Long-Awaited Return: The last time Syracuse played in Jacksonville was from July 29th to August 1st, 1968. The Syracuse Chiefs played the Jacksonville Mets. Jacksonville was the Triple-A affiliate for the New York Mets from 1966-1968 and won the 1968 International League title.

Hitting Machines: **Drew Gilbert** has hits in five straight games, going 5-for-18 with four walks, a home run, a double, and an .891 OPS. Gilbert has reached base in 13 consecutive games and in 14 of the 15 games he's played in this season.

Donovan Walton is 7-for-21 in his last five games with two home runs, and two doubles.

Streaking: **Gilberto Celestino** has reached base in six straight games with hits in five of those games. During this stretch, Celestino is 7-for-20 (.350) with three walks.

Boom or Bust: Only six of Syracuse's first 34 games have been decided by one run. Every other matchup has been decided by two runs or more. The average scoring margin through the first 34 games is 4.5 runs. The Mets are 3-3 this season in one-run games. In 2024, Syracuse had the second-best win percentage in the International League, winning 60% of games decided by one run (18-12 record). Only Rochester with 61.8% (21-13) had a better record in one-run games last year.

Untimely Hitting: Syracuse is hitting .226 with runners in scoring position this season which ranks 15th in the International League. Syracuse is hitting .214 with runners in scoring position and two outs, ranking 15th. The Mets are hitting .306 (11-for-36) with the bases loaded with 37 RBIs, nine walks, and 12 strikeouts.

Power Surge: Syracuse catcher **Jakson Reetz** hit two home runs on April 27th against Worcester and had seven RBIs. Reetz is the 11th Syracuse baseball player since 1961 to have at least seven RBIs in a game and the first since **Michael Aubrey** on May 14, 2011. **Otto Velez** holds the franchise record with eight RBIs in a game on May 17, 1973. Sunday was the second game this season that Reetz hit two homers in. He also hit two home runs April 15th vs. Buffalo.
