THURSDAY'S HIGHLIGHTS: The New Hampshire Fisher Cats never led on Thursday night and were defeated by the Hartford Yard Goats 8-4 at Delta Dental Stadium. Catcher Kekai Rios drove in a game-high two RBIs for the Fisher Cats in the fifth inning and eighth inning. It was his first RBIs at the Double-A level in 17 career Double-A games. In the fifth, Dylan Rock singled to left, driving in Luis De Los Santos and after an error on Hartford left-fielder Colin Simpson, it allowed Miguel Hiraldo to score and Rock to advance to third on the play. Rock went 2-for-3 on the night, his second multihit game against the Yard Goats this series. Hiraldo also extended his hit streak to seven games, which is the longest active Fisher Cat hit streak this season. He went 2-for-4 on the night, his third multi-hit performance over the last five games. On the mound, Jimmy Robbins got the start for New Hampshire and struck out five in four innings of work, allowing seven hits, three runs and two walks, receiving the loss. He has now struck out five hitters in each of his last three starts.

GOING STREAKING: Notable current on-base streaks include Leo Jimenez who has now reached base in all nine games played. Steward Berroa is on a nine-game on-base streak after singling yesterday. Miguel Hiraldo has hit safely in seven consecutive games after starting out the season 2-for-18 at the dish and has reached base in eight straight contests. He now has the longest hit streak on the team. Zach Britton is also on a five-game hit streak and is hitting 6-for-14 at Delta Dental Stadium.

ADAM FEVER: Friday starter Adam Kloffenstein makes his fourth start of the season and his third home start. The righthander is coming off his best outing yet at Somerset last Saturday when he pitched five strong innings, allowing just one run on two hits, no walks and a season-high eight strikeouts, receiving a rain-shortened win. In two home starts vs Portland last homestand, he struck out four batters each in seven total innings of work.

DAMIANO-B-P: IF Damiano Palmegiani is back at the top of the Eastern League leaderboard in on-base percentage. The corner infielder is getting on-base at a .443 clip, sixth-best in the league. The Blue Jays No. 29 prospect has reached base in an impressive 14 of 16 games played this season. Palmegiani has the same number of walks (16) as strikeouts.

MARTINEZ MAGIC: IF Orelvis Martinez is ranked the No. 4 prospect in the Blue Jays system to start the 2023 season. The 21-year-old Dominican Republic native currently leads the Fisher Cats with three home runs to start the season after hitting a team-high 30 home runs last season, breaking the Fisher Cats single-season record of 27 home runs previously set by Chip Cannon (2006) and Eric Thames (2010). Martinez was second in the Eastern League in home runs and had four multi-homer games.

CESAR MARTIN LEADS FIELD STAFF: Manager Cesar Martin is leading the Fisher Cats for a third straight season. Pitching coach Drew Hayes and hitting coach Mitch Huckabay are in their first season in New Hampshire, while position coach Chris Schaeffer returns for his third season in Manchester. The Fisher Cats hit a team-record 166 home runs in 2022.

THIS DAY IN FISHER CATS HISTORY (April 28, 2017). The Fisher Cats opened a series in Binghamton with a 7-5 win. Emilio Guerrero capped a four-run top of the first with his first home run. Ryan McBroom also drove in two runs for New Hampshire. Shane Dawson allowed three runs over six innings to pick up his first win.

MANCHESTER-BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: Toronto (16-9) opens a home series with Seattle (11-14) tonight. Alek Manoah will start for the Blue Jays. Fisher Cat alum Bo Bichette is currently 5th in the Majors with a .340 batting average. Vlad Guerrero Jr. is hitting .333, which is tied for ninth....Triple-A Buffalo (9-14) lost at Gwinnett 6-1. Spencer Horwitz homered to account for the Bisons run...High-A Vancouver (6-8) lost at home to Eugene 11-7...Single-A Dunedin (9-9) won 9-5 over Bradenton. Hagen Danner made his first rehab appearance, allowing one run in 1.0 IP. He did have two strikeouts. Danner, on the Blue Jays 40-man roster, started last year with New Hampshire appearing in four April games before an injury sidelined him for the rest of the regular season. He did make eight appearances in the Arizona Fall League in 2022. Yesterday's appearance was his first this season. Danner was a 2nd round pick in 2017 by the Jays out of high school (Huntington Beach, Calif.).

COMING UP: The Fisher Cats continue their two-week homestand this week vs Hartford. Promotions include Gatos Feroces de New Hampshire night, and a Phone Grip Giveaway, courtesy of Coke Northeast.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned the win last Saturday 3-1 at Somerset in a game shortened by rain to five innings. He went the distance, allowing two hits, walking one and striking out eight.

v. HARTFORD - Made three starts last season against Hartford. Started twice on the July 4 homestand vs. Hartford. Beat the Yard Goats 5-1 on August 16 at Dunkin Donuts Park when he worked five scoreless frames.

2023: Earned a complete game victory 4/22 at Somerset in game shortened to five innings. Had eight strikeouts in a 3-1 win.... Made first two starts on season opening homestand against Portland.

2022: Earned first Double-A win with 5.0 IP scoreless 8/16 at Hartford. Pitched season-high six innings in first quality start vs. Erie 8/10..Struck out 10 Sea Dogs in New Hampshire's 5-3 win July 23, but did not earn decision as Fisher Cats won the game late... Made Double-A debut in a relief outing in Erie May 21....Opened season with Adv. A Vancouver, going 0-2 with a 3.81 ERA in six starts. Struck out 30 in 25 IP.

2021: Kloffenstein spent the entire season with Class A Advanced Vancouver, making a career-high 23 starts. He pitched 101.1 innings and had a 7-7 record with a 6.22 ERA. He walked 61 batters and struck out 107.

2019: Had a 4-4 record and a 2.24 ERA with the Vancouver Canadians, who were the Class A short season affiliate of the Blue Javs in 2019. Kloff made 13 starts and threw 64.1 innings, 23 BB, 64 K. WHIP 1.09. .204 average against. 2018: Pitched with the GCL Blue Jays at the rookie level. (2.0 IP/2 starts)

Obtained: Kloffenstein was selected in the third round and 88th overall in the 2018 draft. He was drafted out of Magnolia High School, where he was teammates with Blue Jays prospect Jordan Groshans. He was originally committed to play at TCU and received a \$2.45 million signing bonus. Personal: Was ranked the No. 11 prospect in the Toronto system at the beginning of 2022. The slider is Kloffenstein's highest-rated pitch.
