LAST GAME

The Bowie Baysox dropped their third-straight game to the Somerset Patriots on Saturday night, by a 10-3 final. Somerset jumped out to an early 3-0 lead on a pair of first inning home runs from Ben Rice (two-run shot) and Elijah Dunham (solo shot). Bowie would battle back to tie the game with two home runs of its own - a two-run shot from Donta' Williams in the second, before a game-tying solo blast from Billy Cook in the third. From there, it was all Patriots, as Somerset took the lead in the fourth on an Aaron Palensky sacrifice fly. The Patriots then tacked on four runs in the sixth with a bases-clearing double from Jeisson Rosario, who was plated on a Jasson Dominguez double later in the frame. Dominguez tacked on another RBI double in the eighth, prior to scoring himself on a Tyler Hardman single.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Somerset Patriots enter today with a record of 57-36 - the second-best mark in the Eastern League. The Double-A affiliate of the New York Yankees, Somerset has already clinched a postseason berth as first half champions in the Northeast division, but have a current record of 15-10 in the second half. The Patriots took four of six from the Baysox at Prince George's Stadium to open the second half a little under a month ago. Somerset continues to hold the best ERA (3.67) in the league, with the most strikeouts (970) as well. Offensively, they lead the league in home runs (143) and walks (461). The Patriots' roster includes eight of the Yankees' top 30 prospects, per MLB Pipeline, highlighted by OF Jasson Dominguez (No. 1 NYY / No. 41 overall), INF Trey Sweeney (No. 5 NYY), OF Elijah Dunham (No. 16 NYY), and IF Tyler Hardman (No. 18 NYY).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-hander Matt Sauer is scheduled to take the ball for Somerset in the series finale. The Yankees' No. 20 prospect, per MLB Pipeline, Sauer missed the majority of the first half of the season with the Patriots after hitting the injured list due to a right-forearm strain. The right-hander has settled in with Somerset after struggling out of the gate to the tune of nine earned runs across 12.1 innings through his first three starts with the Patriots, including a season-high five runs on six hits through three frames against the Baysox back on 6/30. Sauer has allowed just one earned run in each of his last two outings, tossing five innings his last time out this past Sunday against Hartford, following a rehab outing from Nestor Cortes. A second round pick of New York in 2017 out of Righetti High School in Santa Maria, California, Sauer features a low-90s fastball, mid-80s slider, high-70s curveball, and a mid-80s changeup.

AVOIDING THE TRAFFIC

While the Baysox sit with the fourth-most home runs in the Eastern League at 101, Bowie has struggled with the timeliness of its long balls. The Baysox have hit the third-most solo shots in the league at 61 total. However, in terms of portions, 60.4% of Bowie's home runs have been solo blasts. That is the highest portion of any team in the Eastern League.

ONE RUN REBOUND

Despite falling on Thursday, the Baysox have still turned a corner in one-run games this season. Thursday night was Bowie's first one-run loss in its last eight such contests. Dating back to June 2, the Baysox have fared incredibly well in one-run games, going 13-4. Bowie is 19-13 overall in games decided by one run in 2023, after going just 21-29 last season, giving them the most one-run losses in Minor League Baseball in 2022, along with the second-lowest winning percentage in the Eastern League in such games.

CONQUERING THE SUNDAY SCARIES??

The Baysox have struggled in total this season on Sundays, going just 5-9. Bowie has the second-fewest Sunday wins in the Eastern League, along with the second-lowest winning percentage (.357). However, Bowie has righted the ship as of late. The Baysox have won their last four series finales entering today's clash with the Patriots, including three on Sunday (along with Monday, 7/3 vs Somerset).

HOME RUN HOBBLES

Baysox pitching has struggled to contain a Somerset staff that leads the Eastern League with 143 home runs as a team this season. As a staff, Bowie has allowed 115 home runs - third-most in the league. Specifically against the Patriots, Baysox arms have surrendered 22 long balls - tied for the most the Patriots have hit against any opponent, despite Bowie playing fewer games against the Patriots than five of Somerset's additional eight opponents on the season. Eastern League home run leader Tyler Hardman has hit seven of his 26 home runs against the Baysox - more than against any other opponent.

CAREER NOTES

- 2022: Had a stellar month of May, where he pitched to a 0.49 ERA and held opponents to a .098 average - was named South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Month.
- Struggled in the two months afterward, moving on-and-off the 7-day injured list while posting a 6.57 ERA through June and July, before being placed on the injured list for the remainder of the season on August 4. Control issues also resurfaced in June in July with twice as many walks in each month as he had in April or May.
- College: Transferred to UT-Arlington from Weatherford College in 2020, after pitching at Weatherford for two seasons.

NOTES BY OUTING*

- 4/12 Pitched in relief of Chayce McDermott, allowed a solo home run in his third inning of work after striking out two batters to start the frame.
- 4/19 First start. Struck out the first four batters faced, and retired the first nine. Did not allow a hit until the fifth inning, where he allowed two runs.
- 4/26 Pitched in relief of Connor Gillispie. Retired the first two batters faced, but still allowed a run in the same inning. Third inning of work struggled, allowing a walk and two doubles with one out.
- 5/3 Second start, allowed a leadoff home run in the second inning, and five runs in the fourth on four-straight baserunners and another homer.
- 5/9 Relieved Houston Roth. Single and two walks to open his second inning of work eventually led to two runs.
- 5/14 Third start. Gave up two extra-base hits and had no strikeouts.
- 5/21 Relieved Justin Armbruster. Walked two batters in first inning of work, and allowed an unearned run on a passed ball, but still struck out three in the frame.
- 5/26 Fourth start. Earned first win behind five no-hit innings. Was the second-night that the Bowie starter had thrown five hitless innings to begin the game (McDermott) First reliever gave up a base hit to the first batter faced.
- 6/1 Relieved Houston Roth. Allowed go-ahead two-run home run in the sixth, and another solo later in the frame, and one more in the seventh. Career high three home runs.
- 6/7 Struck out two batters in the first inning, but allowed four straight batters to reach with two outs in the second, including a two-run home run. Bowie lead 7-0, but only won 8-7.
- 6/13 Second pitch thrown was hit for a home run, allowed two more runs to score on two walks and two hits in the first.
- 6/18 After starting ahead 0-2 on the first batter, opened with back-to-back walks, and allowed a three-run home run. Walked two more batters after the home run.
- 6/24 Struck out the first four batters faced, but only one more in the fourth inning. Only allowed baserunners in two innings, while stranding a runner at third in both frames.
- 7/1 Walked three batters in the first inning, but reset to retire seven straight before allowing a leadoff home run and two runs in the fourth inning.
- 7/6 Only run scored following a single, balk, wild pitch, and groundout.
- 7/19 Struck out at least one batter in every inning. Did not allow a runner to reach second base.
- 7/25 Third pitch was hit for a solo home run. Allowed three-consecutive baserunners in the fourth inning for a second run.

Johnson's playing career most recently landed him in independent ball this past season with the Kane County Cougars. Johnson also played two seasons collegiately at Florida State.	Forrest Herrmann joins the Bowie Baysox coaching staff in his second season with the Orioles organization. He served as the pitching coach of the Aberdeen Iron-Birds during the 2022 season, helping Aberdeen clinch a first-half division title and make it all the way to game three of the South Atlantic League Championship Series. Herrmann guided one of the best staffs in the SAL last season, which led the league in strikeouts. Prior to joining the Orioles organization, Herrmann spent two seasons as a pitching coach within the Cincinnati Reds organization. Herrmann also served as a pitching strategist in 2019 for the Seattle Mariners organization at their facility in Peoria. Herrmann also worked with current Orioles' left-hander John Means at P3 Premier Pitching Performance center in Missouri. However, DeJohn also received a promotion this season and will also serve as the Minor League Infield Coordinator at all levels. DeJohn has been a part of the Orioles' staff since November 2019. Prior to joining the organization, DeJohn had an extensive background in the college ranks. He served as an assistant coach at the University of Memphis between 2017 and 2019 and was an assistant at the University of Hartford the two seasons prior. DeJohn played at Western Connecticut State from 2003-2008.	Ryan Goll, much like pitching coach Forrest Herrmann, is making a jump from High-A in 2023. Goll serves as the Baysox development coach for his first season in Bowie, after filling the same role for Aberdeen last season.
