YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels fell to the Rumble Ponies, 7-4, for their third straight loss and fourth of the series. Binghamton hit a pair of two-run homers by Luke Ritter and Agustin Ruiz in the second to open a 4-0 lead. In the fourth, Tanner Murphy hit an RBI double and Rowdey Jordan added an RBI single to open a 6-0 lead. The Flying Squirrels cut the lead to 6-4 in the fifth with four runs. Marco Luciano brought in a run with a sac fly, Andy Thomas and Carter Aldrete hit RBI singles and Riley Mahan brought in a run with a groundout. Spencer Bivens worked 2.2 scoreless innings out of the bullpen. Binghamton pitchers combined to strike out 15 Richmond batters.

TDDAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels finale the of a six-game series against the Binghamton Rumble Ponies, Double-A affiliate of the New York Mets. This series marks the Flying Squirrels' first set in Binghamton since 2019. The Flying Squirrels were supposed to play a six-game series in Binghamton from August 31-September 5, 2021, but it was canceled. This series marks the first time the Flying Squirrels have lost a series in Binghamton since they were swept in three games in 2016. This year, Richmond is 4-4 against opponents from the Northeast Division.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS dropped from a tie for first place in the Southwest Division down to fourth with Thursday's loss. Saturday's loss dropped them under .500 for the first time this season. The Flying Squirrels were 14-7 through their first 21 games but have lost 15-of-their-last-22. Their 7-15 record since May 3 is the worst in the Eastern League. The Richmond pitching staff has a 3.81 ERA, which is third in the Eastern League. Richmond starters have thrown 150.0 innings, which is the fewest in Double-A. Richmond relievers have thrown 216.0 innings this year, the most in Double-A. The Flying Squirrels bullpen has a 2.83 ERA, which is the lowest of all 120 teams in Minor League Baseball.

THE RUMBLE PONIES have won five-of-their-last-seven games. Saturday's win clinched their second series win of the season and their first since taking four-of-five against Akron from April 25-29. Binghamton's .221 team batting average is the second-lowest in the Eastern League. Their 4.77 team ERA is ninth in the league and their 5.35 bullpen ERA is 10th. Binghamton's roster includes three of Baseball America's top-30 Mets prospects, including RHP Dominic Hamel (No. 11), RHP Mike Vasil (No. 12), RHP Junior Santos (No. 20) and RHP Luis Moreno (No. 24). Jose Peroza is rated as the organization's best defensive infielder. MLB. com's top-30 Mets prospects list includes RHP Dominic Hamel (No. 7), RHP Mike Vasil (No. 9) and RHP Junior Santos (No. 17).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Kai-Wei Teng makes his ninth start of the season and his second in this week's series against the Rumble Ponies. In Tuesday's series opener, Teng tied his longest outing of the season,working 4.2 innings, and allowed a season-high five runs. For the season, Teng ranks tied for 10th in the Eastern League in strikeouts (46). Among pitchers who have thrown at least 32 innings, Teng is second in strikeout percentage (33.8) and K/9 (12.8). He has 215 strikeouts since coming to Double-A to open the 2022 season, which is the fourth-most strikeouts in a Flying Squirrels career. Since the start of the 2022 season, Teng has the most strikeouts (215), games started (36) and innings pitched (168.2) of all Double-A pitchers. Last year, Teng led the Eastern League and set a Richmond franchise record with 169 strikeouts. For 2022 in his first Double-A season, Teng went 6-12 with a 5.22 ERA. He tied the Flying Squirrels' franchise record for the most starts in a season with 28. A native of Taiwan, Teng was originally signed by the Minnesota Twins before being traded to the Giants at the deadline in 2019 along with RHP Prelander Berroa for RHP Sam Dyson. Prior to the 2023 season, Teng pitched for Chinese Taipei in the World Baseball Classic at Taichung Intercontinental Stadium in his hometown. For more on Teng, see page two.

FOR BINGHAMTON: Right-hander Junior Santos makes his ninth Double-A start and second against the Flying Squirrels. He started against Richmond on Tuesday and tied a season high with six runs allowed over 5.2 innings. Santos signed with the Mets at age 16 in 2017 out of the Dominican Republic. After suffering a broken foot in 2020, Santos spent the 2021 season with Low-A St. Lucie, where he went 6-6 with a 4.59 ERA in 21 games. Last year, he pitched for the High-A Brooklyn Cyclones and made 26 appearances (23 starts), going 8-13 with a 4.47 ERA. Santos is rated by Baseball America as the No. 20 Mets prospect.

THOMAS TAKING OFF: In his last five games since last Sunday, **Andy Thomas** is batting .350 (7-for-20) with a homer, two doubles, one walk, three RBIs and five runs scored, raising his batting average from .192 to .218. He has picked up a hit in each of his last five games. Thomas started this stretch with a solo home run in last Sunday's win over the RubberDucks.

THE NEW GUY: Playing his second game with the Giants organization on Thursday, **Brady Whalen** picked up three hits, including a homer and a triple. With the Flying Squirrels trailing, 1-0, with two outs in the ninth, he hit a solo homer to tie the score. He added a sac fly to tie the score early in Friday's loss. Whalen signed with the Giants as a free agent in December and missed the start of this year with an injury. He was activated on the Richmond roster on Saturday and played his first games for the Flying Squirrels this week in Binghamton.

ALRIGHTY, ALDRETE: Carter Aldrete homered three times over a five-game stretch from May 17-21. He has driven in nine runs over his last 10 games since May 17. In his last 18 games since May 6, he is batting .296 (21-for-71) with four homers, four doubles and 11 RBIs. For the season, Aldrete is ranked tied for sixth in the Eastern League with 25 RBIs. He has hit safely in eight straight games dating back to May 19. He has also reached base in 12 straight games since May 14.

VAUN RETURNS: Outfielder **Vaun Brown** was reinstated from the injured list with the Flying Squirrels on May 16. After missing the start of the season with an injury, he joined Low-A San Jose on a rehab assignment in late-April and played five games before joining High-A Eugene for five games. In the nine games on his rehab assignment, Brown hit .351 (13-for-37). Last year, Brown played his first full professional season and led all full-season minor leaguers in batting average (.346) and OPS (1.060). He also ranked third in the minors in SLG (.623) and sixth in OBP (.437). Brown joined the Flying Squirrels last August and made his Double-A debut in Akron, but left that game in the fifth inning with an injury and did not play again for the year. Brown is rated by Baseball America as the No. 6 Giants prospect and No. 5 by MLB.com. Baseball America also lists Brown as the Giants' best athlete and best hitter for average. Brown has reached base in each of his six games with Richmond.

THE 'PEN IS MIGHTY: Richmond relievers have posted a 2.83 ERA this season, which is the lowest of all 120 teams in the minors. Of Eastern League pitchers who have worked at least 15 innings and have not made a start this year, four Flying Squirrels relievers are ranked in the top-11 in ERA. **Nick Swiney**, who is now in Triple-A, is ranked first in ERA (1.15). **Blake Rivera** (1.59 ERA) is fifth, **Raymond Burgos** (1.80) is eighth and **Wil Jensen** (2.00 ERA) is 11th. Out of all Eastern League pitchers, starters and relievers, who have thrown at least 25.0 innings this year, Jensen has the fourth-lowest ERA.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, Luis Matos is ranked sixth in batting average (.304) and ninth in OBP (.398). Ismael Munguia is ninth in batting average (.300). Carter Aldrete is tied for sixth in RBIs (25). Riley Mahan is tied for sixth in RBIs (25). Hayden Cantrelle is seventh in OBP (.405). Tyler Fitzgerald is tied for first in triples (3). Kai-Wei Teng is tied for 10th in strikeouts (46). Evan Gates is tied for seventh in saves (4).

WHERE THE RUMBLE PONIES RANK: Among the Eastern League leaders, Matt Rudick is fifth in batting average (.311), tied for sixth in RBIs (25), first in OBP (.455), fifth in SLG (.545), second in OPS (1.000), tied for ninth in hits (41), tied for sixth in walks (30), tied for sixth in extra-base hits (17), eighth in total bases (72) and tied for third in runs scored (32). Jose Peroza is sixth in SLG (.531) and seventh in OPS (.919). Wyatt Young is tied for eighth in walks (28).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have eight players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including Marco Luciano (No. 1, No. 30 overall), Vaun Brown (No. 6), Mason Black (No. 9), Carson Seymour (No. 12), Landen Roupp (No. 13), Ryan Murphy (No. 20), Wade Meckler (No. 23) and Randy Rodriguez (No. 30). Luciano is rated by Baseball America as the organization's best power hitter. Roupp is rated as having the best curveball. Brown is rated as the best hitter for average and the best athlete. Meckler is rated as having the best strike-zone discipline. MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Luciano (No. 2, No. 20 overall), Brown (No. 5), Black (No. 10), Roupp (No. 13), Seymour (No. 17), Rodriguez (No. 26) and Murphy (No. 27).


