Today's Game: The Sounds take on the Saints in the home opener at First Horizon Park. Nashville won 12-0 on Sunday at Toledo after dropping the first two games of the series. Left-hander Aaron Ashby gets the nod for his first start of the season. He will be opposed by right-hander Simeon Woods Richardson.

Aaron Ashby: The 25-year-old makes his 24th appearance (15 starts) with Nashville (65.0 IP/36 ER). Ashby underwent arthroscopic surgery on his left shoulder in April and didn't return until September. He made three rehab appearances with Wisconsin (9/2-9/10), two with Biloxi (9/13 & 9/17) and two with Nashville (9/21 & 9/24). He has 40 career appearances (23 starts) at the big-league level posting a 4.47 ERA (139.0 IP/69 ER) with 165 strikeouts. Ashby was drafted in the fourth round of the 2018 Draft from Crowder College.

Simeon Woods Richardson: The 23-year-old is also making his 32nd career appearance (30th start) with St. Paul after finishing last season on the Saints roster. He finished last season for the Saints 7-6 with a 4.91 ERA (113.2 IP/62 ER) and 96 strikeouts. He pitched once previously against the Sounds on 5/5/23. He went 3.0 innings...3 H, 3 ER, 2 BB, 4 K. Woods Richardson is ranked as the number 24 prospect for the Twins (according to MLB Pipeline).

When the Saints Come Marching In: This is the first time the Nashville Sounds are hosting the St. Paul Saints and their third series overall. St. Paul moved from the independent American Association to the Twins' Triple-A affiliate to begin the 2021 season. Nashville has won six of 11 against the Saints, with all of the games being played previously at CHS Field in Minnesota. The last time the Sounds hosted the Twins' Triple-A affiliate was when the Edmonton Trappers came to town during the 2002 season.

Holy Toledo! The Sounds put up 12 runs against the Mud Hens on Sunday after scoring only four in the previous two games of the series. Isaac Collins, Brewer Hicklen and Nick Kahle each added two RBI in the contest and Joey Wiemer was the only Nashville starter to not record a RBI. As a team, they walked 10 times compared to only 6 strikeouts.

Setting the Tone: Vinny Capra got the nod as the leadoff hitter on Sunday after hitting 6th on Friday and 2nd on Saturday. He reached base in five of his six plate appearances (2-3 with 3 BB) scoring three times. He currently leads the Sounds in walks (5) and OBP (.533). This is Capra's first season with Nashville after being claimed off waivers by Milwaukee from Pittsburgh on November 2, 2023.

I-Sac-Fly Collins: Isaac Collins had his first start of the season on Sunday, playing 2nd base and batting 8th. He had a double in the 4th and 6th inning, adding a sac-fly RBI in the 7th. Collins had a .269 batting average (78-for-290) with 10 home runs, and 44 RBI in 96 games for Double-A Biloxi in 2023.

Raging Bullpen: The Sounds bullpen has been exceptional to start the season posting a 1.35 ERA (13.1 IP/2 ER) which is good for 2nd-best in the International League through the opening weekend. Nick Bennett and Kevin Herget each had 2.0 innings of scoreless relief against Toledo. The Sounds pen had 5.0 innings of scoreless relief to finish off a shutout victory on Sunday.

Dorrian Did Not Miss: Patrick Dorrian hit Nashville's only home run over the weekend. His 440 foot blast was his fifth home run of at least 440 feet since the start of the 2023 season. Since the Sounds joined the International League in 2021, Dorrian has the third-most home runs by a Sounds player with 33, trailing only Keston Hiura with 37 and Jon Singleton with 34.

Myers Mires the Mud Hens: Tobias Myers got his first start of the season Sunday against Toledo. Pitched 4.0 scoreless innings, with three hits allowed, four walks and four strikeouts. He had 27 appearances (26 starts) last season for Biloxi with a 5.03 ERA (137.2 IP/77 ER) and 168 strikeouts. Myers now has 7.0 scoreless innings in three career appearances for the Sounds.

The Sweet Life: Manager Rick Sweet returns for his fourth consecutive season as the Sounds manager (5th overall) and his 34th season as a manager in MiLB. Sweet is the winningest manager in Nashville Sounds history, earning his 321st victory in the 2023 season finale vs. Jacksonville. This is his 11th season as manager of the Brewers' Triple-A affiliate and boasts a 684-584 record (Nashville in 2014, Colorado Springs from 2015-18, San Antonio in 2019 and Nashville 2021-). Overall, Sweet has a career managerial record of 2,276-2,104 - that's the fifth most wins in MiLB history and second among active managers (only Buddy Bailey with Single-A Myrtle Beach has more wins).

Back Home Again: The Sounds are 27-18 in home openers and have won each of their last two (2022 vs. Durham, 2023 vs. Louisville). Both of those two wins came in walk-off fashion, with Corey Ray getting a single to win it in '22 and Tyler Naquin hit a two-run blast to win it in '23.
