Hartford used three runs in the second and two in the fifth en route to a 6-4 win on Friday night. Kolby Allard started for Reading and took the loss, allowing four runs on seven hiits over four innings, with three strikeouts. Efrain Contreras pitched in relief, allowing two runs over four innings, with four strikeouts. Reading matched a season-high with five doubles, with two of them coming from Trevor Schwecke. Schwecke also drove in two runs for Reading in the game. With the loss, Reading has dropped its fifth series of the season, and now holds a 2-5-2 record in its series this season.

Home Sick

Reading has performed vastly better at America's Classic Ballpark than on the road this season. The Fightin Phils hold a 14-10 record at home, compared to just 6-19 on the road. This comes after a 2023 where Reading was 36-33 away from home, and just 23-44 at FirstEnergy Stadium. To compate, Reading is hitting 251 at home, to .205 on the road, while averaging 5.2 runs per games at home, while scoring just 3.6 per game on the road. The Fightin Phils have also hit double the amount of home runs at home, than on the road. The R-Phils have hit 28 (1.2/game) at home and 14 (0.6/game) away from home.

So That's May

The Fightin Phils finsihed the month of May with a 10-17 record, after going 10-12 in April. Reading finished May with a .241 batting average, which ranked as fifth in the Eastern League. They also hit 24 home runs and had 75 extra-ase hits. On the pitching side, the R-Phils posted a 5.05 ERA, which ranked as the worst in the Eastern League over the past month. Reading had an 8-4 record at home in May, compared to a 2-13 record on the road in May,

Rodriguez Rolling

Jose Rodriguez added another hit on Friday night to increase his hitting streak to 10 games. It is the longest hitting streak by a Fightin Phil this season. Over his 10-game hitting streak, Rodrigez is slashing .415/.429/.610, with a 1.039 OPS dating back to May 16. He's struck out just once in 42 plate appearances over that streak and has five multi-hit games, including two three-hit games. Rodriguez finshed May with a .347 batting average, along with two home runs, 10 extra-base hits, 10 RBI and 18 runs scored. He struck out just five times in 80 May plate appearnaces, which is 6.3% of at bats. His 10-game hit streak currently ranks as the second-highest active streak in the Eastern League, trailing Portland's Blaze Jordan (17 games). It's also tied for the fifth-longest in the league this season.

S&S Show (Simmons and Schwecke)

Kendall Simmons and Trevor Schwecke combined for another strong night at the plate on Friday. Simmons had another hit and run scored, while Schwecke had two doubled and two RBI. Schwecke has hits in three-of-his-last four games, and is hitting .400, with one homer (three XBH) and four RBI over that stretch. Simmons has hits in six-of-his-last-seven games, and is hitting .350, with three homers and six RBI over that stretch. Simmons has enjoyed facing Hartford this season, as he has a team-high .429 average (6-14) against the Yard Goats, with three XBH, three RBI across five games against Hartford.
