TODAY'S GAME: The M-Braves continue their nine-game, two-city road trip with game three of a six-game set at Tennessee. The M-Braves went 1-2 on the first-leg in Chattanooga, July

ABOUT THE LAST NIGHT: The Smokies walked off with a 9-8 win over the M-Braves on Wednesday night to take a 2-0 series lead. Mississippi's Cal Conley, Landon Stephens, and Drew Lugbauer hit home runs in the loss.

TENNESSEE WALTZ: The M-Braves face both of Tennessee's Southern League teams on this road trip. This is the first meeting with the Smokies in 2023, after going 3-8 against the Cubs affiliate in 2022. The Smokies will visit Trustmark Park in the final homestand of the season, September 5-10.

TOP PITCHING STAFF: The M-Braves lead the Southern League, and rank 5th in Double-A, with a 3.92 ERA. The pitching staff has given up just 65 home runs, the fewest in Double-A. The M-Braves bullpen is 4th in MiLB with a 3.36

LET THE GOOD TIMES ROLL: The M-Braves closed the first half by going 24-17 over the last 41 games after starting 9-18. The club picked up right where it left off with a series win at Biloxi. Over the last nine series, the club is 4-2-3, starting the run with a five-game sweep of Chattanooga from May 9-14.

GRAND SALAMI TIME: The M-Braves have a club record six grand slams, including the first-ever multi-grand slam game on June 16 at Pensacola (Cade Bunnell, Luke Waddell). Waddell's last two home runs were grand slams on June 16 at Pensacola and July 1 at Biloxi.

PROSPECTING: 8 of Atlanta's Top 30 MLB Pipeline prospects are on the active roster: RHP Victor Vodnik (10), INF Cal Conley (12), OF Jesse Franklin V (13), RHP Alan Rangel (25), RHP Tanner Gordon (27), C Tyler Tolve (28), LHP Luis De Avila (29) and INF Luke Waddell (30).

RETURN OF THE PEARL CITY BOMBERS: The M-Braves rank 2nd in the league and T-6th in Double-A with 102 homers in 84 games - 65 on the road, while their opponents have just 65 total home runs. 16 Mississippi players have at least one homer, with Landon Stephens leading the way with 18, which is T-1st in the Southern League.

M-Braves opponents have just 15 home runs at Trustmark Park this season.

STREAKIN' TOLVE: Tyler Tolve's 20-game onbase streak from May 24 to July 2 was the longest by an M-Braves player this season. He has currently reached in 26 of 28 games.

DEAN RUNNIN' WILD: Justin Dean set a club record with four steals in the first two innings on July 1 at Biloxi. Dean had seven steals over two games, June 30-July 2, finished the series with eight stolen bases, and has a team-leading 22 on the year, which ranks 7th in the Southern

WADDYYY: Over his last 35 games since June 4, Luke Waddell is batting .328 with a league-most 44 hits, 26 runs, plus 29 RBI, five homers, two grand slams, 13 extra-base hits, 10 stolen bases. and .921 OPS.

WELCOME BACK MILLY: OF Cody Milligan returned from the IL on Friday after being shut down on April 25 after suffering a wrist injury. The Binger, OK is 7-for-18 with two doubles, three RBI, six runs, and five walks. He's hit in 15 of 18 games played this year, batting .348 with eight doubles, one home run, nine RBI, 21 runs, 14 walks, and .991 OPS.

LEAGUE AFFILIATE OF THE

RETURN OF THE SLUGBAUER: 1B Drew Lugbauer hit his 101st minor league home run on Wednesday at Tennessee, which was his 60th in three seasons for the M-Braves. Lugbauer returned Wednesday from his second IL stint. He is currently on a 11-game hitting streak, batting .472 with 4 2B, 4 HR, 9 RBI, 6 BB, .558 OBP, and 1.475 OBP. It's the longest current streak in the

On May 23, Lugbauer cranked a 117-mile-perhour home run, ranking 5th among MLB players for hardest-hit balls.

The M-Braves all-time and single-season home run leader slugged his 50th career M-Braves home run on April 30 at Biloxi. Lugbauer has a club record, and Double-A franchise record 60 home runs over parts of three seasons. Lugbauer also has a club-record 173 RBI. He hit 18 homers in 2021 and led the Southern League and Braves minor league system with 28 homers in 2022.

ANOTHER WINNING MONTH: After an 8-13 April, the M-Braves posted a 13-12 record in May and June. Over the month of June, the M-Braves ranked 2nd in the league with a .250 batting average, 37 home runs, and a 4.17 ERA. The M-Braves are out to a 5-3 start in

DE AVILA DELIVERS IN JUNE: Luis De Avila delivered five solid starts in June, going 3-0 with a 1.61 ERA in 28.0 innings. After a team-most 16 starts, De Avila ranks among the league leaders in ERA (3.28, 3rd), starts (T-4th), opponent average (.222, 4th) innings pitched (74.0, 8th), and WHIP (1.32, 8th).

EVEN STEPHENS: Landon Stephens has reached base safely in 13 of 14 games, batting .326 with five doubles, five home runs, 11 RBI, nine runs, six walks, and 1.187 OPS. He homered in three straight games from June 16-18 and has homered in two-straight, on four different occa-

Stephens leads the Southern League with 21 extra-base hits since June 1, and overall this season is T-1st in home runs with 18. He ranks among the league leaders in OPS (.878, 4th), slugging (.521, 5th), extra-base hits (31, 7th), and RBI (51, 8th).

HOT VOD: Victor Vodnik has not allowed a run over his last 13 appearances since May 27, 18.0 IP. 6 H. 28 strikeouts to 13 walks. Since the start of May. Vodnik is 2-0 with four saves, a 0.64 ERA in 28.0 innings and 20 games. He is currently 3rd in the league appearances with 28.

WINNIN' WITH WILCOX: RHP Kyle Wilcox has allowed two earned runs in 22.0 innings over 19 relief appearances with the M-Braves, including eight walks to 34 strikeouts. The righthander was on Triple-A Gwinnett's roster from April 18-May 23, recording a 4.32 ERA in 12.1

TODAY'S GAME

- Rangel makes his 16th start of 2023 and his third career start against the Smokies. This
 will be Rangel's 49th career start for Mississippi over the last three seasons. Rangel
 made two starts against the Smokies last season, going 0-1 with a 3.60 ERA. He did
 not face Tennessee in 2021.
- Rangel has lost six of his last eight starts dating back to May 26.

LAST TIME OUT

Rangel was unable to get through the first inning last Friday, at Chattanooga, allowing seven runs (five earned) on five hits with one walk, and one strikeout in 0.2 innings. The M-Braves fell behind 10-0, and dropped the season-opener to the Lookouts, 12-5.

2023 NOTES

- Posted a 2.61 ERA in 20.2 innings in May, recording at least five innings in all four starts.
- Allowed only one run over two starts on 4/19 vs. MTG, and 4/25 at BLX, with no walks, and 10 strikeouts.
