**CARR IN CRUISE CONTROL:** Yankees No. 11 prospect Kyle Carr was dominant in five starts during the month of May. During the month he went 3-1 with a 1.55 ERA (5 ER in 29.0 IP) and 36 K, all of which ranked 3rd in the Eastern League during the month. His 0.97 WHIP ranked 4th, while his .189 BAA ranked 6th. During his last start on 5/30 vs. NH, Carr struck out 10 batters for the first time in his career, over 6.2 IP which marked his longest Double-A start.

**BRIDGEWATER BOMBERS:** Cole Gabrielson's two home runs on Friday signaled Somerset's 28th multi-HR game of the year, out of 55 games (50.9%). Somerset is up to a Double-A leading 91 home runs this season. The Patriots have hit homers in 18 of their last 21 games, while their 91 home runs this season are the most through 55 games in Double-A during the Research Tool Era (since 2005). The Patriots are the fastest Double-A team to 90 HR in the Research Tool Era, beating the previous record by five games (RCT - 60 GP - 2021). The Patriots' 228 HR pace through 55 games is on track to beat the Double-A Research Tool Era record set by Somerset in 2022 with 205 home runs.

**COLE WORLD:** On Friday night, Cole Gabrielson recorded his first career multi-home run game, entering the night with 10 career home runs. Gabrielson smashed his first home run 111 mph off the bat 450 feet to left center field, before ripping his second of the game an inning later in the ninth. The two-home run game was Gabrielson's first since he was college at USC (2/19/23 vs. Marist). Gabrielson became the eighth Patriot this season to record a multi-home run game, joining Jace Avina, Kenedy Corona, DJ Gladney, Tyler Hardman, Marco Luciano, Garrett Martin and Coby Morales. It was the first two-HR game by a Patriots batter since DJ Gladney 5/26/26 vs. NH and 10th instance overall of a Somerset batter hammering multiple home runs in a single game this season.

**EXTRA, EXTRA, READ ALL ABOUT IT:** The Somerset Patriots have compiled an extra base hit in all 55 games played this season, making them the only Double-A team to have done so this year, and one of only two teams in Minor League Baseball to have done so (ELP, SDP Triple-A).

**SOMERSET SHOVING:** In the five games prior to Friday, the Somerset Patriots had allowed just 11 earned runs across 46.0 IP, equating to a 2.15 ERA. With 12 strikeouts on Friday, the Patriots pitching staff recorded its 35th game this year with double-digit strikeouts. Somerset's 586 strikeouts this season lead Double-A, while the Patriots' 28.0 K% is T-1st in Double-A and is T-8th among all Full Season MiLB teams.

**PUTTING IN THE WORK:** Following five innings of work by Jack Cebert on Friday, Somerset has had a pitcher go at least five innings in five of the last six games (Cade Smith - 5.0 IP - 6/3 @HBG, Trent Sellers - 6.1 IP - 6/2 @HBG, Chase Chaney - 5.1 IP - 5/31 vs. NH, Kyle Carr - 6.2 IP - 5/30 vs. NH).

**UP ALL NIGHT TO GET LUCKY:** The Somerset Patriots enter today with a record of 24-15 in night games this season, compared to a league-worst 4-12 in day games. Somerset's 24 wins in night games rank 2nd in the Eastern League (Richmond, 27-13) and are four more than any other Northeast division team (Hartford, 20-21).

**DJ TURN ME UP:** DJ Gladney enters today with a team-best six-game hit streak in tact, including extra base hits in four straight games. During the streak, Gladney is 6-for-25 with 2 HR, 5 XBH and 7 RBI. Gladney's .394 BABIP is tied for the lead among active Eastern League hitters. Gladney eighth homer of the season on Thursday was his fifth go-ahead or game-tying RBI this season in the seventh inning or later, which leads all Patriots.

**THE MARTIN MASH:** Garrett Martin enters today with 18 HR, leading all Eastern League batters and all Yankees minor leaguers, while ranking 2nd in Double-A and 4th in MiLB. Martin's 45 RBI lead the Eastern League and rank 4th in Double-A and rank 3rd among Yankees minor leaguers.

**HITTING THE G:** Connor McGinnis enters today with hits in eight of his last nine games, over which he is 10-for-32 (.313) with 2 BB, 2 RBI and a double. Entering this stretch, McGinnis had been 1-for-13 (.077) in his first four Double-A games.

**GIVE HIM THE VERDE LIGHT:** Kevin Verde enters today with hits in four of his last five games, going 6-for-16 (.375 AVG) with two walks in that span. Entering this five-game stretch, Verde had been 1-for-14 (.071 AVG) in his first five Double-A games.

## 2026 SOMERSET PATRIOTS COACHING STAFF

### JAMES COOPER: Manager (1st year)

James Cooper enters his first season as manager of the Somerset Patriots, his fifth overall year in the Yankees organization and his fourth consecutive as a minor league manager. He spent the 2025 season as the manager of the High-A Hudson Valley Renegades, after serving as manager of the Single-A Tampa Tarpons in 2024 and beginning his minor league managerial career with the FCL Yankees in 2023. Under Cooper's leadership in 2025, Hudson Valley finished with a franchise-record 79 wins (79-50), being eliminated from playoff contention on the final day of the regular season. During the season, the Renegades finished second in AVG (.235), H (970), OBP (.336), SLG (.363), OPS (.699), third in R (598) and HR (547). In 2024 at the helm for Tampa, the Tarpons led the FSL in SB, while ranking second in AVG, H and 2B, and fourth in OPS. During Cooper's first assignment with the Yankees organization in 2022, he served as defensive coach for the FCL Yankees, where he helped the team with the 2022 FCL Championship. The following season, Cooper made his managerial debut with the FCL Yankees and was named the Florida Complex League Manager of the Year in 2023, when his team led the FCL in runs, hits, triples, RBIs, AVG, OBP, SLG and OPS.

### MIKE FRANSOSO: Hitting Coach (2nd year)

Mike Fransoso enters his second season as a coach in Somerset and within the Yankees organization. Under Fransoso's leadership during the 2025 season, the Patriots' offense ranked among the Eastern League leaders with 129 HR (2nd), a .691 OPS (4th) and 600 R (5th). Fransoso played for the Somerset Patriots (2018-2019) during the team's run as an independent team and also the Pittsburgh Pirates organization (2013-2015). He previously coached in the Seattle Mariners organization (2021-2024), serving as the hitting coach and interim manager for the Double-A Arkansas Travelers in 2024, when he helped manage the team to a Southern League Championship.

### DEMETRE KOKORIS: Pitching Coach (1st year)

Demetre Kokoris enters his first season in Somerset and second with the Yankees. He served as the pitching coach in Hudson Valley in 2025 and guided the team to a league-best 2.82 ERA and 20 shutouts. Prior to joining the Yankees, Kokoris, coached in the Texas Rangers (2022-2024) and Toronto Blue Jays (2019-2021) organizations. He spent the 2023 and 2024 seasons as the bullpen coach for the Triple-A Round Rock Express, and was the pitching coach for the Single-A Down East Wood Ducks in 2022. Prior to joining the Rangers, he was the pitching coach for the Short-Season Class-A Vancouver Canadians (2019-20) and was a rehab pitching coach (2021) with the Blue Jays. Before entering the professional coaching ranks, Kokoris was a college pitching coach at Chemeketa Community College, Point Loma Nazarene University, and Santa Barbara City College. He has also served as the pitching coach for the Greek National Team since 2021.

### UZIEL VILORIA: Defensive Coach (2nd year)

Uziel Viloria enters his second consecutive season as a defensive coach in Somerset and his second season with the Yankees organization. Under his leadership in 2025, the Patriots posted a franchise record .983 fielding percentage. Viloria began his coaching career in 2024 as a coach in the Phillies organization. During his playing career, Viloria signed with the Phillies as an international free agent in 2019 and went on to play 112 games in four seasons as an infielder in the organization (2019-2023), reaching High-A Jersey Shore in 2022 and 2023.

### CALEB HAMILTON: Defensive Coach (1st year)

Caleb Hamilton enters his first season in Somerset and second with the Yankees organization. After a playing career that included MLB experience with the Minnesota Twins (2022) and Boston Red Sox (2023), Hamilton completed his first year in coaching as the defensive coach for High-A Hudson Valley in 2025. During his final season playing in 2024, Hamilton saw time in 39 games for the Rocket City Trash Pandas, the Double-A affiliate of the Los Angeles Angels. He was drafted by Minnesota in the 23rd round of the 2016 MLB Draft out of Oregon State University, where he was an All-Pac-12 performer for the Beavers. Despite not catching in college, Hamilton made 323 of his 574 professional appearances as a catcher, and he played at least one game at all nine positions.

After being traded to the Yankees from the Cubs entering the 2025 season, Arias spent the year on the Yankees' 40-man roster. He broke camp on the 7-day IL for Triple-A SWB, before being reinstated following a minor league rehab assignment on 7/19 and having his option transferred to Double-A Somerset. Ended the season in Somerset with 17 relief appearances in which he went 3-0 with a 2.57 ERA, 2 HLD, 1/3 SV, 15 BB and 29 K in 21.0 IP.

**Career Notes**

Re-signed with the Yankees as a minor league free agent on 11/26/25 and was extended a non-roster invite to Major League Spring Training. Arias was originally acquired by the Yankees from the Chicago Cubs in exchange for cash considerations on 1/15/25, after he was designated for assignment by the Cubs on 1/12/25. Initially signed an international free agent contract with Blue Jays in 2018, but did not appear in a game before his release in 2020. Signed with the Cubs in 2021 and spent the first four seasons of his career in the Cubs minor league system.
