**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels beat the SeaWolves, 8-7, for their first win this year at UPMC Park. **Ismael Munguia** hit a solo home run on the first pitch of the game. In the second, Brady Allen hit a two-run homer to give the SeaWolves a 2-1 lead. **Diego Velasquez** moved Richmond back in front with a two-run single in the third. The SeaWolves scored three runs in the fifth to take a 5-3 lead. In the sixth, Munguia hit a two-run single to even the score. **Matt Higgins** drove a bases-clearing, three-run double in the top of the eighth with two outs to move the Flying Squirrels ahead, 8-5. The SeaWolves scored a run in the eighth and another in the ninth to close within a run, but **Cameron Cotter** stranded runners on second and third to end the game and pick up his third save. **Will Bednar** picked up his first Double-A win.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels face the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers, in the fourth of a six-game series. This is the final series between the two teams this year. The Flying Squirrels were swept in a six-game series at UPMC Park back in May. The SeaWolves won four-of-six at The Diamond from May 28-June 2.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** dropped back-to-back games to open the series after going 4-1 in their previous five games since Wednesday after losing their previous six straight from August 14-20. After batting a league-best .300 (70-for-233) and scoring 40 runs over a six-game span from August 18-26, the Flying Squirrels were held to one run and three hits in each of the first two games of this series before collecting eight runs and 14 hits on Thursday. Since August 18 in 10 games, the Flying Squirrels hit 10 homers. They had only hit six home runs in their previous 19 games from July 27-August 17.

**THE SEAWOLVES** clinched the Southwest Division's first-half title with a 38-29 record to book their third consecutive postseason appearance. They are in second place in the division standings in the second half. Erie's roster includes three of Baseball America's top-30 Tigers prospects, including RHP Jackson Jobe (No. 1), INF Hao-Yu Lee (No. 11) and RHP Troy Melton (No. 12). Jobe is rated by Baseball America as having the best control, best changeup, best slider and best fastball in the Tigers system. He is also rated by Baseball America as the No. 5 overall prospect in baseball. MLB.com's top-30 Tigers prospects list includes four Erie players, including Jobe (No.2), Lee (No. 8), Melton (No. 12) and RHP Eric Silva (No. 29).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Right-hander **Nick Sinacola** makes his 13th Double-A start and his first against the SeaWolves. He last pitched on Saturday against the Curve and threw five scoreless innings in a win. Among Giants minor league pitchers (min. 90 IP), Sinacola leads the organization in BAA (.216), WHIP (1.01) and BB/9 (1.91). He made his Double-A debut on June 6 against the Curve at The Diamond and allowed five runs over 4.1 innings. In his next five starts from June 12-July 4, he went 3-0 with a 1.33 ERA (4 ER/27.0 IP). He began the season with High-A Eugene and went 4-1 with a 2.68 ERA in 10 outings, including two starts. At the time of his promotion to Double-A, Sinacola ranked second among Northwest League pitchers (min. 40 IP) in WHIP (0.79), third in BB/9 (1.56), third in BAA (.190), ninth in ERA (2.68), and 10th in K/9 (8.48). He spent the entire 2023 season with the Emeralds and went 2-5 with a 4.58 ERA over 23 outings (20 starts). Sinacola was selected by the Giants in the seventh round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of the University of Maine, where he was the America East Pitcher of the Year that season as a senior. **For more on Sinacola, see page two.**

**FOR ERIE:** Right-hander Jackson Jobe makes his 15th Double-A start and his first against the Flying Squirrels. Last time out, he was charged with a loss after allowing one run in six innings at Bowie last Saturday. Jobe was assigned to Double-A on July 5 and went 2-0 with a 0.83 ERA (2 ER/21.2 IP) in his first four Eastern League starts of the season. Since then, he has gone 1-1 with a 3.04 ERA (9 ER/26.2 IP) in five starts. Jobe was selected by the Tigers with the third-overall pick in the 2021 MLB Draft out of Heritage Hall in Oklahoma City. He is currently rated by Baseball America as the No. 1 Tigers prospect and No. 2 by MLB.com. Baseball America also has him ranked as the No. 5 prospect in baseball.

**DOUBLE TROUBLE:** The Flying Squirrels have turned 83 groundball double plays this year, which is the most in the Eastern League. Richmond pitcher **John Michael Bertrand** has induced 19 double plays this year, which is the most in the minor leagues. The Flying Squirrels turned four double plays on July 27 against Binghamton, which is tied for the most in a game this season in the league. They matched that feat with four double plays in the first four innings at Harrisburg on August 16 with Bertrand pitching. Those four double plays were tied for the most induced by a pitcher in the Eastern League dating back to 2005, which is the first year those statistics are readily available. It has been accomplished by three other Richmond pitchers, including **Daryl Maday** in 2010, **Clayton Blackburn** twice in 2014 and **Garrett Williams** in 2019. Bertrand's 19 GIDPs this year are tied for the fourth-most in a season in franchise history, trailing 27 by **Craig Westcott** in 2012 (second-most in the Eastern league since at least 2005), 21 by **Clayton Tanner** in 2010 and 20 by **Mike MacDonald** in 2010.

**BERICOTO BASHING:** In his last 59 games dating back to June 6, **Victor Bericoto** is hitting .295 (69-for-234) with five homers, 12 doubles, 13 walks and 33 RBIs. After leading the Giants organization in homers (27) last year, Bericoto hit just one homer in his first 34 games this season through May 21. From May 22-28, he homered three times in five games. He went deep again on June 14 at New Hampshire and added a homer on June 18 at Portland, but he had not homered in 34 games before belting a two-run shot on August 9 off the scoreboard in left-center at The Diamond. Bericoto homered again last Friday.

**TO THE MUNGUIA:** In his 21 August games, **Ismael Munguia** is batting .342 (27-for-79), fourth-highest in the Eastern League, with a homer, five doubles and eight RBIs, adding four stolen bases. He has at least one hit in 17-of-21 games played this month. Last year, he hit .282 over 75 games with the Flying Squirrels. In his Richmond career, Munguia is batting .289 (129-for-446) in 112 games, which is the fifth-highest career mark in franchise history (min. 450 PA).

**FAMILIAR FACES:** Erie's roster includes two former Flying Squirrels relief pitchers. **Matt Seelinger** pitched for the Flying Squirrels in 2021 and went 3-1 with a 3.07 ERA in 36 appearances. He was also part of the only nine-inning no-hitter in Richmond franchise history on May 13, 2021 at FNB Field in Harrisburg, recording an out in the eighth inning. He spent parts of the 2022 and 2023 seasons in the Eastern League with Reading. He signed with the Tigers in June and joined the SeaWolves. **Eric Silva** began this season with the Flying Squirrels, going 4-2 with a 4.35 ERA in 28 games with two saves. He was swapped to the Tigers at the trade deadline on July 31 in exchange for Mark Canha and joined the SeaWolves.

**PACKING THE HOUSE:** The Flying Squirrels drew an average of 7,113 fans in April for their home games at The Diamond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 followed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and are ranked 10th among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance (6,543), just shy of the highest average attendance in franchise history (6,689 in 2013).

**BOULEVARD TO THE BAY:** This season, 12 former Flying Squirrels players have reached the majors for the first time. That is the most in a season in franchise history. In 2014, 11 alumni made their MLB debuts, including **Joe Panik**, **Adam Duvall**, **Andrew Susac**, **Matt Duffy**, **Jackson Williams**, **Edwin Escobar**, **Hunter Strickland**, **Chris Dominguez**, **Gary Brown**, **Brett Bochy** and **Chris Heston**. The Flying Squirrels alumni to debut in the majors this season are **Erik Miller** (2023 Flying Squirrels), **Landen Roupp** (2022-23), **Kai-Wei Teng** (2022-23), **Nick Avila** (2022), **Randy Rodriguez** (2022-23), **Mason Black** (2023), **Gerson Garabito** (2021), **Spencer Bivens** (2023), **Raymond Burgos** (2023), **Hayden Birdsong** (2023-24), **Parker Dunshiee** (2023) and **Grant McCray** (2024). Dating back to 2022, 21-of-the-last-23 Flying Squirrels alumni who have reached the majors have debuted with the San Francisco Giants, with Garabito (Rangers) and Dunshiee (Braves) being the only exceptions. Last year saw 10 former Flying Squirrels players debut in the big leagues, including a team-record five from that season's Richmond roster.

**LOTTA INS, LOTTA OUTS, LOTTA WHAT-HAVE-YOUS:** There have been 60 players who have seen action for the Flying Squirrels this year, which ties the franchise record for a single season. In 2018 and 2019, the Flying Squirrels also had 60 different players see time on the field. This season, there have been 31 different pitchers used by the Flying Squirrels, which includes appearances by **Andy Thomas** on June 1 against the SeaWolves and **Luis Toribio** on August 10 against the Yard Goats. There have been 31 different hitters who have seen at least one plate appearance with Richmond this season.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** Two of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the Richmond roster, including OF **Vaun Brown** (No. 11) and SS **Diego Velasquez** (No. 26). On Baseball America's Best Tools list, LHP **John Michael Bertrand** is rated as having the best control. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list features two Richmond players, including Velasquez (No. 17) and LHP **Jack Choate** (No. 21).
