#### Looking to Get Right

The Fightin Phils finish a six-game series at the Richmond Flying Squirrels on Sunday afternoon. Richmond holds the 5-0 edge in this week's series after winning the series in 2023 8-1. Reading was swept in their lone trip to Richmond last season, a series-opening three game series. This is the lone series between the teams this season as their won't be a trip to Reading.

#### Shutout on Saturday

Reading fell 2-0 to Richmond on Saturday night, marking the third time Reading was shutout this season. Carlos De La Cruz had two hits for Reading, including a double, which was the R-Phils' lone extra-base hit. The bullpen was strong again for Reading, combining to go five inniings and allowing just one hit, with seven strikeouts. Robinson Pina suffered the loss, snapping his streak of four-straight starts with a winning decision.

### Struggles with Richmond

Dating back to last season, the Fightin Phils hold just a 1-13 record against the Flying Squirrles. After being swept in the season-opening series in Richmond in 2023, and dropping the first four of this week's trip to The Diamond, Reading has not won a game at Richmond since July 9, 2022, dropping nine in a row.

### **Bounce Back Efforts**

Despite taking a no-decison, Matt Osterberg had a bounce-back outing at Richmond. The lefty tossed a quality start, allowing three runs over six innings, while striking out a season-high nine batters (his previous high was five). This came after Osterberg allowed 18-earned runs over 12.1 innings in his last three outings, prior to Friday. Osterberg became the fifth Reading pitcher to throw six-innings this season, but the Fightin Phils have just a 2-3 record in those games. Arturo De Freitas has made the most of his oppurtunities as of late. After playing in just one game with Reading last season, and seeing the field sparringly in 2024, De Freitas has produced as of late. De Freitas had started at catcher four times, dating back to May 8 and has hits in all four of those games. De Freitas also added his first two Double-A RBI with a two-run single on Friday afternoon.

### Looking to Avoid a Sweep

The Fightin Phils will look to avoid a sweep on Sunday at Richmond. The last time Reading was swept was at Richmond from April 8-9 of 2023, which was a three-game sweep. If the R-Phils lose on Sunday, it will mark the first time they are swept in a six-game series since July 13-18, 2021, at home against Portland. It would also mark the third time Reading is swept in a six-game series since the schedule shifted to six-game series in 2021.

### A Look at the Numbers

Reading has played much better baseball on Tuesday-Thursday, as opposed to Friday-Sunday games. Reading is 9-7 in the first three days of the week, and just 7-15 during the weekend games. Also, Reading is 14-1 in games this season when scoring over five runs, and just 2-21 when failing to score five runs.

### Rodriguez Rolling

Jose Rodriguez has been rolling as of late. After hitting just .176 in April, Rodriguez is slashing .311/.347/.511, with an .858 OPS. He's added 10 runs, four doubles, one triple, one home run and nine RBI in 12 games in May. He also has hits in nine-of-12 games in May as well.

### This Day in Baseballtown History

May 19, 2008: At Reading, a 20-hit onslaught is responsible for the Phillies' 14-1 dumping of Akron. Greg Golson goes 5-for-6 with a homer, five RBIs and three runs scored while Lou Marson is 3-for-6 with a grand slam, six RBIs and two runs. All nine Reading starters collect a hit and seven of them have multi-hit games

## Richmond Roundup

Richmond enters today with a 17-21 record, which is fifth in the Southwest Division. The Flying Squirrels were swept on the road at Erie last week, and entered this week's series on an eight-game losing streak, which was snapped on Wednesday night. After this week, Richmond is back on the road at Bowie. Last season, Richmond finished 74-64 and lost to Erie in the first round of the playoffs. Richmond's roster features seven of the Giants top-30 prospects, including: Hayden Birdsong (6), Grant McCray (13), Vaun Brown (15), Victor Bericoto (19), Adrian Sugastey (23), Jairo Pomares (26) and Carson Ragsdale (30).

### Squirrel on the Bump

Righty Matt Frisbee makes the start this afternoon for Richmond. This season, Frisbee is 0-5, with a 7.50 ERA over seven games and six starts (24 IP, 27 H, 18 BB, 29 SO). He last pitched May 12 at Erie, suffering the loss, but allowed just one run over four innigns. Frisbee has suffered losses in five-straight starts. After appearing in his first outing of the season out of the bullpen on Apr. 7, he's made starts in his last six appearances. Frisbee split 2023 between Richmond (27 games) and Triple-A Sacramento (5), going 6-0, with a 5.10 ERA. He also spent most of 2021 and '22 with Richmond, while also appearing in some games with Sacramento in 2021. The Giants drafted the 27-year old in the 15th round of the 2018 Draft out of UNC Greensboro.
