- The Blue Jays claimed the series opener from Tampa, 5-4 on Tuesday night at TD Ballpark. The win marks the club's third straight win, and seventh win in the last eight games.
- Cristian Feliz belted his 14th home run of the season in the second inning a two-run shot to put the Jays ahead 2-0.
- Tampa tied the game on a Daury Arias two-run homer in the top of the third.
- Irv Carter took over for Nolan Perry with two outs in the fifth inning, and earned the win with 2.2 hitless, scoreless innings.
- Tucker Toman broke the tie with a two-out, two-RBI double in the bottom of the seventh that made it 4-2 Jays.
- Roque Salinas blooped an RBI single to right in the bottom of the eighth to give Dunedin necessary insurance for the eventual one-run win

### ONE IS ENOUGH

Last night's 5-4 victory marked the Jays third consecutive one-run victory, and 30th one-run game of the season - the most in the FSL this season. The Jays are 15-15 in those contests. 55 of the Blue Jays 81 games this season (68%) have been decided by three or fewer runs. Dunedin has a 29-26 record in those games.

### CRISTIAN CRUSHES BASEBALLS

Cristian Feliz continued his strong stretch last night with his four homer in his last six games. Feliz's 14 home runs this season are second in the FSL behind Ariel Almonte's 15. In six games against Clearwater last week, Feliz went 8-17 with 3 HRs and a league-leading 1.591 OPS to earn FSL Player of the Week honors. Feliz is on pace to hit the most home runs by a D-Jay in a single season since Orelvis Martinez hit 19 in 71 games in 2021.

### **HEATING UP**

The Blue Jays have won seven of their last eight games. The hot stretch comes after the team lost five of seven games. Dunedin's 6-1 start to July is the best in the FSL. With last night's victory and Fort Myers' loss, the Jays now trail the first place Mighty Mussels by two games. Across the last eight games, Dunedin is hitting .272 with an .882 OPS - both the best in the league in that span.

### SERIES SUCCESS

With last week's five games to one series win, the Blue Jays have achieved a split or better in seven of their last eight sets. Dunedin has especially been strong at home, having gone without a series loss at TD Ballpark since Clearwater took four of six from the Jays April 16-21 (six series).

### NICE TO SEE YOU, NIMMALA

In nine games since his return to Dunedin from the FCL Blue Jays, Arjun Nimmala is 11-33 (.333) with seven extra base hits. The 18-year old has hit a triple in three of his last four games - including last night's series opener.

### **HOMER HAPPY**

Much of the run scoring in the Blue Jays recent action has revolved around the home run. Dunedin pitching has surrendered a home run in seven straight games (17 total in that stretch). The Blue Jays have homered in five of their last six games, racking up eight total longballs in that stretch. Four of those homers belong to Cristian Feliz.

### FERNANDO IS THE FUTURE

It was announced last Tuesday that Blue Jays RHP Fernando Perez would represent Toronto in the All-Star Futures game on Saturday July 13 in Arlington. In 13 starts this season, Perez ranks among the Florida State League leaders in ERA (3.60), Ks (76), innings (70), and WHIP (1.04). Perez is the first active member of the Dunedin roster to be selected since Francisco Rios in 2016. Perez had his best month of the season in June, pitching to a 2.86 ERA in 22 innings across four starts.

### HITTERS PARK

TD Ballpark has proved to be the second-most home run friendly park in the Florida State League this season, as the Blue Jays and their opponents have combined for 75 home runs at the Venue. Bradenton's LECOM Park has seen the most homers with 78, while BayCare Ballpark is third with 64. The Blue Jays lead the league with 42 home runs allowed at home.

### REHAB CITY, USA

With Andres Sosa and Brennan Orf added to the mix last night, Dunedin has hosted 16 MLB/MiLB rehab players this season. Other notable rehabs include top prospect Ricky Tiedemann, Alek Manoah, Damiano Palmegiani (AAA), and Riley Tirotta (AAA).
