losing streak, the M-Braves are 24-18.

The M-Braves scored 68 runs in nine games from May 27 to June 7, ranking 2nd in Double-A over that span.

THIS TEAM KNOWS HOW TO PITCH: The M-Braves pitching has been one of the best in minor league baseball this season, pitching their sixth shutout on Saturday night.

The M-Braves lead the Southern League in pitching, are 2nd in Double-A, and 8th in MiLB with a 3.60 ERA. M-Braves starters are 6th in Double-A with a 3.89 ERA.

The M-Braves finished May with the fourth best ERA in MiLB at 2.99

PROSPECTING: 6 of Atlanta's Top 30 MLB Pipeline prospects are on the active roster: RHP Victor Vodnik (11), INF Cal Conley (13), OF Jesse Franklin V (14), RHP Alan Rangel (26), C Tyler Tolve (29) and LHP Luis De Avila (30).

<u>"KISS IT GOODBYE", EVEN AT THIS BALLPARK:</u> The M-Braves have 57 homers - 36 on the road. 12 different players have at least one homer with Drew Lugbauer leading the way with 12 homers, ranking 1st in the Southern League.

The M-Braves have nine home runs at Trustmark Park this week, M-Braves opponents have just eight home runs at Trustmark Park this season, including two by Biloxi on Tuesday.

MUÑOZ GETS THE CALL: The Atlanta Braves recalled RHP Roddery Muñoz, the M-Braves Opening Day starter, on Tuesday. When Muñoz makes his MLB debut, he will become the fifth M-Braves alum to debut this season, joining RHP AJ Smith-Shawver (6/3), INF Braden Shewmake (5/5), LHP Dylan Dodd (4/4), and LHP Jared Shuster (4/2). 165 M-Braves alum have debuted in the MLB since 2005.

ROLLIN' ROBLES: LHP Domingo Robles is one of the best pitchers in the Southern League to this point, ranking top ten in ERA (3.42, 5th), wins (4, T-3rd), and WHIP (1.16, 4th).

VIVA LA VALDES: Javier Valdes posted a teambest 19-game on-base streak from April 23-June 1. Over the streak, Valdes hit .361 with five homers, five doubles, nine RBI, 16 walks, and a 1.189 OPS

"JESSE FRANKLIN V": Jesse Franklin V just lost a team-best, 10-game hit streak (5/24-6/9). The outfielder is slashing .300/.396/.500 with a homer, five doubles, five walks, and six RBI over the streak.

**DEAN OF THE CLASS:** Justin Dean was promoted back to Triple-A Gwinnett on Friday while on an 11-game on-base streak. He caught fire in Birmingham, batting .417 (10-for-24) with eight walks, six runs, and a .563 OBP in six games.

BIG BAD BARGER: The 25-year-old reliever allowed a run for the first time on May 20 in his 12th relief appearance. He has four saves (T-2nd, SL). Barger started the season with 15 shutout innings, with 19 strikeouts to seven walks, in 11 appearances. He currently has a 2.74 ERA in 22 innings.

ALL HAIL KING SLUGBAUER: 1B Drew Lugbauer homered in three straight games from May 23-25, becoming the sixth M-Brave to do so. bauer achieved the feat from July 25-28, 2021.

The first baseman ranks among the league leaders in home runs (12, 1st), RBI (38, 3rd), SLG (.591, 1st), OPS (.974, 1st), and XBH (24, T-3rd).

Lugbauer recorded his first career M-Braves triple on May 13 against the Lookouts, then another on May 16 at Montgomery. He made his profesional pitching debut on May 17 at Montgomery tossing 2/3 scoreless innings with a strikeout of Logan Driscoll on an 87 mph fastball. On May 23, Lugbauer cranked a 117-mileper-hour home run, which ranked 5th among MLB players for hardest hit balls at the time.

The M-Braves all-time and single-season home run leader, slugged his 50th career M-Braves home run on April 30 at Biloxi. Lugbauer has a club record 58 home runs over parts of three seasons, blowing past the previous record of 32 (Travis Demeritte/Connor Lien). He hit 18 home runs in 2021 and led the Southern League and Braves minor league system with 28 homers in 2022. On September 9, 2022, he surpassed Ernesto Mejia's (2011) and Mike Hessman's (2001) single-season M-Braves franchise record

WINNIN' WITH WILCOX: RHP Kyle Wilcox picked up his first save on Tuesday. He has yet to allow a run in 11.1 innings over nine relief appearances with the M-Braves, including two walks to 20 strikeouts.

The right-hander was on Triple-A Gwinnett's roster from April 18-May 23, recording a 4.32 ERA in 12.1 innings.

### TODAY'S GAME

Robles will appear in his 12th game of the season and 10th for the M-Brayes. This will be his third career start against Biloxi. Robles is one of the best pitchers in the Southern League to this point, ranking top ten in ERA (3.42, 5th), wins (4, T-3rd), and WHIP (1.16, 4th).

#### LAST TIME OUT

Robles gave up seven runs over 4.2 innings on Tuesday against Biloxi. The lefthander threw a season-high 93 pitches.

- Appeared in Atlanta's spring training, picked up a save in one relief appearance, tossing a scoreless inning.
- Broke camp with Mississippi, but was transferred to Gwinnett before the M-Braves' season began, on April 4.
- Made two starts for Triple-A Gwinnett in April, going 0-2 with eight earned runs in 7.2
- Tossed 7.0 innings of shutout relief, coming into the game after a long rain delay on May 5 at Pensacola. Robles posted the longest shutout relief appearance in club history. The left-hander gave up just three hits and a walk with seven strikeouts.
- Logged a career-high 11 strikeouts on May 13 vs. Chattanooga, 6.0 IP, 4 H, 0 ER, 2
- In May, went 2-2 with a 2.20 ERA in 28.2 innings over five games, four starts. Robles posted two quality starts. His 28.2 innings in May ranked 2nd in the league.
