Gwinnett is +9 (40-31) in those games, including three walk-off wins: 6/15 vs. Nashville (Drake Baldwin bases-loaded walk for 4-3 win in 10 innings), 6/29 vs. Memphis (Luke Waddell 2-run single for 5-4 win), and 7/12 vs. Jacksonville (Ryan Casteel 2-run homer for 7-6 win).

NACHO SUPREME: Nacho Alvarez Jr. combined to go 5-for-7 (1 2B, 1 HR, 2 R, 2 RBI) in last night's doubleheader. He has hit safely in 21 of 27 games (77.8%) during his Triple-A debut with Gwinnett, batting .342 (38-for-111, 6 LOGUE LOCKED IN: Zach Logue tossed 4.0 perfect innings efforts. The Stripers are 5-2 (.714) when he homers.

BALDY ON BASE: Drake Baldwin went 1-for-6 with a pair of walks in the doubleheader last night, extending his on-base streak to 18 games. He's batting .313 (21-for-67, 3 2B, 4 HR, 12 R, 11 RBI, 19 BB, 1.002 OPS) on the streak since 6/21. Baldwin has hit safely in 22 of 29 games (75.9%) with the Stripers since making his Triple-A debut in 2023, batting .304 (34-for-112, 3 2B, 7 HR, 16 R, 19 RBI, .944 OPS). Gwinnett is 6-1 (.857) when he homers.

#### MANAGER KANEKOA TEXEIRA

Kanekoa Texeira is in his first season as the manager of the Stripers in 2024 ... Named the eighth manager in Gwinnett history on 1/25/24 ... Is the second former Gwinnett player to manage the club (pitched for the G-Braves from 2014-16), joining Matt Tuiasosopo ... 2023: Debuted as a Double-A manager with Mississippi, going 62-75 ... Under his leadership, the M-Braves led the Southern League in lowest ERA (3.94) and finished second in both WHIP (1.36) and BAA (.236) ... 2021-22: Managed High-A Rome, going 56-60 (6th in High-A East) in his first season and 74-54 (3rd in South Atlantic League) in his second season ... Rome made the SAL Playoffs in 2022, losing in the first round to Bowling Green ... 2017-19: Served as a pitching coach with Rookie Danville (2017-18) and Class-A Rome (2019) ... 2006-16: Selected in the 22nd round in 2006 by the Chicago White Sox and went on to play 11 professional seasons with six different organizations including the White Sox, New York Yankees, Kansas City Royals, Seattle Mariners, Cincinnati Reds, and Atlanta Braves ... Pitched in the Majors with Seattle (2010) and Kansas City (2010-11), going 1-1 with a 4.66 ERA in 49 relief appearances.

**IDDAY'S START:** AJ Smith-Shawver makes his 10th start with Gwinnett this season in the finale of a three-game series vs. Charlotte ... It is his 12th start overall this year and second with the Stripers since 5/18 at Memphis.

**PROSPECTING:** Smith-Shawver is currently ranked the Atlanta Braves' No. 1 prospect by MLB.com ... He is also ranked No. 67 on the MLB.com Top 100 Prospects list.

**LAST TIME DUT:** Started on 7/14 vs. Jacksonville, his first outing with Gwinnett since 5/18 ... Took his third loss with the Stripers despite working 3.2 no-hit innings (2 R, 2 ER, 1 HB, 1 BB, 3 SO) ... Opened with 3.0 scoreless frames before allowing a walk and a hit batter to start the fourth ... Exited in a scoreless game with two outs and runners on second and third ... **Allan Winans** allowed both inherited runners to score to Smith-Shawver's line on a single by Griffin Conine ... Gwinnett went on to lose 2-1.

**GWINNETT CAREER:** Makes his 20th career start with the Stripers today ... Is 3-5 with a 5.00 ERA (42 ER in 75.2 IP), 1.32 WHIP, .203 BAA, and two quality starts since 2023 ... When he made his Triple-A debut on 5/19/23 at Memphis, he was the second-youngest starting pitcher (20 years, 5 months, 29 days) in Gwinnett history, behind only **Julio Teheran** (20 years, 2 months, 12 days on 4/8/11 at DUR).

**IMPRESSIVE VELO:** Has thrown four of the top five fastest pitches recorded by a Striper this season, all 99.7 mph or above ... His 100.0 mph fastball to Durham's Jonathan Aranda on 5/1 is the second-fastest pitch thrown by a Gwinnett hurler this year, trailing only **Daysbel Hernandez's** 100.3 mph fastball to Jacksonville's Javier Sanoja on 7/13.

**2024 SEASON:** Was on Gwinnett's Opening Night roster ... **4/5-5/18:** Made eight starts with the Stripers (1-2, 6.10 ERA, 1.52 WHIP, 250 BAA) ... **5/23:** Recalled by Atlanta and started that night at the Chicago Cubs ... **5/24-7/9:** Was on the Braves' 15-day injured list (strained left oblique muscle) ... **7/3:** Assigned to High-A Rome for rehab and made one start ... **7/9:** Activated by Atlanta, but did not pitch ... **7/10:** Optioned back to Gwinnett.

MLB CAREER: Has made seven appearances (6 starts) for the Atlanta Braves since 2023 ... Is 1-0 with a 3.64 ERA (12 ER in 29.2 IP), 1.11 WHIP, and .183 BAA.

- 2023: After just 28 career MiLB starts, had his contract selected by the Braves on 5/30 ...
   Over four stints (5/30-6/25, 7/30, 9/10-12, 9/28-10/1), went 1-0 with a 4.26 ERA (12 ER in 25.1 IP), 1.11 WHIP, and .183 BAA in six games (5 starts) ... 6/15 vs. COL: Earned his first MLB win (5.2 IP, 6 H, 3 R, 3 ER, 2 HR, 1 BB, 6 SO in 8-3 triumph).
- <u>2023 Postseason:</u> Named to Atlanta's NLDS roster on 10/7 ... **10/11 at PHI:** Made his MLB Postseason debut in relief in NLDS Game 3, pitched 2.2 innings and yielded three runs on solo homers (Trea Turner, Nick Castellanos, Brandon Marsh) in a 10-2 loss.
