### LAST GAME

The Baysox fell to the Senators by a 13-4 final on Saturday night. Left-handed starter Cade Povich allowed six run, five of which were earned, through just over three innings. The damage included three runs in the top of the first, as JT Arruda launched a two-run home run just two batters into the game, before Blake Rutherford came home to score on an error. Harrisburg would manage an additional pair of two-run homers, as Jack Dunn hit one over the wall in the fourth against Povich, before Rutherford did the same in the fifth against right-hander Conner Loeprich. Rutherford's home run was part of a four-run fifth inning for the Senators, who would tack on three more in the ninth against right-hander Xavier Moore, with Arruda adding his third RBI of the night on a bases loaded walk. Offensively, the Baysox had some early success against left-handed starter Alex Troop, with a Donta' Williams RBI single in the second and a Cesar Prieto RBI double in the third, but ultimately, the bats grew silent after a first-career Baysox home run for Tim Susnara on a solo shot in the fifth. Troop was able to go six innings and pick up the win for Harrisburg, while Odalvi Javier went the back three frames and picked up the save.

### TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Senators enter tonight with a record of 25-24 - good for third place in the Southwest division and two-and-a-half games out of first. The Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals, Harrisburg split a six-game series in Reading last week, losing each of the last three contests. The Senators won five of six in Harrisburg against the Baysox back in the second week of May. After six home runs this week, Harrisburg has the second-fewest home runs (37) and third-fewest road home runs (20) hit in the Eastern League, while the Bowie staff has allowed the most home runs at home (41) in the league. The Senators' roster is highlighted by the Nationals' top two prospects, according to MLB Pipeline - James Wood (No. 1 WSH/No. 7 overall) and Robert Hassell III (No. 2 WSH/No. 44 overall) patrolling the outfield. RHPs Jackson Rutledge (No. 11 WSH) and Gerrardo Carrillo (No. 27 WSH) alongside LHP Mitchell Parker (No. 23 WSH) feature on the Harrisburg pitching staff.

### TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-hander Michael Cuevas gets the ball for Harrisburg for this afternoon's finale. It's the second start for Cuevas this week against Bowie, and the third time he's faced the Baysox this season. Cuevas fired five frames in a losing effort on Tuesday, as he allowed three runs (two earned) on six hits. On the season, Cuevas has allowed 4 ER to the Baysox in 10 IP, good for a 3.60 ERA. Still 21 years old, Cuevas was a 23rd round pick of the Nationals back in 2019 out of Brennan High School in San Antonio, Texas. Baysox hitters have plenty of familiarity with Cuevas, who will be making his 15th appearance against an Orioles' affiliate in his career this afternoon.

### DOUBLE THE MAYO!

Coby Mayo has been a balanced mix of power, patience, and run production at the plate for the Baysox. Mayo leads the Double-A level with 17 doubles and is second with 25 extra-base hits. The No. 8 Orioles prospect, per MLB Pipeline, already has three doubles in this series and five in his last seven games. Mayo also leads the Baysox with 24 RBI on the season. In addition to his power and production, Mayo paces the Baysox with a .397 on-base percentage and 28 walks.

### SLIPPING UP

After committing six errors in the past two games, the Baysox continue to lead Double-A with 53 errors this season. Last year, Bowie had a lauded infield defense, and committed only 100 errors in a full 138-game season, and an average number in the Eastern League. At this point in the season, Bowie is on pace for 152 total errors in 2023.

### STALLING THE SENS

Right-hander Garrett Stallings has had remarkable success when facing the Senators in his career. Stallings has tossed 10 shutout innings against Harrisburg through his two appearances this season, including grabbing the win on Tuesday night with five scoreless innings of relief, where he retired 15 of 16 batters faced. Stallings owns a career 2.96 ERA (8 ER in 24.1 IP) in his career against the Senators. Stallings has logged three outings of at least five shutout innings against Harrisburg in his career, including six hitless frames back on 5/8/22. As a starter this season, the right-hander also sports a 1.44 ERA - the second lowest in all of Double-A (min. 25 IP).

### DONTA' DAZZLES

OF Donta' Williams has hits in five straight, and seven of his past eight games for the first time in his Double-A career. After a 4-for-51 stretch (.078) in the beginning of May, Williams is 10 for his last 22 (.454) with a pair of home runs and four doubles. Williams has also shown improved plate discipline, with seven walks in his last eight games, helping his on-base percentage jump 66 points during the stretch.

## QUICK HITS

- Set a franchise record in 2022 for most home runs allowed (27) Currently tied for third-most home runs allowed in Baysox history (38)
- Record the fifth-most strikeouts and the second-most starts in the Orioles' system in 2022, all while throwing the second-most innings and giving up the most hits.
- Was a part of the 11th no-hitter in Baysox history on 5/8 against Harrisburg, alongside Morgan McSweeney – pitched six of the seven innings in what was the front end of a doubleheader, allowing just two walks.

## CAREER NOTES

- Gave up the second-highest batting average and slugging percentage amongst Baysox arms with at least 30 innings.
- Shifted to the bullpen in July from the rotation after allowing 43 runs in 17 innings from 5/27-6/26. Proceed to win Orioles Minor League Pitcher of the Month in July, pitching to a 1.46 ERA in 5 appearances (1 start), which included a career-high 10 strikeouts in 4 innings against Richmond on 7/2.
- Held right-handed hitters to a .236 average, as opposed to a .345 average for right-handers. Held opponents to a .176 average in 19 innings as a reliever.
- Began 2021 season in High-A Aberdeen with a 4.39 ERA in 80 innings before being promoted to Bowie on 8/17.
- Traded to the Orioles in December of 2020 in the Jose Iglesias deal alongside fellow Orioles farmhand Jean Pinto.
- Never made an appearance for the Angels' organization after being drafted by them in the fifth round of the 2020 draft.
- Orioles EVP/GM Mike Elias had targeted Stallings in the 2020 draft but was taken earlier by the Angels.
- Threw two complete game shutouts in his junior season at Tennessee. He earned two SEC Pitcher of the Week awards, and was also named to the 2019 SEC All-Defensive team

## NOTES BY OUTING\*

- Struck out three of the first seven batters faced, but allowed a single and home run to the first two batters of the third inning. Later allowed a triple, but a double play at home prevented a run.
- Thanks to a double play, faced the minimum over his 14 batters. Both hits were singles, and neither reached second base.
- Two of three hits allowed were home runs, including one to the second batter of the game.
- Relieved Peter Van Loon in second game of a DH. After retiring the first batter, gave up four-straight hits, including a triple and two-run home run. Allowed first three batters to reach in the following inning as well.
- Relieved Van Loon again, allowed seven hits to the first eight batters he saw, including another home run.
- Retired the first seven batters, and only allowed one hit through four innings.
- Relieved Van Loon. Allowed four runs in first two innings, but none in final three, while striking out five.
- Allowed two base hits in the third, but a baserunning mistake saved him from allowing a run.
- Relieved Van Loon. Only allowed one baserunner, a two-out single in his second inning.

He served as the pitching coach of the Aberdeen IronBirds during the 2022 season, helping Aberdeen clinch a first-half division title and make it all the way to game three of the South Atlantic League Championship Series. Herrmann guided one of the best staffs in the SAL last season, which led the league in strikeouts.
