YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels snapped a three-game losing streak with a 6-5 win against the Baysox, snapping Bowie's six-game win streak. Bowie opened a 2-0 lead in the first inning with RBI singles by Zach Jarrett and Robert Neustrom. In the bottom of the third, **Andres Angulo** launched a grand slam, his first Double-A homer, to put Richmond ahead, 4-2. The Flying Squirrels added to the lead with a two-run homer in the fifth by **Sandro Fabian**. Bowie closed the gap to 6-3 in the sixth with a bases-loaded walk by Patrick Dorrian. Terrin Vavra made it a two-run game in the eighth with a solo homer. J.C. Escarra brought in a run with a groundout in the top of the ninth, but **Raffi Vizcaino** closed out the game and preserved the lead. Richmond starter **Sean Hjelle** threw 76 pitches to navigate through the first three innings. **Ronnie Williams** pitched 2.0 scoreless relief innings and picked up his second win of the season. **Joey Marciano** worked 1.2 scoreless innings.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels played the second of a six-game set against the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. The two teams will face of 24 times this season, with two series in Richmond and two in Richmond. The Flying Squirrels enter on a three-game losing streak. The Baysox are in first place in the AA-NE Southwest and have won six straight games.

STRONG START: The Flying Squirrels' 9-4 record is the second-best start through 13 games in team history, trailing only a 10-3 start in 2018. That year's edition of the Flying Squirrels opened the year 10-4 through the first 14 games. If the Flying Squirrels win tonight, it will match the best start in team history through 14 games.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS sit tied for second place in the Double-A Northeast Southwest Division, a half-game behind Bowie. The Flying Squirrels finished the 2019 season with a 55-84 record, the worst in the franchise's history, and finished in last place in the Eastern League's Western Division for the second consecutive year. Seven players from the 2019 team are back in Richmond to start the 2021 season, including **Jacob Heyward**, **Sean Hjelle**, **Ryan Howard**, **Peter Maris**, **Heliot Ramos**, **Frank Rubio** and **Raffi Vizcaino**. Reliever **Patrick Ruotolo** did not appear with the Flying Squirrels in 2019, but he did pitch in Richmond in 2018. Outfielder **Vince Fernandez** played in the Eastern League with Hartford in 2019.

THE BAYSOX lead the Double-A Northeast Southwest Division by a half-game over Richmond and Erie. Patrick Dorrian was named the Eastern League Player of the Week after hitting .333 with three homers and 11 RBIs last week against Reading. The Baysox offense leads the Double-A Northeast with 19 home runs and 86 runs scored. Bowie's roster includes five of MLB.com's Top-30 Orioles prospects, including Adley Rutschman (1), D.L. Hall (4), Terrin Vavra (11), Kyle Bradish (13) and Kevin Smith (17).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Matt Frisbee** makes his third Double-A start. He has not allowed a run this season in 11.0 innings of work. Last time out on Thursday at Harrisburg, Frisbee worked 6.0 perfect innings in the franchise's first nine-inning no-hitter. In his season debut on May 8, he pitched 5.0 scoreless innings and allowed two hits. He has not issued a walk on the season. Dating back to August 25, 2019 with High-A San Jose of the California League, Frisbee has not allowed a run in 20.2 consecutive innings. He spent most of the 2019 season with San Jose, going 9-8 with a 3.17 ERA in 22 outings (20 starts). He went 4-2 with a 1.91 ERA in his last 10 appearances (56.2 IP) of the season while picking up 60 strikeouts. Following the season, Frisbee was named a Giants Organizational All-Star by MiLB.com. He was drafted by the Giants in the 15th round in 2018 out of UNC Greensboro. **For more on Frisbee, see page two.**

FRISBEE AWARDED: On Monday, **Matt Frisbee** was named the Double-A Northeast Pitcher of the Week for May 10-16. In his lone start for the week, he worked 6.0 perfect innings at Harrisburg on Thursday with six strikeouts in the Flying Squirrels' combined no-hitter. Overall this season, Frisbee has pitched 11.0 scoreless innings to begin the season.

THEIR PLACE IN HISTORY: With the combined no-hitter on Thursday, **Matt Frisbee**, **Joey Marciano**, **Matt Seelinger** and **Patrick Ruotolo** threw the first nine-inning no-hitter for a Richmond professional baseball team since June 27, 1989, when **Charlie Puleo** and **Steve Ziem** accomplished the feat for the Richmond Braves in Rochester. Since Richmond was awarded a Triple-A franchise in 1954, there have been four nine-inning no-hitters by Richmond teams. On May 12, 1962, **Al Downing** no-hit the Syracuse Chiefs at Parker Field. On June 1, 1977 **Mickey Mahler** worked a no-hitter against the Toledo Mud Hens at Parker Field. The Flying Squirrels' only other no-hitter was a seven-inning gem by **Jack Snodgrass** and **Daryl Maday** on April 5, 2013 against the New Britain Rock Cats, the only no-hitter thrown by a home team at The Diamond since the park opened in 1985. The outing on Thursday was also the first nine-inning no-hitter for a San Francisco Giants Double-A affiliate since David Wilhelmi pitched one for the Shreveport Captains against the Arkansas Travelers in the Texas League on May 3, 1983. The most recent before that one was by Miguel Puento on August 15, 1969 for the Amarillo Giants against the Shreveport Braves.

FOR BOWIE: RHP Kyle Bradish makes his third start of the season. He has not allowed a run over 9.2 innings of work this season. He pitched 4.2 innings on May 5 at Altoona and struck out seven. Last Wednesday, he pitched 5.0 innings and struck out nine batters against Reading. Bradish was drafted by the Los Angeles Angels in the fourth round in 2018 out of New Mexico State. He was traded to the Baltimore Orioles on December 4, 2019, along with RHP Isaac Mattson, RHP Kyle Brnovich and RHP Zach Peek for RHP Dylan Bundy. Bradish is rated by MLB.com as the Orioles' No. 13 prospect and No. 12 by *Baseball America*.

STRONG ARMS: Over the last 11 games since May 8, the Flying Squirrels pitching staff has combined for a 2.60 (24 ER/83.0 IP), which is the second best in the Double-A Northeast during that span and second in all of Double-A. The Richmond pitchers also have the best BAA (.192) in the Double-A Northeast in that stretch and the second-best WHIP (1.13).

HOME SWEET HOME: The Flying Squirrels have won six straight games at The Diamond dating back to the second game of the season on May 5. They are 6-1 in home games in 2021, trailing only Akron (6-0) and Bowie (6-0) for the best home records in the Double-A Northeast this season.

AIN'T THAT GRAND: On Tuesday, **Andres Angulo** clubbed a go-ahead grand slam for his first Double-A home run. It was the first grand slam for the Flying Squirrels since **Jacob Heyward** hit a walk-off slam in the tenth inning to beat the Erie SeaWolves on August 19, 2019. Angulo now sits tied for seventh in the Double-A Northeast with a .333 batting average this season. Prior to the 2021 season, Angulo had not played above the Low-A level. He spent the 2019 season with Single-A Augusta, seeing time in 73 games.

MO-MENTUM: **Kyle Mottice** sits tied for seventh in the Double-A Northeast with a .333 batting average this season. He has at least one hit in nine of his 12 games played this season, including multiple hits in four of those games. Mottice is in his first Double-A season and his first year with the Giants organization after spending the 2018-19 seasons as a Pittsburgh Pirates farmhand.

CLOSING IT OUT: Reliever **Patrick Ruotolo** is tied for the lead in the Double-A Northeast with three saves this season. He is also tied for third in games pitched (5). On Thursday, Ruotolo pitched the ninth inning to finish a combined no-hitter, the first nine-inning no-hitter in the history of the Flying Squirrels franchise.

ALL OVER THE MAP: The Flying Squirrels roster contains 18 players from 11 different states across the United States: California (4), Georgia (4), Florida (2) and one player from North Carolina, Minnesota, Illinois, Massachusetts, New York, Missouri, Washington and Ohio. Nine players grew up in four countries and territories outside of the 50 states, including the Dominican Republic (4), Puerto Rico (2), Venezuela (2) and Colombia (1).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have three players included in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects: **Heliot Ramos** (3), **Tristan Beck** (12) and **Sean Hjelle** (13). Ramos is also rated by *Baseball America* as the No. 83 overall prospect. Ramos (3), Hjelle (11) and Beck (20) are also ranked in MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospects.

ROAD TO THE SHOW: On Monday night, 2019 Flying Squirrels outfielder **Johneshwy Fargas** made his Major League debut for the New York Mets in Atlanta. He picked up his first MLB hit in the game, an RBI double. In 2019, Fargas was named the Flying Squirrels Player of the Year after hitting .249 over 127 games. He also set the franchise's single-season stolen base record with 50 on the year.
