**BACK TO THE HILLS:** After winning their fifth out of the last six series last week, the FredNats return to Lynchburg, VA for the first time since early April for the third six-game series of the season with the Hillcats, Single-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians. Lynchburg is currently the only team in the North Division that Fredericksburg has a losing record to, going to 5-7 in the first 12 meetings of the season with 12 still to go, six on the road this week and six at home to finish out the regular season. Tonight, Bryan Polanco looks to bounce back from the worst start of his season last week against Delmarva where he allowed seven earned runs and did not make it out of the 2nd inning. Polanco has overall been one of the best pitchers on this staff, leading the team in wins and innings pitched this year.

**ABOUT LAST WEEK:** The FredNats finished the season series with the Delmarva Shorebirds a whopping 18-3 after another series win last week at home, winning four out of six. Fredericksburg allowed a season-worst 17 runs on 18 hits in Wednesday's loss, but dominated on the mound in the four wins. Jose Colmenares hit a walk-off single in Saturday's game as well.

**YO!:** 2023 FredNat and top Washington infield prospect Yohandy Morales begins his trek back to the Double-A Harrisburg Senators this week with the FredNats on a rehab assignment. Morales broke his thumb in Harrisburg in late May and has not played since then. Last year's second round pick out of Miami, Morales played in 18 games for the FredNats after last year's draft, slashing .390/.448/.571 for an OPS of 1.019. Morales is currently ranked as Washington's 4th-best prospect according to MLB Pipeline.

**HOT COOP:** Everett Cooper III has been the hottest bat in this FredNat order in the month of July so far. This month, Cooper is slashing .320/.393/.440 for an OPS of .833. His wOBA is .399 (.320 is average), and his wRC+ is 147 (100 is average).

**DOMINANT STARTS:** After heavily relying on the bullpen for the first two months of the season, the FredNat starting rotation has majorly improved over the last month. Since June 11, FredNat starters have logged 167.1 innings and allowed just 33 earned runs for a group ERA of 1.81. In the three weeks prior to that, the starting rotation's ERA was 5.70. In the last full six-game series alone, FredNat starters pitched 16.1 scoreless innings, allowing a total of seven hits.

**FORTY THREE AND ONE:** Last Tuesday's loss was the first time all season that the FredNats lost a game when leading after seven innings, and both doubleheader sweeps have pushed the team's record in that scenario to 43-1. FXBG's loss in Friday night's game was the first time all season the team has blown a lead after eight innings.

**FORMULA FOR SUCCESS:** The FredNats are 42-7 this season when scoring first, including 35 out of the last 37 wins. FXBG was beaten for the first time in nearly a month when scoring first in Salem last weekend.

**THE SKIP IS BACK:** The FredNats' leader from the last two seasons returns to the Managerial role for 2024. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg. Lowery, 34, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Triple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978. Lowery is 196-161 in his two-plus years as Manager in Fredericksburg, including the 2022 Carolina League playoffs.

**THE STAFF:** The majority of the 2023 coaching staff returns for 2024, with the lone exception being Hitting Coach Mike Habas. Pitching Coach Justin Lord, Development Coach Carmelo Jaime, Performance Analyst Josh Freligh, Strength & Conditioning Nathan Sier and Athletic Trainer Jake Meyer are all back from last year's staff. Lord, 44, will begin his fourth season coaching in the Washington organization. The Florida State alum pitched six seasons professionally before transitioning to coaching, spending time in the Baltimore organization prior to joining the Nationals.

Habas, 33, begins his first season in the Washington organization after spending the last four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization. He was the hitting coach for the ACL Brewers the last two seasons, and was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats and Head Coach at Prairie State Junior College prior to his time with Milwaukee. Jaime, 38, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and has served as the first base coach and infield coach with the FredNats the past three seasons. Meyer is in his seventh year with the Nationals overall and second with the FredNats, he spent his first five years at the facility in West Palm Beach, FL. Sier is in his second year with FXBG after previous stops with ZSP Sports and Macomb Community College (MI). Freligh begins his second year with the Nationals after previous stops with the Boston Red Sox and Los Angeles Dodgers.

**A LASTING LEGACY:** The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won five Mills Cup Championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014.

**TODAY'S START:** Bryan Polanco is set to make his 13th start of the season, this evening against the Lynchburg Hillcats. Polanco made a spot start at the end of April against Delmarva, and has since taken over a starting role after the promotion of Jose Atencio.

**NOTHING NEW:** While Polanco had been primarily a relief arm with Fredericksburg this year, starting games is a role he's more than familiar with. In his MiLB career, 17 of Bryan's 33 career appearances have been as a starting pitcher. In 2022 and '23 in particular, he started 16 games compared to just six relief appearances.

Further simplifying the transition, Polanco has served as the "bridge guy" out of the FredNat bullpen this year, capable of handling longer outings. Of his five relief appearances, Polanco has worked three innings once, 4+ innings three times, and even logged a five inning relief outing on 5/1 vs Down East.

**AGAINST THE HILLCATS:** Bryan has seen the Hillcats twice this year, once as a starter. He's worked six innings, and has allowed four earned runs for an ERA of 6.00 on the series.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Polanco was on the bump last week when Delmarva went on to plate 17 runs - he allowed seven earned in just 1.1 innings of work.
