ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Down 5-4 in the top of the eighth inning, DH **Abrahan Gutierrez** shocked the Maimonides Park crowd, launching a three-run home run off of RHP **Justin Courtney** to give Greensboro a 6-4 lead and eventual 6-5 victory. The loss snaps a quick two-game Cyclones winning streak. Brooklyn INF **Jose Peroza** cracked a two-run opposite-field home run as Brooklyn built an early 4-1 lead. RHP **Luis Moreno** allowed two runs (one earned) over 5 2/3 innings in the no-decision.

GREEN AROUND THE GILLS: For the first time ever, the Greensboro Grasshoppers and the Brooklyn Cyclones play against each other. Prior to the realignment in Minor League Baseball ahead of the 2021 season, the Cyclones were part of the New York Penn League at Short Season Class A, while Greensboro has been part of the South Atlantic League since 1979. Pittsburgh has had an affiliate with Greensboro since 2019. Prior to that, the Miami Marlins were with Greensboro from 2003-2018 and the Yankees from 1990-2002. Baseball in Greensboro dates back to the early 1900s.

CON SWAGGER: OF **Stanley Consuegra** put the team on his back Wednesday afternoon, going 4-for-5 with three doubles, a home run, and five RBIs. Consuegra doubled three times for the first time in his career, while he tallied four hits for the second time in his career and five RBIs in a game for the third time in his career. Consuegra recorded 10 total bases, putting together Brooklyn's single-most impactful offensive game of the season.

NIC KNOWS: C **Nic Gaddis** has enjoyed a power play stretch at the plate, homering three times in his past 13 games with a .516 slugging percentage. Since June 21, Gaddis has a .434 OBP and a .950 OPS, reaching in 18 of his past 20 games.

PEROZA POP: INF **Jose Peroza** has collected 28

vs. GREENSBORO: The Pittsburgh Pirates affiliate comes to Maimonides Park, setting up a match-up with Brooklyn for the first time in team history. Greensboro is in the North Division and hosts three of Pittsburgh's Top 30 prospects including former Mets minor leaguer No. 6 C Endy Rodriguez. He is joined by No. 11 RHP Jared Jones and No. 19 OF Hudson Head. The Grasshoppers play at First National Bank Field in Greensboro, North Carolina.

total bases in his past 13 games with four doubles, one triple, and three home runs.

HELP! I NEED SOMEONE: Brooklyn ranks 118 out of 120 Minor League teams with 315 runs scored and 116 out of 120 teams in batting average (.217) and 114 out of 120 in home runs (48).

BOMBOSAS: Since the May 22nd doubleheader against Hudson Valley where the Cyclones blasted five home runs across two games in Coney Island, Brooklyn has turned around its power at the plate. The Cyclones have run into 41 home runs in the past 50 games after just seven over the team's first 34 games.

PROSPECT POP: Brooklyn is home to seven of the Mets Top 30 prospects, according to MLB Pipeline. Offensively, OF **Alex Ramirez** ranks as the No. 4 prospect along with No. 14 OF **Jaylen Palmer**, No. 19 prospect 1B **JT Schwartz**, and No. 29 prospect INF **Jose Peroza**. On the mound Brooklyn hosts No. 9 RHP **Dominic Hamel**, No. 16 prospect RHP **Junior Santos**, and No. 21 prospect **Mike Vasil**.

BREAK ROOM: With the MLB All-Star Game coming up in Los Angeles on Tuesday, the Minors also get a four-day break. While there is no South Atlantic League All-Star Game, Brooklyn is off Monday through Thursday of next week and back at it July 22-24 at Jersey Shore.

WELCOME TO HIGH-A: Carson Seymour makes his seventh High-A start today, facing Greensboro for the first time.

FIRST THREE: In his first three outings with Brooklyn, Seymour posted a 3.21 ERA, allowing five earned runs over 14 innings.

LAST FIVE: Since the first three outings with the Cyclones, Seymour has yielded 12 earned runs in just 18 2/3 innings, posting a 5.79 ERA.

ST LUCIE STALWART: Seymour began his season with Low-A St. Lucie, tossing four consecutive scoreless outings. He finished his Florida State League experience with a victory over the Yankees affiliate in Tampa, striking out a career-high eight batters over 5 1/3 innings.

K-STATE: The 6-foot-5 righty transferred to Kansas State after one year at Darmouth, sitting for the 2019 season due to NCAA transfer rules before pitching for two seasons in the Big 12 Conference.

GOOD COMPANY: Seymour’s college teammate at Kansas State, RHP Jordan Wicks, was selected 21st overall by the Chicago Cubs and signed for \$3.1 million.

DYNAMIC DAD: Carson’s father Brian was a professional tri-athlete (swimming, biking, running), finishing the Hawaii Ironman competition four times.

FROM MANHATTAN (KS) TO QUEENS: Seymour was selected in the sixth round of the 2021 MLB Draft by the Mets and signed for \$291K. The last time the Mets selected a player directly from Kansas State, they drafted 2013 Brooklyn Cyclones OF Jared King who reached as high as Double-A Binghamton.
