### INDY BITS

ABOUT YESTERDAY: The Indianapolis Indians posted six runs in the first inning courtesy of an Andrés Alvarez leadoff home run and Mike Jarvis grand slam en route to a 6-1 victory over the Iowa Cubs at Principal Park on Sunday afternoon. Indianapolis was off to the races in the first inning, with Alvarez taking Thomas Pannone deep to left field for the team's third leadoff homer this season. Command issues plagued the I-Cubs starter, who walked Matt Fraizer on four pitches - his third consecutive base-on-balls — to bring home another run later in the inning. With two outs and the bases loaded, Jarvis then cranked his first Triple-A homer in dramatic fashion to clear the basepaths. Iowa recorded its second and final hit in the eighth inning after Priester's exit and broke up the shutout bid via a run-scoring wild pitch by Josh Fleming.

MAKING HISTORY: Andrés Alvarez's leadoff home run and Mike Jarvis' grand slam in the first inning last night marked just the second time in the Victory Field era that the Indians hit both a leadoff homer and grand slam in the same game. The first time came on July 3, 2003, at Columbus when Bill Hall homered to begin the game and Keith Luula hit a grand slam in the fifth inning

A JACK FOR JARVIS: Mike Jarvis launched his first career Triple-A home run in grand fashion last night, launching a first-inning grand slam for the Indians first such home run since Endy Rodríguez on July 14, 2023, at Omaha. It was the infielder's third career grand slam and first since April 30, 2023, with High-A Greenshoro vs. Rome

LEAD 'EM OFF: Andrés Alvarez kicked off the game with the Indians third leadoff home run of the season and first by a batter other than Ji Hwan Bae. It was the second leadoff home run of his career and first since May 21, 2022, with Double-A Altoona vs. Richmond.

QWINNING: Quinn Priester worked with the six-run lead handed to him in the first inning, spinning a shutout gem across 7.0 one-hit innings. He worked efficiently, tallying just 81 total pitches with 14 outs recorded on the ground. Priester's lone hit surrendered came with one out in the first inning. It was his second win of the season and first since his season-debut on March 31 at Louisville (5.2ip, 1h, 1r, 1bb, 9k). It was also his seventh career appearance (sixth start) against lowa since 2023, in which he owns a 5-0 record, 2.70 ERA (12er/40.0ip) and 37 strikeouts.

THE GREATEST SPECTACLE IN RACING: Yesterday marked the 29th time in the Victory Field era that the Indians have played on Indy 500 race day, all but one of which have come on the road. In those games, they own a 12-17 record and broke a three-game losing streak on race day with a 6-1 victory at lowa yesterday. Following Josef Newgarden's second consecutive victory in the Indy 500 yesterday, the Indians are 4-4 when an American wins the 500. In addition, the Indians were 0-2 the last time a driver won back-to-back races (Hélio Castroneves, 2001-02).

LAMB ON BASE: Jake Lamb led the Indians with two hits and two RBI on Saturday night to extend his current on-base streak to 26 games since April 18. His streak bested Nick Gonzales' 21-game streak as the longest by an Indians batter this season and is the second-longest in the International League this season, trailing Rochester's James Wood (29). During that stretch, he is hitting .351 (34-for-97) with 16 runs, 11 doubles, one home run, 19 RBI, a .419 onbase percentage and .914 OPS with eight multi-hit performances. Lamb has hit safely in each of his last six games and nine of his last 10 with a .318 batting average (14-for-44), four doubles and seven RBI. He has now reached base safely in 37 of 38 games this season.

TONIGHT: The Indians kick off a seven-game homestand vs the Omaha Storm Chasers, Triple-A affiliate of the Kansas City Royals, tonight at 7:15 PM ET. The first series between the two at Werner Park was shortened by three games due to inclement weather, with one of those contests set to be made up as part of a doubleheader on Thursday. The Indians are 1-2 against Omaha this season. Kicking off the series tonight for the home team will be RHP Isaac Mattson (0-1, 3.52) for his first career appearance against the Storm Chasers in 45 career Triple-A games (one start). Countering for Omaha is RHP Jonathan Bowlan (5-1, 4.35), who earned the win with 6.0 two-run innings on Sept. 16, 2023, his lone career start vs. Indianapolis.

MEMORIAL DAY: Tonight marks the 23rd time in the Victory Field era and second time in as many years that the Indians are set to play on Memorial Day. In those games, they own an even 11-11 record with a 4-5 record at Victory Field. They are currently working a three-game winning streak on the holiday, defeating Columbus at Huntington Park in 2019 (8-3) and Toledo at Victory Field in 2023 (12-6).

REHAB NOT DELAYED: The Pittsburgh Pirates today announced that the rehab assignment of catcher Jason Delay has been transferred to the Indianapolis Indians from Single-A Bradenton. He was placed on the 10-day injured list with right knee inflammation on April 3 (retro to April 1) and was later transferred to the 60-day. He appeared in one game to begin his rehab assignment with the Marauders, going 0-for-2 with a walk on May 25. Delay appeared in one regularseason contest with Pittsburgh after hitting .231 (6-for-26) with two doubles and two RBI in 13 spring training games. He spent most of the 2023 season in the big leagues with a .251 batting average (42-for-167), 13 extra-base hits and 18 RBI in 70 games.

THIS DATE IN 2012: Left-hander Jeff Locke recorded the only 10-plus strikeout game of the season for Indianapolis, striking out a career-high tying 11 batters in 6.1 innings at Louisville. Locke surrendered three runs on four hits and gave up no walks in the outing. He took a no-decision as Indy overcame a 4-1 deficit, scoring one in the eighth and seven runs in the top of the ninth for the 9-4 win. Third baseman Jordy Mercer tied the game in the final frame with a two-run homer, and after Alex Presley reached base safely with a run-scoring fielder's choice, Starling Marte cleared the bases with a grand slam.
