GAME INFORMATION

TONG TERRIFIC: RHP **Jonah Tong**, the Mets' No. 4 prospect and MLB Pipeline's No. 44 prospect, will be called up by the New York Mets and make his major league debut on Friday against the Miami Marlins at Citi Field. Tong, 22, will become the fourth pitcher that began the season with Double-A Binghamton to make their MLB debut for the Mets this season, along with RHP Jonathan Pintaro, RHP Alex Carrillo, and RHP Nolan McLean. Tong leads Minor League Baseball with 179 strikeouts, 14.17 K/9, a 40.5 K%, a 1.43 ERA, and a .148 BAA across two levels. Tong went 8-5 with a 1.59 ERA and 162 strikeouts over 102 innings in 20 starts for Double-A Binghamton this year and went 2-0 with 17 strikeouts in 11.2 scoreless innings in two starts for Triple-A Syracuse. The 2022 seventh-round pick will make his MLB debut (August 29, 2025) less than one year after making his Double-A debut (September 5, 2024).

TUCCI MANE: LHP **Jonathan Santucci**, the Mets' No. 14 prospect (MLB Pipeline), is slated to make his eighth Double-A start tonight. Santucci is 3-0 with a 2.34 ERA and 43 strikeouts in 34.2 innings at Double-A. The 22-year-old has not allowed an earned run over his last two starts and has 14 strikeouts in 10.1 innings over that span. Over his last three starts, the 2024 second-round pick is 1-0 with a 0.55 ERA (1 ER) and 20 strikeouts over 16.1 innings, while opponents are hitting .143. Santucci has allowed two earned runs or fewer in six of his first seven starts at Double-A.

WINNING: The Rumble Ponies are 79-40 overall and are 39 games above .500 (ties season best). Binghamton has the best winning percentage (.664) in Double-A and the 3rd-best in Minor League Baseball, behind Detroit's High-A West Michigan (.708) and Pittsburgh's High-A Greensboro (.692). Binghamton is on-pace for 90 wins, which would surpass the franchise record for wins in a single season (86 - 2013). Binghamton won the Northeast Division First-Half title, and clinched a spot in the postseason with a 45-22 (.672) record.

LAST GAME: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies beat the Somerset Patriots, 8-1, in the series opener at Mirabito Stadium on Tuesday. RHP **R.J. Gordon** (5-0) earned the win with eight strikeouts over five innings of one-run ball. LF **D'Andre Smith** and 3B **Jacob Reimer** both recorded three-hit games. SS **William Lugo** hit a bases-clearing double in the seventh that broke the game open.

REIMER REASON: INF **Jacob Reimer**, the Mets' No. 6 prospect (MLB Pipeline), recorded his second-straight three-hit game and third-straight multi-hit game on Tuesday. Over his last 11 games, Reimer is hitting .512 (21-for-41) with a .574 OBP, .927 SLG, 1.501 OPS, 4 HR, 12 RBI, 11 R, & 8 XBH. The 21-year-old has risen his AVG from .200 to .277 and OPS from .662 to .867 at the Double-A level over that span. He was named to the MiLB Prospect Team of the Week last week at Portland (.471 AVG, 2 HR, 5 RBI, 5 XBH). Reimer is ranked as MLB Pipeline's No. 3 3B prospect in baseball.

SMITH HAPPENS: OF **D'Andre Smith** recorded his second-straight three-hit game on Tuesday and is 6-for-11 with 4 RBIs, three runs and two doubles in that span. Since the start of July, Smith has produced a .315 AVG, .841 OPS, 4 HR, 23 RBI, 23 R, 8 2B, 13 XBH, & 13 SB over a 38-game span. Smith ranks 5th in Double-A and 2nd in the Eastern League with a .315 AVG, 2nd in the EL with 47 hits, and 9th in the EL with 13 SB, since July 1. The 24-year-old is hitting .279 over 79 games in AA.

EWING IT ALL: OF **A.J. Ewing**, the Mets' No. 7 prospect (MLB Pipeline), has reached base safely in 12 of his first 13 Double-A games, with 21 H, 3 RBI, 9 R, and 7 SB. Ewing has recorded six-straight multi-hit games and has eight multi-hit games in 13 games at the Double-A level. Over his last six games, Ewing is 14-for-28 (.500 AVG) with a .517 OBP, 1.196 OPS, 2 RBI, 5 R, 5 2B, & 4 SB. The 21-year-old has 65 stolen bases in 109 games across three levels, which ranks T-4th in MiLB.

PARADA PARTY: C **Kevin Parada** is riding a 7-game hit streak, a 13-game on-base streak and has reached base in 15 of his 16 games in August (18-for-55, .327 AVG, .406 OBP, .934 OPS, 2 HR, 8 RBI, 7 R, 5 2B, 7 XBH, 7 BB). He recorded his first 3-hit game on May 16 and has produced a .306 AVG (3rd in AA), .528 SLG (3rd in AA), .901 OPS (6th in AA), 9 HR, 42 RBI over a 62-game span since. In 9 games against Somerset, Parada has a .414 AVG, .514 OBP, 1.273 OPS, 3 HR, 8 RBI, 8 R, & 7 BB.

SUPER SUERO: C/1B/LF **Chris Suero**, the Mets' No. 15 prospect (MLB Pipeline), is riding a 23-game on base streak, which marks the longest for any Binghamton hitter this season. Suero holds the 2nd-longest active on-base streak in the Eastern League, behind Reading's Keaton Anthony (25). The 21-year-old has 23 H, 7 XBH, 15 RBI, 16 R, and 16 BB over his first 26 games at Double-A.

LAST START: Santucci spun five scoreless innings with three strikeouts, despite issuing three hits and four walks at Portland on Thursday night...He battled left-hander Dalton Rogers who threw 5.1 scoreless innings for Portland...It marked his sixth time in seven Double-A starts where he allowed 2 ER or fewer.

2025 SEASON: Recorded a career-high 11 strikeouts over 5.1 innings and did not allow an earned run on three hits and one walk vs. New Hampshire on August 15...Promoted to Double-A Binghamton on Monday July 7...Made 15 appearances and 13 starts for High-A Brooklyn and went 5-4 with a 3.46 ERA and 75 strikeouts in 67.2 innings...Recorded a career-high nine strikeouts over six scoreless innings against High-A Hudson Valley on July 5 in final High-A start...Ranked among the South Atlantic League with a 3.46 ERA (9th) and 75 strikeouts (10th) at the time of his promotion...Went 5-0 with a 1.35 ERA and 54 strikeouts in 46.2 innings over his final nine appearances with High-A Brooklyn...Began first professional season with High-A Brooklyn.

LAST SEASON: Did not pitch professionally after being drafted by the Mets in the second round (46th overall) out of Duke...All-ACC First Team (SP)...In third season at Duke, he made 13 starts as Blue Devils' Friday night ace and went 6-1 with a 3.41 ERA, worked a career high 58 innings striking out 90 batters and holding opponents to a .188 batting average against...Started against Oral Roberts in the second game of the NCAA Norman Regional in Oklahoma and tossed two scoreless innings...Punched out a career high 14 batters against Akron (3/1)...2024 Golden Spikes Midseason Watch List...Missed three weeks with a rib injury.

CAREER NOTES: Currently ranks as the New York Mets' No. 14 prospect and No. 6 pitching prospect (MLB Pipeline)...Pitched one scoreless inning for the Mets in the 2025 Spring Breakout game...Was invited to the USA Baseball Collegiate National Team Camp in Cary, North Carolina, over the summer of 2022, after his freshman season at Duke...Was a two-way player for his first 2 years at Duke.

BACKGROUND: Originally drafted by the New York Mets in the second round (46th overall) of the 2024 MLB Draft out of Duke University...Made 40 appearances and 27 starts in his three-year career at Duke and went 10-6 with a 3.86 ERA and 198 strikeouts (13.9 K/9) in 128.1 innings...Grew up in Leominster, Massachusetts and attended Phillips Academy in Andover, Mass. for high school...Tabbed the No. 2 recruit out of Massachusetts and the 64th overall player in the class of 2022...Father Steven played baseball at Assumption University from 1991-93 and was a 19th-round pick by the St. Louis Cardinals in 1993, who played four seasons as an outfielder in the minor leagues and reached Double-A Arkansas in 1996.
