TODAY'S GAME / OPPOSING STARTER: Altoona open the second half of the season with a 6-game series against Reading.

Righty Luke Russo takes the ball for the Fightins. Russo was Philadelphia's 16th round pick in 2023 out of Eastern Michigan, where he shared the field for his freshman season with former Curve righty Justin Meis.

LONNIE GANG: Prior to his injured list stint, OF **Lonnie White Jr.** batted .317 with a 1.025 OPS (3 2B, 1 3B, 2 HR and 8 RBI) in an 11-game stretch. White Jr. has reached base safely in 16 straight games, during which he's hitting .279 with a .922 OPS.

BRANNIGONE: Infielder **Jack Brannigan** has been one of Altoona's top players since his return from the IL. He's 8-for-25 with 4 HR and 9 RBI, recording a .393 on-base percentage and a 1.273 OPS in 7G. Brannigan was recalled to the Pirates roster on Thursday, June 25 as an injury fill-in for INF **Spencer Horwitz**.

THE KID IS BACK: Pirates infielder **Konnor Griffin** joined Altoona for a Major League Rehab assignment on Wednesday, June 24. Returning from a forearm strain, Griffin played seven innings in the field and went 2-for-2 with a triple, a two-run homer, a walk and was hit by a pitch in four plate appearances.

OMAR COMIN': Catcher **Omar Alfonso** recorded a .941 OPS during his 20-game on-base streak that ended on June 19 in Akron. Alfonso's streak was the longest by a Curve hitter his season.

TIME TO RESET: Altoona wrapped up the First Half of the season on Sunday, June 21. After a 12-game losing streak to begin the season, the Curve played to a 31-26 record. In the first 69 games of the year, Altoona finished first in three categories; games played (69), GIDP (65) and LOB (529). Their 310 runs scored were 27th among Double-A teams.

IF ALL THE ICE MELTS, IS IT JUST BERG LETTUCE?: Catcher **Derek Berg** drove in all three Curve runs in a 3-1 win over Akron on Saturday, June 20. Berg had a clutch 2-run double in the 10th inning to give the Curve the lead. Altoona catchers have driven in 42 runs this year, second-most by an Eastern League club. Berg has an .862 OPS in his last 27G (since May 10) with The Curve.

WHEATIES, THE BREAKFAST OF CHAMPIONS: Lefty **Connor Wietgreffe** has turned a corner for the Curve in the month of June, allowing just 1 earned run in 23.0 IP in 4 outings this month. He's 3-0 with a 0.39 ERA this month, with 10 H, 5 BB and 29 K, holding opponents to a 0.65 WHIP and a .132 BAA. He ranks 1st in the EL in strikeouts (29), Wins (3), ERA (0.39), BAA (.132), WHIP (0.65), and 2nd in IP (23.0).

Wietgreffe has thrown 18.0 consecutive scoreless innings, the longest streak by a Curve pitcher since **Hunter Barco** set the franchise record in 2025.

PUPPIES: Among the 20 position players that have suited up for the Curve, 11 have made their Double-A debut this season. Only 5 pitchers (23 total) who have thrown for the team this year have made their level debut.

ITS OUTTA HERE: The Curve have 18 games this season in which they've hit at least two home runs, they've hit 3 homers in back-to-back games to start the series with Reading. The Curve have hit 73 home runs in 71 games, they're on pace to hit 139 homers which would be the most in a season since 2023 when the club hit 122 round trippers. Altoona's franchise record of 143 homers in a season was set in 2022. 16 different players have hit a home run this season, 2nd-most by an Eastern League club.

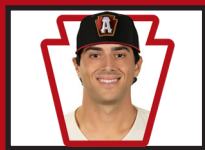

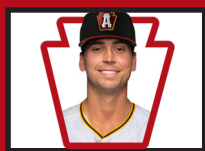
