**TODAY'S GAME:** The Quakes complete their final regular-season road trip of the year, as they face the Lake Elsinore Storm (Padres) in the final game of a six-game series at "The Diamond". The Quakes return home on Tuesday, September 5, hosting the Fresno Grizzlies in the final home stand of the year. Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

**VS THE STORM:** Today's game is the last of 24 head-to-head games and the final of nine here at "The Diamond". The Quakes had won all four previous series against the Storm this year, carrying a 16-7 record overall against the Storm, now 4-4 in Lake Elsinore. Last season, the Quakes went just 10-20 against the Storm, 7-8 at home.

**LAST GAME:** Five different Rancho pitchers combined on the Quakes' eighth shutout of the year, as Rancho won a 6-0 decision on Saturday night at the Lake Elsinore Diamond. Luis Carias was sharp in his Cal League debut, scattering two hits with two walks over 4.1 innings. Domingo Geronimo (8-0) retired all five batters he faced to earn the win. Offensively, Chase Harlan had three hits and four RBIs, while Ching-Hsien Ko finished a homer shy of the cycle. Jackson Nicklaus smacked his fourth homer of the year. Storm starter Cameron Nohos (0-1) took the loss in his debut. The Rancho win snapped a two-game losing streak and gives them a shot at a series-split today.

**LAST ROAD GAME:** The Quakes play their final regular season road game tonight in Lake Elsinore with a chance to finish the year with a winning record away from LoanMart Field. The Quakes are currently 33-32 on the road this year, 4-4 here in Lake Elsinore. A win would also give Rancho their second straight series-split overall.

**ROUGH NIGHT FOR INJURIES:** Last night's win was marred by the fact that there were three different Rancho injuries on the field. Charles Davalan was pulled from the game after his first at-bat with a leg injury. Ching-Hsien Ko was injured but finished the game, after flipping over the wall in foul territory while attempting to catch a foul ball. Reliever Cody Morse was struck on the left foot on a come-backer with two outs in the ninth inning and was lifted in favor of Dilan Figuredo. No roster moves have been made as a result of any of these injuries.

**PLAYOFF PICTURE FINALIZED:** Last night's Inland Empire win at Fresno secured the 66ers' berth in the 2025 playoffs. The Quakes and 66ers will meet in the South Division Finals, with game one in San Bernardino on Tuesday, September 9. On Saturday, the Fresno Grizzlies wrapped up their playoff spot, as they'll host San Jose in the opening round of the playoffs, also on September 9.

**ROSTER MOVES:** Earlier today, Hyun-Seok Jang was added to the Rancho roster, as he comes off the Development List. RHP Luis Carias, who was added to the roster on Saturday, goes to the Development List. RHP Marlon Nieves was placed on the Temporary Inactive List on Saturday. On Friday, OF Jaron Elkins was placed on the Injured List. Taking his spot on the roster was 2025 11th-round selection Dylan Tate, as he joins the team from Arizona.

**HYUN-SEOK JANG:** 21-year-old right-hander Hyun-Seok Jang makes his 12th start of the year, but his first since June 1. In his last outing overall, he allowed just two walks and struck out four over three hitless, scoreless innings in a no-decision at Modesto. He was placed on the Development List shortly after and was just activated today. Jang, who signed with the Dodgers in August of 2023 out of South Korea, was regarded as the top pitching prospect coming out of Korea in 2023 and is rated by MLB Pipeline as the Dodgers' 17th best prospect.

**TUCKER MUSGROVE:** Righty Tucker Musgrove will make his 13th appearance for the Storm and his sixth start, his second start against the Quakes. Musgrove's lone outing against Rancho was on August 10, when he worked a 1-2-3 inning at LoanMart Field in a no-decision. Musgrove has only worked a total of 18 innings this year. He was drafted by the Padres in the seventh round of the 2023 draft out of Mobile College in Mobile, Alabama.
