**Today:** The Lugnuts play the last in a six-game series with the archrival Whitecaps at LMCU Ballpark; a victory would give Lansing wins in both games over the weekend and split the series. As it happens, the Nuts split a six-game series against the Whitecaps in April, winning both games over the weekend to achieve the feat. Also, happy Mother's Day!

**Starting Matchup:** In a rematch from the series opener, the Nuts will start right-hander **Jack Perkins**, drafted from Indiana in the fifth round last year, against Australian Whitecaps southpaw **Jack O'Loughlin**. On Tuesday, O'Loughlin blanked the Nuts through five innings on two hits and a walk (70 pitches / 50 strikes), while Perkins was out after three innings, allowing four runs on four hits and one walk with four strikeouts (64 pitches / 45 strikes), allowing a home run to **Eliezer Alfonzo**.

**Yesterday:** Lugnuts 6, Whitecaps 0. Lansing right-hander **Blake Beers** fired seven scoreless innings, combining with **Kumar Nambiar** on a five-hitter, and the Nuts offense scored six runs in the third inning to whitewash the Whitecaps..

**On the Air:** Today's game is available on Bally Live and on MiLB TV with **Dan Hasty** and **Nate Wangler**, and via StreamGuys with **Adam Jaksa** and **Jesse Goldberg-Strassler**.

### LUG•NOTES

**Big Innings:** The Lugnuts' six-run third inning last night was the Nuts' biggest single-inning rally of the year, topping a pair of five-run rallies... that were also coincidentally (or not so coincidentally) against the Whitecaps' staff.

**Beers for Seven:** When **Blake Beers** fired seven innings last night, it tied the Michigan Wolverine's professional career high... set coincidentally (or not so coincidentally) against the West Michigan Whitecaps on June 11, 2022.

**Streaking:** Catcher **Daniel Susac** went 3-for-5 with yesterday, reaching base for the 14th straight game. He is currently slashing .316/.422/.500 in May, raising his overall slash line to .271/.345/.458, an .803 OPS.

**Heading to the Show:** A record-breaking closer at Illinois, reliever **Garrett Acton** was signed as an undrafted free agent following the five-round 2020 draft. He made 14 appearances with the Lugnuts in 2021, posting a 3.63 ERA – and striking out a ridiculous 34 batters compared to four walks in 17 1/3 innings. Today the A's called Acton up to the Major Leagues; he will shortly become the fourth Lugnuts alum to make his MLB debut this season, joining **Ryan Noda**, **Hogan Harris** and **Mason Miller**, all of whom debuted for the A's, and the 177th all-time Nut to reach the Majors.

**Juan-derful:** Reliever **Jorge Juan** leads all Midwest League pitchers (minimum 12 innings) in K/9-IP ratio (17.58) and K rate (45.2%). Juan has whiffed 28 batters this year in just 14 1/3 innings while allowing just one earned run. His 0.63 ERA places him fifth in the league.

**Weekend Delights:** The Nuts have been much more effective this season on Saturday and Sunday than on weekdays, going 7-13 during the week and 8-3 during the weekend (including 5-2 on Sundays). The major key: the Nuts have a 2.83 ERA on Sundays.

**First-Round Pedigrees:** The Lugnuts' roster boasts the A's last two first-round selections. 20-year-old **Max Muncy** was the 25th overall selection in the 2021 draft and enters the season ranked the A's No. 1 shortstop prospect by MLB Pipeline. 21-year-old **Daniel Susac** was taken 19th overall in 2022 and is the A's No. 2 catching prospect behind 1B/C Tyler Soderstrom.

**They Know Their Trade:** Lansing has four players acquired by the Oakland Athletics via trade on its roster: **Christian Fernandez** (Tampa Bay Rays, 7/9/22, for Christian Bethancourt); **Euribiel Ángeles** (San Diego Padres, 4/3/22, for Sean Manaea); **Junior Pérez** (San Diego Padres, 6/30/20, for Jorge Mateo); and **Alexander Campos** (Seattle Mariners, 11/15/17, for Ryon Healy).

**2012:** With the Lugnuts leading 4-0 at Dayton in the bottom of the sixth inning, the Dragons put runners at first and second with none out. Ryan Wright attempts to lay down a sacrifice bunt, but popped it up. Catcher Carlos Perez grabbed it out of the air (one out), fired to second baseman Jon Berti to double off Juan Perez (two outs) and Berti relayed to first baseman K.C. Hobson (three outs). The Nuts won the game, 4-2, to improve to 26-11.

**In a Nutshell:** Jack Perkins makes his fifth Lugnuts start today... one of four 2022 draftees on the roster; the others are 1st-rounder Daniel Susac, 4th-rounder Jacob Watters and 9th-rounder Caeden Trenkle... scouted and signed by Rich Sparks, who also was responsible for scouting/signing Lugnuts teammate Blake Beers and such other notables as Max Schuemann (promoted to Triple-A Las Vegas), Jeff Criswell (traded in the offseason to Colorado), Jack Weisenburger and Nuts teammate OF Clark Elliott... unrelated to former Phillies MiLB pitcher of the same name who split 2022 between Lehigh Valley and Reading... agent is Sam Samardzija, Jeff "Shark" Samardzija's brother.

**Glory Days:** Starred at Kokomo High School, batting .525 as a senior while being ranked Perfect Game's No. 2 prospect in the state of Indiana and No. 1 right-handed pitcher and No. 61 overall in the nation.... all-state running back for Kokomo Wildkats football, earning three letters... taken in the 39th round by the Cubs, but elected to attend college instead.

**Study Skills:** Posted a 4.42 GPA in high school, graduating fifth in his class... graduated in three years from the University of Louisville, earning double major in finance and marketing, before pursuing business management in grad school at Indiana.

**Life in Louisville:** Pitched in 2019 and 2021 for the Cardinals... overall as a freshman, posted 4.18 ERA in 16 appearances, four starts, spanning 32 1/3 innings, with 18 walks and 37 strikeouts... missed 2020 due to undergoing Tommy John; suffered UCL tear while pitching against Clemson in the 2019 ACC Tournament... returned in 2021 and struggled, with 7.31 ERA in 11 games (1 start) over 16 innings, walking 22 and whiffing only 15.

**Off to Bloomington:** Transferred to Indiana in order to work with pitching coach Justin Parker, but Parker left for South Carolina the week after Perkins transferred in... ended up instead working with Dustin Glant, who had been the pitching coach at NYY Triple-A affiliate Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, whom he credits for his development... opened as the no. 2 starter for the Hoosiers in 2022, but moved into the Friday night role for Big Ten play, going 3-4 with a 5.10 ERA in 16 games, team-leading 15 starts... in a team-leading 83 innings, gave up only six homers and struck out 91 while walking 47, hitting 21 batters and tossing 12 wild pitches... 91 strikeouts ranks 10th highest all-time in school history... recorded six quality starts.

**Draft Day:** Selected with the 154th pick of the 2022 draft, Oakland's fifth-round selection and second pitcher taken (after fourth-rounder Jacob Watters)... signed for \$270,750... highest of three Indiana Hoosiers selected in the draft (12th-rounder Bradley Brehmer and 20th-rounder Reese Sharp, both to the Orioles)... the last impactful Indiana Hoosier to reach the Majors was Kyle Schwarber, taken fourth overall in 2014.

**Pro Debut:** Made Minor League Baseball debut on August 6, 2022, in the Arizona Complex League, striking out three while allowing two hits and one run in one inning at the Cubs... worked with catcher Daniel Susac; fellow Lugnut Caeden Trenkle was in right field and leading off in the game... six days later, made Stockton debut with two scoreless innings at San Jose, the first of three straight two-inning scoreless appearances for the Ports in which Perkins allowed only one hit, walked none, and struck out seven in total... whiffed four Giants in two innings on September 2 in fourth Stockton appearance before allowing two runs on two hits and two walks in one inning on September 8 at Modesto, his final appearance of the year... runners attempted two steals and were caught once... lefties hit .182 (2-for-11, 0 BB, 4 K) and righties hit .150 (3-for-20, 2 BB, 7 K).
