### Snapping a Skid

Today, Reading plays the fourth of six games on the road at the Portland Sea Dogs as the R-Phils look to stop a two-game slide. Looking ahead, Portland comes to Reading July 14-16 and again from September 5-10. The R-Phils return to Portland from June 20-25. Last season, Reading won the season series over the Sea Dogs 10-8. The team's split the one series at Hadlock Field in 2022.

### Close But Not Enough

Reading kept it close in a 5-2 loss to Portland yesterday afternoon. The R-Phils struck first for the 8th time in 12 games, but could not maintain the lead. Reading is now 2-6 this season when scoring first in games. Portland's offense was jumpstarted by a long home run from Alex Binelas, that landed at the 12-yard line of the adjacent football field. Reading starter Tyler Phillips was also ejected from the game after arguing a close call at home plate.

### Road Blues

While still early, Reading's offense has performed drastically different when at home, versus on the road. In six games away from FirstEnergy Stadium, the Fightin Phils are hitting .199, which compares to .303 at home. The R-Phils are also scoring two more runs per game at home, while additionally having picked up 23 extra base hits (eight home runs) at the friendly confines, compared to just 10 (two home runs) while away.

### Fielding Finding its Footing

After a struggle in the field to open the season, Reading's defense has been a bright spot these last few games. After ranking at the bottom of the league in fielding percentage, the R-Phils now rank 8th in the Eastern League. The R-Phils have now gone four-straight games without a defensive error.

### Around the Organization

The big club, Philadelphia Phillies were shutout at home last night to the Colorado Rockies 5-0. Philadelphia and the Rockies play the second of four games tonight at 7:05. Lehigh Valley fell 7-4 to Worcester last night, but former R-Phil Vito Friscia lifted two home runs in the game. Jersey Shore topped Aberdeen 6-3 and Clearwater was victorious over Tampa, 6-3.

### Win the Battle Johan

After a slow start to the season, R-Phils center fielder Johan Rojas has been red hot. Over his last 10 games, Rojas is hitting .310 and also owns a six-game hitting streak, with hits in 8/9. The Phillies sixth-ranked prospect has led off and played in center field for every game this season.

### This Day in Baseballtown History

**April 21, 1999:** At Reading, Pat Burrell hits his first Double-A HR and Larry Huff scores four times in a 9-5 win over Akron. Burrell would go on to hit a total of 28 home runs during the season.

### Watching The Dogs

After taking two of the series' first three games, Portland enters today's matchup 9-3 on the season and leads the Eastern League Northeast Division. The Sea Dogs are coming off a series win over New Hampshire, where Portland took four-of-six games on the road. After this series, the Sea Dogs take the long trip south and west for six games at Erie and then immediately six games at Akron.

### Playing Fetch

Tonight's Sea Dogs starter is righty CJ Liu. Liu is making his third start of the season. He owns a 1-0 record with 3.00 ERA over nine innings pitched. Additionally, Liu has allowed five walks and struck out 10 batters. Liu went five shutout innings at New Hampshire last Saturday, allowing five hits, three walks and picked up eight strikeouts. It was the fifth time of his career striking out more than right hitters in a game.
