The game was called in the bottom of the eighth due to inclement weather. It's the fourth shutout of the year thrown by New Hampshire pitching. Fisher Cat arms held Akron to just three hits while combining for 11 strikeouts. On the mound, left-hander <b>Jimmy Robbins</b> got the start and threw one of his best outings of the year. The 25-year-old threw five scoreless innings, allowing two hits and four walks while striking out a season-high eight. New Hampshire scored their lone runs of the game in the third off Akron left-handed starter Doug Nikhazy. <b>Leo Jimenez</b> grounded an RBI double down the third-base line, his 12 <sup>th</sup> extra base hit since being activated off the injured list on May 23. <b>Orelvis Martinez</b> drove in his 43 <sup>rd</sup> RBI of the year with a sacrifice fly to right, bringing home Jimenez. Right-hander <b>Troy Watson</b> threw a scoreless eighth with a pair of strikeouts to earn the save.

On Thursday, the Fisher Cats hit six home runs in the doubleheader, four in the first game and two in the second game. Zac Cook had two homers on the day while Will Robertson, Leo Jimenez, Riley Tirotta and Damiano Palmegiani all hit one each. The Fisher Cats set a team record with 166 homers in 2022, led by Orelvis Martinez with 30.

Horwitz, 25, played in 74 games for the Fisher Cats over the 2021 and 2022 seasons. In 70 Double-A games last year, he slashed .297/.413/.517 with 10 home runs, 39 RBIs, and 30 extra-base hits. The Timonium, Md., native was selected by the Blue Jays in the 24th round of the 2019 MLB Draft out of Radford University. Taylor, 24, appeared in 87 games for the Fisher Cats in 2021. He slashed .294/.385/.503 with 16 home runs, 52 RBIs, 34 extra-base hits, and 30 stolen bases. Last year on August 2, Taylor was traded to the Royals along with former Fisher Cats pitcher Max Castillo for infielder Whit Merrifield. Taylor was added to Kansas City's 40-man roster in November, and
