**LAST TIME OUT:** The Cyclones snapped a brief two-game slide on Thursday night with a 4-3 win over the BlueClaws... Brooklyn scored all 4 of their runs in the top of the 5th...LF **Omar De Los Santos** provided an RBI double and scored on an error to tie it at 2...1B **Joe Suozzi** collected a go-ahead run-scoring single and DH **Kevin Parada** added an RBI two-base hit...LF **Jared Carr** garnered a 2-run homer to right for Jersey Shore in the 4th...RHP **Wilkin Ramos** posted 3-shut-out innings of relief to earn his 2nd win...RHP **Manny Rodriguez** recorded the final 3 outs to pick up his first career save.

**WASHED OUT:** The Cyclones endured their 3rd postponement of the 2023 season and their 2nd consecutive day washed away on Saturday afternoon due to rain...It was the first time Brooklyn had back-to-back days postponed since May 12 and 13 of last year vs. Wilmington...It is the first time it has happened on the road since May 6 and 7, 2022, at Aberdeen.

**IF THERE'S A WIL-KIN, THERE'S A WAY:** RHP **Wilkin Ramos** has been a force for Brooklyn out of the bullpen in 2023... The 22-year-old enters Saturday's matchup with a 10-inning scoreless streak dating back to April 13 at Winston-Salem... During the 4-game stretch, Ramos has permitted only 2 hits and walked 3 batters...The right-hander has whiffed 15 batters in that span (13.50 K/9)...Over his last 2 appearances, Ramos has punched out 11 batters in 6.0 innings (16.50 K/9)... The Dominican native is 5th in the South Atlantic League (min. 10.0 IP) in strikeout rate (39.0%).

**ALEX ALWAYS ON:** OF **Alex Ramírez** extended his team season-long hitting streak to 12 on Thursday...The stretch is tied with Greenville's **Blaze Jordan** for the longest active streak in the SAL...The 20-year-old is 17-for-his-last-49 (.347) with 6 runs scored, 2 doubles, a home run, 10 RBI, 5 walks, and 4 stolen bases...Ramírez enters Sunday's matches tied for 5th in the SAL in hits (20)...Since the start of last season, Ramírez leads all Mets' minor leaguers in batting average (.283) and is tied with teammate OF **Stanley Consuegra** for the lead in triples (7).

**THUNDERBOLT:** The Cyclones stole a season-high 6 bases on Wednesday afternoon at Jersey Shore...That was the most for Brooklyn since they stole 6 bags at Hudson Valley on April 20, 2022...3B **Jaylen Palmer** and DH/RF **Joe Suozzi** swiped bases in both contests...Coming into Sunday, OF **Omar De Los Santos** is tied for 2nd in the South Atlantic League with 10 and Palmer is tied for 5th with 9...More importantly, both are a combined 19-for-20 on attempts...The 'Clones are 4th in the league with 34 team stolen bases, but is 2nd in success rate (.895)...Only Hudson Valley (.912) has been more successful.

**SUPER STANLEY:** OF **Stanley Consuegra** blasted his 4th home run of the year on Tuesday night...Consuegra enters Sunday's games on a 12-game on-base streak dated back to April 12...Since then, the right-handed swinger is slashing .326/.404/.696 with a stellar 1.100 OPS...Consuegra has 8 extra-base hits, 4 home runs, 13 RBI, and 5 walks in that span... He is tied for 5th in the league in extra-base hits (9), tied for 8th in homers (4), 9th in slugging percentage (.565), tied for 9th in total bases (35), and tied for 10th in RBI (13).

**vs. JERSEY SHORE:** Brooklyn hits the road for a 6-game set against the Phillies' High-A affiliate...The BlueClaws claim 2 of Philadelphia's top 30 prospects per *Baseball America*...INF **Hao Yu Lee** comes in at No. 6, while RHP **Tommy McCollum** is deemed the 29th-best farmhand...The Cyclones captured 2-of-3 from Jersey Shore at Maimonides Park from April 7-9...Brooklyn dominated the 2022 season series, winning 22-of-27 meetings...The Cyclones went 12-3 in 15 games at ShoreTown Ballpark last season.

**WELCOME BACK, WILLIAM:** INF **William Lugo** made his season debut on Tuesday night at Jersey Shore...The 21-year-old is 2-for-6 with a double, walk, 2 runs scored, and a stolen base in 2 games...Lugo joined the Cyclones from Single-A St. Lucie on April 8 last year and slashed .267/.347/.484 with a .795 OPS in 28 regular season games...He added 4 home runs and 18 RBI...The Baní, D.R. native added another solo home run in the postseason...Lugo is ranked as the Mets' No. 27 prospect by *Baseball America* and No. 26 by MLB Pipeline...He joined the squad from extended spring training on Monday.

**GO DJ:** LHP **Daniel Juárez** has been as dominant as can be out of the bullpen for the Cyclones in 2023...In his first 6 outings of the campaign, the southpaw holds a 1-0 record with 1 save...He has not permitted a run on 3 hits and a walk, striking out 11...In 11 regular season appearances with the 'Clones dating back to last season, Juárez has yielded only 1 unearned run in 10.1 innings...The 22-year-old has not surrendered an earned run in 19 straight appearances dating back to last year...Juárez last allowed earned runs on June 22, 2022, with Single-A St. Lucie at Palm Beach...Since then, he is 3-0 with 8 hits allowed, 10 walks, and 26 strikeouts in 20.2 innings.

**ATOP THE WONDER WHEEL:** Prior to Opening Day, *Baseball America* ranked the Brooklyn Cyclones as having the fourth most-talented roster in all of Minor League Baseball...The 'Clones are the highest rated non-Triple-A squad, falling just behind the Norfolk Tides (1), Durham Bulls (2), and Columbus Clippers (3)...Brooklyn is the lone South Atlantic League team and A-level club to be recognized within the Top 10.

**MEET THE 'NEW' BOSS:** Chris Newell takes over as the manager of the Brooklyn Cyclones in 2023 after serving as the team's bench coach in 2022...Newell served as skipper of the Birmingham-Bloomfield Beavers of the United Shore Professional Baseball League from 2016-19...The 49-year-old won consecutive championships (2017-18) and was named Manager of the Year three times (2016-18).

**PROSPECTS:** Brooklyn hosts 3 of the Mets Top 10 prospects, according to *MLB Pipeline* and *Baseball America* and 4 of the Top 30...They include C **Kevin Parada** (No. 3 *MLB Pipeline*/No. 4 *Baseball America*), OF **Alex Ramírez** (4/5), and RHP **Blade Tidwell** (7/9)...INF **William Lugo** (27/26) also appears on both lists...OF **Stanley Consuegra** ranks as the organization's No. 21 farmhand per *MLB Pipeline*.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Did not receive a decision on Friday night vs. Wilmington...Permitted 2 runs on 5 hits over a career-high 5.2 innings...Walked 2 and struck out 6...Induced a double play and threw a wild pitch...Hurled 77 pitches (49 strikes)...Relieved by RHP **Joshua Cornielly** with the bases empty and 2 out in the top of the 6th and Brooklyn behind, 2-0...Cyclones tied the game in the 9th on a DH **Joe Suozzi** single...Blue Rocks went on to win in 10 innings, 4-2.

**2022:** Signed with New York for \$220,000...Assigned to the Florida Complex League Mets on August 11...Tossed 1.0 scoreless inning at FCL Astros Blue before joining Single-A St. Lucie on August 16...Yielded 4 runs on 4 hits, striking out 6, in 2.2 innings over 2 appearances (1 start)...Placed on the 7-day injured list for the remainder of the season on August 30.

**SOARING EAGLE:** Stuart was selected by the Mets in the 8th round of the 2022 draft out of the University of Southern Mississippi...Was a 4th-year sophomore at Southern Miss in 2022 after redshirting as a true freshman and missing his sophomore campaign due to the COVID-19 pandemic...Accumulated a 4-0 record with a 3.38 ERA (15 ER in 40.0 IP) and 1 save in 22 outings (4 starts)...Whiffed 38 and walked 13.

**NEW ROLE:** Despite primarily serving as a relief pitcher in college, Stuart is expected to make his 5th professional start on Friday...In those outings, he has no record and a 2.25 ERA (4 ER in 16.0 IP), adding 23 strikeouts (12.94 SO/9)...The Kankakee, Ill. native made only 4 starts throughout his collegiate tenure, all coming in his final season during 2022.

**SUMMER NIGHTS:** The 23-year-old is no stranger to pitching in the northeast...Stuart tossed 6.0 scoreless innings over 4 appearances with the Bourne Braves of the prestigious Cape Cod Baseball League in the summer of 2021...Was teammates with 2022 Cyclones LHP **Nick Zwack**...Also made 1 start with the Amsterdam (N.Y.) Mohawks of the Perfect Game Collegiate Baseball League in 2019.

Permitted 1 run on 2 hits over 1.0 inning...Walked 1 and did not strike out a batter...Threw 19 pitches (12 strikes)...Relieved by LHP **Quinn Brodey** in the bottom of the 8th and the Cyclones trailing, 6-4...BlueClaws went on to take the series opener, 7-4.

**PROSPECT RADAR:** Entering the 2023 season, *Baseball America* deemed Colón one of the Mets’ “14 Prospects to Watch Beyond The Top 30”

**2022:** Assigned to Single-A St. Lucie from extended spring training on June 1...Registered a 3-0 record with a 3.23 ERA (17 ER in 47.1 IP), 2 saves, and 57 strikeouts in 13 appearances (4 starts) with the Mets...Transferred to High-A Brooklyn on August 8...Composed a 1-0 mark with a 1.07 ERA (3 ER in 25.1 IP), 2 saves, and 27 strikeouts in 6 appearances (3 starts) for the Cyclones.

**FINISHING STRONG:** After joining the Cyclones on August 8, Colón was one of the most dominant pitchers in the South Atlantic League through the remainder of the season...Among pitchers with at least 25.0 innings pitched, the right-hander was 2nd in the circuit in ERA (1.07)...He also yielded the fewest hits (13), tied for the fewest runs allowed (3), and ranked 3rd in WHIP (0.79) and batting average against (.153).

**FLORIDA’S FINEST:** During his stint with St. Lucie, Colón was among the elite producing arms in the Florida State League...From June 1 until the time of his promotion to Brooklyn, the Las Matas de Farfán, D.R. native was 2nd in the circuit in ERA (3.23) and tied for 3rd in strikeouts (57)...He was also 3rd in WHIP (1.10), 4th in innings pitched (47.1), and 5th in batting average against (.227).
