YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels were shut out by the Senators, 4-0. Jacob Young scored the first run in the first inning after stealing third base and coming home on a throwing error. In the fifth, Young hit an RBI triple and Robert Hassell III added an RBI double to open a 3-0 lead. Young hit an RBI single in the seventh to extend the lead to 4-0.

TODAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the third of a six-game series against the Harrisburg Senators, Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals. The two teams met for a six-game set in Harrisburg from April 11-14, with the Senators winning four-of-six, including three games by one run. The Flying Squirrels won five-of-six at The Diamond from June 20-25 to close the first half. Richmond dropped two-of-three in Harrisburg from July 14-16 coming out of the All-Star Break. Richmond is 2-2 against the Senators in the second half.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 28-20 in their last 47 games since June 18 and snapped a three-game skid with Tuesday night's win. Over the last 53 games since June 14, Richmond starting pitchers have combined for a 2.92 ERA (66 ER/203.2 IP) and have allowed 15 home runs. For the year, the Flying Squirrels' 3.78 ERA is second-best in the league. Richmond starters have thrown 405.0 innings, which is the fewest in Double-A. Richmond relievers have thrown 545.2 innings this year, the most in Double-A. The Flying Squirrels bullpen has a 3.61 ERA, which is the fourth-lowest in Double-A and the 10th-lowest of the 120 full-season teams in the minors.

THE SENATORS are 13-4 in their last 17 games dating back to July 28, including going 5-1 against the RubberDucks at FNB Field last week. They have won four consecutive series. Since July 28, they are leading the Eastern League with a .283 batting average (165-for-582) and with 102 runs scored (6.0 runs per game). Harrisburg's roster includes nine of Baseball America's top-30 Nationals prospects, including OF James Wood (No. 2, No. 7 overall), SS Brady House (No. 3, No. 63 overall), OF Robert Hassell III (No. 4), 3B Trey Lipscomb (No. 15), RHP Cole Henry (No. 17), C Israel Pineda (No. 21), OF Jacob Young (No. 24), LHP DJ Herz (No. 25) and LHP Mitchell Parker (No. 30). MLB.com's top-30 Nationals prospect list includes nine Harrisburg players, including Wood (No. 2, No. 7 overall), House (No. 3, No. 43 overall), Hassell (No. 8), Lipscomb (No. 14), Herz (No. 16), Henry (No. 19), Pineda (No. 22), Parker (No. 26) and Young (No. 30).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Hayden Birdsong makes third Double-A start. He last pitched last Friday against the Baysox and worked one inning, allowing three unearned runs with three strikeouts. He departed after throwing 41 pitches in the inning. On the year, he leads all Giants minor league pitchers in strikeouts (124). Among all MiLB pitchers who have worked at least 80 innings, he ranks second in strikeout percentage (35.3) and fourth in K/9 (13.44). He began the season with Low-A San Jose and pitched 12 games (10 starts). With San Jose, he led the California League in strikeouts (70) prior to his promotion to High-A Eugene on June 13. With the Emeralds, he went 2-1 with a 1.55 ERA in his final six starts before being promoted to Double-A Richmond on August 4. During his time with Eugene from June 13-July 30, he led the Northwest League in WHIP (0.92) and ranked second in strikeouts (46). Birdsong was selected by the Giants in the sixth round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of Eastern Illinois University, where he played two seasons minutes from his hometown. Birdsong is rated by Baseball America as the No. 12 Giants prospect and No. 10 by MLB.com. For more information on Birdsong, see page two.

FOR HARRISBURG: Left-hander Dustin Saenz makes his 11th Double-A start and his second against Richmond. He last pitched on Saturday against Akron and worked six innings, allowing three runs in a win. In his last three starts, Saenz is 3-0 with a 2.50 ERA (5 ER/18.0 IP). He pitched at The Diamond on June 23 and allowed three runs in five innings in a no-decision. Saenz began the year with High-A Wilmington and went 2-2 with a 1.97 ERA in 10 outings. He was selected by the Nationals in the fourth round in the 2021 MLB Draft out of Texas A&M.

STARTING STRONG: Against the Curve on the last road trip beginning August 1, Richmond starting pitchers opened the set throwing 20 innings without allowing a run until the third inning on August 5. Flying Squirrels starters have a 2.20 ERA (14 ER/57.1 IP) over the last 13 games since August 2. In that stretch, **Carson Seymour** is 1-0 with a 0.61 ERA (1 ER/14.2 IP), **Spencer Bivens** has a 1.46 ERA (2 ER/12.1 IP) and **John Michael Bertrand** has a 1.80 ERA (3 ER/15.0 IP). **Wil Jensen** also threw four scoreless innings in his start on August 10.

PLAYOFF CHASE: With 28 games remaining in the regular season, the Flying Squirrels are tied for second place the Southwest Division Second-Half standings, one game behind the Erie SeaWolves, who have already clinched a spot in the postseason by winning the division's first half. Richmond is tied for second-place with Bowie and Harrisburg. Akron is in fifth, two games back, and Altoona is in sixth, four games back. The winner of the second half in the Southwest Division will face Erie in the first round of the playoffs, unless the SeaWolves win the second half, which would lead to the second-place team (determined by winning percentage) in the second half advancing to the postseason. The Flying Squirrels are aiming to reach the playoffs for the fourth time in team history. They reached the postseason in 2011, 2014 and 2022.

PACKING THE HOUSE: The Flying Squirrels are leading the Double-A level in total attendance (363,160) and average attendance (6,371) this year. They are also 14th in the minors in average attendance. Last year, Richmond led all 30 Double-A teams in total attendance (406,560) and average attendance (6,160) for the first time in franchise history.

ALL ABDARD THE SHANE TRAIN: Shane Matheny has reached base 43 times in his last 20 games since July 25 (23 hits and 20 walks), hitting .338 (23-for-68) with four homers, five doubles, two triples and 16 RBIs adding a .485 on-base percentage. On Tuesday night against the Senators, Matheny homered twice, a three-run shot in and a solo home run, and added a double in a three-hit, four-RBI performance. It was the third two-homer game of his Richmond career, joining performances on May 1, 2022 against Bowie and May 12, 2022 at Harrisburg. He also had a two-home run game on August 25, 2019 with High-A San Jose at Stockton. For his Flying Squirrels career, Matheny has worked 128 walks, moving ahead of Ricky Oropesa (112, 2013-16) for second-most in franchise history. He trails Jacob Heyward (2019, '21-22), who had 158 in his career.

DONNIE'S IN HIS ELEMENT: Donovan Walton has hit safely in each of his seven-of-his-eight games since being assigned to Richmond last week, combining to hit .321 (9-for-28) with a double, three walks and three RBIs, adding two stolen bases. In his 16 games for the Flying Squirrels this season, he is batting .302 (16-for-53) with two homers and nine RBIs. Covering his two stints with Richmond, Walton had reached base in 14 consecutive Eastern League games and hit safely in eight straight games prior to going 0-for-4 on Wednesday.

GLOW SHOW: Over his last 27 games since July 1, **Jimmy Glowenke** is batting .300 (27-for-90) with four homers, seven doubles, 20 RBIs and nine walks. On July 18 at Akron, he closed the game a triple shy of the cycle and went 3-for-6 with a three-run homer, a two-run double and an RBI single, picking up a career-high six RBIs. On July 29 against the Sea Dogs, he hit a lead-off double to start the bottom of the ninth in Richmond's comeback win. He is hitting .333 (7-for-21) in his last seven games since August 2 with two doubles, three walks and six RBIs.

DLD FRIENDS: Harrisburg's roster includes two former Flying Squirrels players. First baseman Frankie Tostado was selected by the Mariners in the minor-league phase of December's Rule 5 Draft and later traded to the Nationals. In 2021 and 2022, Tostado played 177 games for the Flying Squirrels, batting .264 with 104 RBIs. His 25 career homers with Richmond are tied for fifth-most in a career in franchise history. Reliever Patrick Ruotolo joined the Senators after being signed by the Nationals as a free agent on July 1. He spent parts of three seasons with Richmond (2018, 2021, 2021), going 4-2 with a 2.45 ERA and 16 saves in his 64 appearances. On May 13, 2021 at Harrisburg, Ruotolo worked the ninth in the Flying Squirrels' first nine-inning no-hitter in franchise history. Other former Flying Squirrels playing in the Eastern League this year include outfielder Diego Rincones (2021-22) with Erie, pitcher Gray Fenter (2022) with Somerset and pitcher Matt Seelinger (2021) with Reading.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have six players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including LHP Carson Whisenhunt (No. 5 - on IL), OF Vaun Brown (No. 7), RHP Hayden Birdsong (No. 12), RHP Carson Seymour (No. 16), RHP Landen Roupp (No. 17 - on IL) and RHP Ryan Murphy (No. 28). Baseball America rates Brown as the organization's best hitter for average and best athlete, rates Roupp as having the best curveball and Jose Cruz as having the best changeup. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospect list includes five Richmond players, including Whisenhunt (No. 3), Birdsong (No. 10), Brown (No. 13), Roupp (No. 15) and Seymour (No. 23).
