BACK TO EARTH: After three straight shutouts to open the series, the FredNats dropped their first game of the week last night against the Shorebirds for Delmarva's first win of the year against FXBG. Tonight, RHP Marc Davis will look to build on his strong start last week against Fayetteville where he pitched three scoreless, hitless innings against the Woodpeckers. He'll face off against Delmarva righty Michael Forret, who has already taken a loss against Fredericksburg this year on Opening Night. Fredericksburg is 2.0 games out of first place in the Carolina League North Divsion behind the Carolina Mudcats heading into play today.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Jarlin Susana pitched well, allowing one run in four innings with seven strikeouts, but the FredNat offense was held down for most of the game before a 9th inning rally came up short in 6-4 loss for FXBG. Nate Ochoa had two hits, and Brenner Cox and Armando Cruz picked up RBIs, but ultimately Delmarva won its first game of the year against Fredericksburg.

HE GONE: Reigning Carolina League Player of the Week Phillip Glasser was promoted to High-A Wilmington before today's game. Glasser, the 24-year-old from Canton, Ohio, slashed .381/.444/.587 for an OPS of 1.031 in 15 games with Fredericksburg to open the season. Glasser led the league in hits and slugging, and was top-5 in batting average, OPS, XBH and total bases in his time with the FredNats.

MAJOR THEFT: In Tuesday's game, the FredNats stole 10 bases and were not caught, setting the single-game franchise record and also putting up the most stolen bases in a single game in Major League or Minor League Baseball this year. Brenner Cox, Elijah Green and Cristhian Vaquero each had two steals, Armando Cruz had three, and Gavin Dugas stole home for FXBG.

BULLPEN WORK: So far in 2024, the FredNat bullpen has been one of the best units in the Carolina League. In 89 IP so far for the FredNat relievers, the unit has allowed 26 earned runs for a group ERA of 2.53. The Freddies are also 5/5 in save opportunities (three by Thomas Schultz, one by Kevin Rodriguez and one by Samuel Vasquez), and the team is 10-0 when holding a lead after seven, and 11-0 when leading after eight innings this year.

HISTORIC DAY: In last Wednesday's game, Phillip Glasser joined some rare air with his four hits, four RBIs and three stolen bases. The last time a hitter accomplished that in a single Major League Baseball game was when Joe Carter did it with the Cleveland Indians in 1986. Glasser is also just the fourth Minor League player at any level since 2005 to have four hits, four RBIs and three stolen bases in a single game. For his total efforts last week, Glasser was named the Carolina League Player of the Week by Major League Baseball.

THE SKIP IS BACK: The FredNats' leader from the last two seasons returns to the Managerial role for 2024. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg Lowery, 34, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Iriple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978. Lowery is 153-127 in his two-plus years as Manager in Fredericksburg, including the 2022 Carolina League playoffs.

THE STAFF: The majority of the 2023 coaching staff returns for 2024, with the lone exception being Hitting Coach Mike Habas. Pitching Coach Justin Lord, Development Coach Carmelo Jaime, Performance Analyst Josh Freligh, Strength & Conditioning Nathan Sier and Athletic Trainer Jake Meyer are all back from last year's staff. Lord, 44, will begin his fourth season coaching in the Washington organization. The Alabama native and Florida State alum pitched six seasons professionally before transitioning to coaching, spending time in the Baltimore organization prior to joining the Nationals.

Habas, 33, begins his first season in the Washington organization after spending the last four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization. He was the hitting coach for the ACL Brewers the last two seasons, and was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats and Head Coach at Prarie State Junior College prior to his time with Milwaukee. Jaime, 38, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and has served as the first base coach and infield coach with the FredNats the past two seasons, roles he will continue in 2024. Meyer is in his seventh year with the Nationals overall and second with the FredNats, he spent his first five years at the facility in West Palm Beach, FL. Sier is in his second year with FXBG after previous stops with 2SP Sports and Macomb Community College (MI). Freligh begins his second year with the Nationals after previous stops with the Boston Red Sox and Los Angeles Dodgers.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won five Mills Cup Championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014.

TONIGHT'S START: Marc Davis is set to make his fourth start of 2024, in his return to the mound from Tommy John Surgery in 2022.

Davis had a promising start to his professional career, as the right-hander posted a 3.97 ERA out of the bullpen in '22, while earning a Carolina League Pitcher of the Week nod as well.

JUCO BANDIT: Davis played three seasons at Florida Southwestern State, a junior college located in Fort Myers, FL. With the Buccaneers, Marc worked primarily as a reliever; 34 of his 44 total appearances came out of the bullpen. He recorded a stellar 3.14 ERA to go along with a 1.41 WHIP for his collegiate career, while striking out a whopping 14.55 batters per nine innings.

TWO-WAY TALENT: Davis was recruited as a two-way player out of South Gwinnett High School. He impressed scouts at the plate on the travel circuit, with exit velocities north of 90 MPH as a teenager, and displayed excellent range as a shortstop. Of course, he also possessed a rocket arm, and ultimately chose to focus on the mound.

AGAINST DELMARVA: Davis made his first start of 2024 against the Shorebirds, who plated four runs against him in three innings of work.

LAST TIME OUT: Marc turned in his best start of the year last week against Fayetteville. He shutout the Woodpeckers over three complete innings, and did not allow a base hit while striking out three batters.
