Off the Field: Tonight is Marvel Super Heroes Day with a pregame Comic Book Giveaway and postgame LAFCU Fireworks!

Last Night: Dragons 19, Lugnuts 4. Dayton collected 19 hits, including home runs from Victor Acosta and Leo Balcazar, and romped past the Lugnuts on Peanuts Night.

On Deck: Tomorrow is a Capital City Market Kids Day, with the Lugnuts wearing special Lilo & Stitch-inspired uniforms! Kids run the bases after the game, followed by an Extra Inning of free ice cream and music with Big Lug at Capital City Market across Michigan Avenue.

### Lug•Notes

Big Nate: Nate Nankil has been spectacular the month and yesterday was no exception, going 2-for-3 with an HBP to extend his hitting streak to 12 games (23-for-48, 479) and his on-base streak to 18 games (29-for-71, 5 BB, 3 HBP, 408 avg., .468 OBP, .577 slugging). Nankil is 2nd in the Midwest League in batting average (.318), 3rd in base hits (78) and 3rd in doubles (18).

Anything's Possible for KG: Joshua Kuroda-Grauer has hit safely in his last seven games (15-for-34, .441), with a .571 average (8-14) in this series. Kuroda-Grauer is hitting .390 (16-41) in the season series against Dayton, the Nuts' far and away best hitter vs. Dragons pitching.

The Perks of the Trade: In his second career Major League outing, Jack Perkins fired 3 1/3 shutout innings to pick up the save as the Athletics defeated the Yankees, 7-0, earlier today at Yankee Stadium, Perkins, who has recorded 6 1/3 shutout innings to open his MLB career is one of five Lugnuts to have made his MLB debut this season and 198 Lugnuts to reach the Majors all time (not including team broadcaster Adam Jaksa, who called the second and third innings of the Athletics/Tigers series finale Thursday on A's radio).

Prospecting: The Lugnuts have eight of MLB Pipeline's Top 30 A's prospects: No. 6 Tommy White, No. 9 Joshua Kuroda-Grauer, No. 11 Steven Echavarria, No. 15 Ryan Lasko, No. 16 Rodney Green, Jr., No. 26 Nate Nankil, No. 29 Tzu-Chen Sha and No. 30 Wei-En Lin.

Offensive Minded: The first four games of this series have seen a combined 73 runs and 98 hits, an average of 18 runs and 24.5 hits per game between the two teams. The 19 runs scored by the Dragons yesterday were the most allowed by the Lugnuts in one game since... West Michigan's 20-6 victory on June 13, two weeks prior.

Midsummer Classic: Major League Baseball All-Star Game voting has advanced to phase 2, with three former Lugnuts (Toronto first baseman Vladimir Guerrero, Jr., A's shortstop Jacob Wilson and Toronto catcher Alejandro Kirk) each making the final two at his position. A run-off vote will determine the starter between Guerrero and the Yankees' Paul Goldschmidt, Wilson and the Royals' Bobby Witt, Jr., and Kirk and the Mariners' Cal Raleigh. A little more on Wilson, who played 23 games for the Lugnuts in 2023: he ranks 2nd in the Majors to Aaron Judge in both batting average (.340) and base hits (106) and is on pace to become the first ever rookie to start the All-Star Game at shortstop for the American League. The last Athletics starting shortstop in the All-Star Game was Bert Campaneris in 1974.

Among the Best in the Minors: Lansing first baseman T.J. Schofield-Sam ranks 2nd in all of Minor League Baseball with 22 HBPs and 5th with a .339 batting average; closer Mark Adamiak is tied for 1st in MiLB in saves (12); 2025 Opening Day starter Gage Jump is tied for 1st with 2021 Lugnut Jack Cushing in wins (8); and 2023 Lugnut Colby Thomas is 1st in MiLB in runs batted in (70). Jump is currently playing for Double-A Midland while Cushing and Thomas are with Triple-A Las Vegas.

A Little More on T.J.: Schofield-Sam leads the Midwest League in batting average (.339) and base hits (85) and ranks 2nd in OPS (.917), total bases (125) and OBP (.419), 3rd in slugging (.498) and tied for 3rd in runs scored (48).

The Men in the Pen: The Nuts have four of the most heavily used relievers in the MWL. Blaze Pontes leads the league with 25 appearances, while Mark Adamiak, Yehizon Sanchez and Hunter Breault are tied for 2nd with 24 appearances.

No Whiffs: The Lugnuts are the only team in full-season MiLB with fewer than 500 strikeouts (498), averaging only 6.8 K per game.

Danner knocked solo home runs down the left-field line in the third inning and down the right-field line in the fourth inning, erasing an early 2-0 deficit.

No-Hit History: On June 13, 2024, tossed five hitless innings, walking two and striking out six, before handing the baton to Grant Judkins (2 2/3) and then Colton Johnson (1 1/3) as part of the Lugnuts' 8-0 no-hitter of the Cedar Rapids Kernels, the 4th no-hitter in franchise history and the first home no-hitter since April 2003.

Jupiter? How did Jake's hometown receive its name? The Hobe tribe lived in the area; a Spanish mapmaker miswrote their name as Jobe, which was then miswritten again as Jove, which was then mistranslated to Jupiter. Jupiter is located on the eastern coast of Florida in Palm Beach County on the Atlantic Ocean. Burt Reynolds was born in Lansing and died in Jupiter.

Hometown Hero: Started four years for Jupiter High School ("Warriors," wearing green and gold)... totaled 229 strikeouts, 1.49 ERA and 1.13 WHIP... two-time FHSAA All-State... honored twice as the 9A Player of the Year... also from Jupiter H.S.: Miles Mikolas and Dante Bichette (but not son Bo, who was homeschooled and played for Lakewood High School in St. Petersburg)... the Garland family was originally from New England before moving to Florida shortly before Jake was born.
