JACKSONVILLE SMASHES NASHVILLE, 11-3

The Jumbo Shrimp crushed the Sounds 11-3 on Saturday. Jacksonville plated four runs in the first inning to grab the immediate lead. After a Nashville run in the second, Heriberto Hernandez launched a solo home run to lead off the fourth. The Sounds pulled to within 5-2 in the fifth, but three Jumbo Shrimp runs in the sixth widened the gap to 8-2. Nashville added a tally in the bottom of the sixth, but then Maximo Acosta's RBI single in the eighth proceded two more Jacksonville runs in the ninth to set the final margin at 11-3.

WHAT A DIFFERENCE A DAY MAKES

After committing four errors and surrendering five stolen bases in a 7-1 loss on Friday at Nashville, Jacksonville bounced back in a big way in an 11-3 victory on Saturday. The Jumbo Shrimp compiled only three games last season with at least 11 runs scored, and Saturday's 11-run output was their most in a game since also plating 11 on June 26, 2024 against the Sounds. Jacksonville also walked nine times on Saturday, a number they clipped only five times in 2024. Lastly, the Jumbo Shrimp stole five bases on Saturday against Nashville; Jacksonville had registered only one five-steal game total over the last two seasons.

SOUNDS BITES

When Jacksonville rejoined the Triple-A level in 2021, they took five out of six against Nashville in the lone series the clubs played during that campaign. Since then, however, the Sounds have won each of the next three season series', with Jacksonville owning a combined 24-37 (.393) mark against Nashville since the 2022 campaign. The Jumbo Shrimp and Sounds will meet 15 times throughout the 2025 season, with nine of the meetings coming in the Music City.

MUSICAL CHAIRS

The 2024 season saw unprecedented player movement in Northeast Florida. Jacksonville set franchise records in their combined Triple-A/Double-A era (1962-present) with 90 players used, including a club record 51 pitchers. The Jumbo Shrimp also smashed another franchise record with 28 different starting pitchers used during the 2024 campaign. All told, Jacksonville had 267 transactions throughout the 2024 season.

CARP-E DIEM

The 2025 season will be **David Carpenter's** first piloting a team in MiLB. The 39-year-old spent the last two seasons at the helm of the West Virginia Black Bears in the MLB Draft League while also serving as the pitching coach at Division II Fairmont State University from 2021-24. With the Black Bears, he posted an 81-66 (.551) record, steering West Virginia to a league championship in 2023. Carpenter pitched in 222 MLB games over six seasons from 2011-15 and 2019 with the Astros, Blue Jays, Braves, Yankees, Nationals and Rangers. He registered a career 3.69 ERA in the big leagues. Carpenter's ties to the IL include a stint of eight games pitched with Gwinnett from 2013-14 and 39 games with Nashville, then a PCL club, in 2019.

I DON'T KNOW WHY YOU SAY GOODBYE, I SAY HELLO

Of Jacksonville's 28-man Opening Day roster to begin the 2025 season, a whopping 15 players have previously played for the Jumbo Shrimp. The 2025 Jumbo Shrimp also feature six members of the Miami Marlins' Top 30 prospects. That list is headed by catcher **Agustin Ramírez**, who *Baseball Prospectus* ranks as the No. 55 prospect in the entirety of baseball.

DE LOS SANTOS CLAUS

Jumbo Shrimp infielder **Deyvison De Los Santos** is coming off a monster 2024 season while playing for Jacksonville, Triple-A Reno and Double-A Amarillo. The 21-year-old native of Santo Domingo in the Dominican Republic led all of Minor League Baseball in home runs (40), RBIs (120) and total bases (307). He also ranked in the top 20 in the minor leagues in hits (2nd, 158), extra-base hits (T-2nd, 67), slugging percentage (5th, .571), OPS (10th, .914) and runs scored (18th, 89). Of the 250 hardest-hit balls in Triple-A during the 2024 season, De Los Santos smacked 11 of them, including a 116.0 mile per hour (10th overall in Triple-A) single while playing for Reno on June 12, 2024.

SHRIMP BITES

A win on Sunday will net the Jumbo Shrimp a series win in their first series of the season. Jacksonville has not recorded a series win against Nashville since taking three of five over the Sounds from April 18-23, 2023. The Jumbo Shrimp are 0-3-1 in sets in Nashville since rejoining Triple-A in 2021.

ABOUT FREDDY

-A two-way player at Riverview High School (Fla.), Tarnok went 7-0 with a 0.66 ERA while also batting .393. He was selected by the Braves in the third round, signing with Atlanta to bypass a commitment to the University of Tampa.

-Tarnok made his major league debut for the Braves on August 17, 2022, pitching 0.2 scoreless innings in a 9-7 loss to the New York Mets in Atlanta. His first big league strikeout came at the expense of Tyler Naquin.

-On December 12, 2022, the Oakland Athletics acquired Tarnok from the Braves in a three-team trade in which the Atlanta Braves received Sean Murphy, the Milwaukee Brewers acquired William Contreras, Joel Payamps, and Justin Yeager, and the Athletics also acquired Manny Piña, Kyle Muller, Esteury Ruiz, and Royber Salinas.

-The Philadelphia Phillies claimed Tarnok off waivers on June 1, 2024. Following the 2024 season, he signed a minor league contract with the Miami Marlins.

2024 SEASON

-In seven starts, Tarnok was 0-2 with a 3.65 ERA (12.1 IP, 13 H, 3 BB, 15 K, .283 BAA). However, over 16 relief appearances, he posted an 0-3 record and 9.78 ERA (19.1 IP, 21 H, 17 BB, 21 K, .280 BAA).

2023 SEASON

-Tarnok held left-handed batters to a .192/.276/.269/.545 line in 58 plate appearances compared to a .184/.333/.447/.780 line for right-handed hitters over 93 plate appearances.

ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-Tarnok's parents are Jeff and Neung. He has a brother, Christopher, and a half-brother, Nick. Through his mother, Tarnok is of Thai descent.
