LAST TIME OUT: Hendry had his longest outing since returning from the IL last Friday night against Asheville, completing 3.0 innings while allowing no runs, one hit, one walk and striking out two. He combined with four Renegades relievers to throw the 19th shutout of the season for Hudson Valley. Hendry only allowed two balls to be hit out of the infield, and his lone hit was an infield single by Narbe Cruz in the top of the second.

2024 HIGHLIGHTS:

- Began the season in on the Renegades Break Camp Roster.
- Struck out three batters in his first professional inning on 4/12 (G2) @ Rome - got Ambioris Tavares and Sabin Ceballos swinging to start the inning, then caught Bryson Worrell looking to end the inning after a Ethan Workinger double. Hendry struck out eight in his first pro outing and picked up the win.
- Placed on the 7-day Injured List on April 26... transferred to the 60-day Injured List on 8/1... reinstated from the 60-day Injured List on 8/22, missing nearly four months.

2023 HIGHLIGHTS:

- Drafted by the Yankees in the 10th round of the 2023 MLB Draft, but did not pitch after the draft.

- Full name is Brian Christopher Hendry.
- Played collegiately for four years at St. John's University (2019-22) and one at Oklahoma State (2023), going 5-4 with a 6.37 ERA, 87.2 IP, 101 H, 72 R, 62 ER, 43 BB, 97 K and 7 HR in 36 games (14 starts) between the schools.
- Missed the 2022 season at St. John's with an injury.
- In 2023 at OSU, went 2-1 with a 6.63 ERA in 36.2 IP and 51 K in 16 appearances.
- In a start on 3/11 vs Utah Tech struck out 13 batters across 6.0 IP, picking up his first win.
- Played high school baseball at Shawnee HS in New Jersey, the same school attended by 11-year MLB LHP Sean Doolittle. Hendry was a two-time conference champion with the Shawnee Renegades.
