LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn rallied for its second comeback victory in as many LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn rallied for its second comeback victory in as many days, beating Hudson Valley, 8-5...The Cyclones trailed 5-3 entering the seventh inning, but scored four in that frame and one more in the eighth to win the contest...2B Wilfredo Lara delivered the go-ahead RBI single...3B Nick Lorusso and SS William Lugo blasted solo home runs in the first and fourth innings... Lorusso finished the day 2-for-4 with a walk, while Lugo was 2-for-3 with a double and a pair of free passes...LHP Julian Smith tossed 1.2 innings of scoreless relief to earn his first win as a member of the Mets' organization...RHP Justin Lawson walked the first hitter he faced, then retired nine straight to record his fifth save...Hudson Valley received a pair of two-run home runs from 2B Roc Riggio and 1B Rafael Flores in their four-run fifth.

SUPER STANLEY: OF Stanley Consuegra is in the midst of his best offensive stretch of the season...Since May 17 at Bowling Green, he's hitting .287/.400/.575 with a .975 OPS...The Santo Domingo, D.R. native has scored 14 runs and added seven doubles, six home runs, and 18 RBI...Consuegra has raised his batting average by 53 points (.171 to .224) and his OPS by 208 points (.519 to .727) during the stretch...Since that date, the 23-year-old is tied for third in the South Atlantic League in extra-base hits (13) and tied for fifth in home runs (6)...Consuegra set the Cyclones' all-time doubles record (39) on June 8 vs. Aberdeen and the all-time hits mark (180) on May 29 at Jersey Shore...He is also the franchise's all-time leader in extra-base hits (80), home runs (35), RBI (119), and outfield assists (19)...Consuegra also holds the single-season mark for (119), and outfield assists (19)...Consuegra also holds the single-season mark for home runs (23), and extra-base hits (42), and is tied with INF **Ronny Mauricio** (63) for single-season RBI.

LARRUPIN' LORUSSO: INF Nick Lorusso has been one of the best hitters in the South Atlantic League throughout 2024...The 23-year-old is tied for seventh in the circuit in extra-base hits (23), tied for ninth in total bases (95), and tied for 10th in home runs (9)...Lorusso has also been a terror at the plate against Hudson Valley...In 9 games against the Renegades, the Connecticut native is 11-for-33 (.333) at the dish with five home runs and nine RBI...Lorusso sits third among New York Mets' full-season minor leaguers in slugging (.492) and extra-base hits (23)...He is also tied for third in triples (3), fourth in home runs (9), fifth in batting average (.264), sixth in RBI (32) and total bases (95), and tied for sixth in hits (51).

MARVELOUS MORABITO: OF Nick Morabito has been as good as any offensive player in Minor League Baseball in 2024...Morabito is tied for seventh in Minor League Baseball in stolen bases (30), tied for eighth in on-base percentage (.451), and tied for 14th in batting average (.338)...Since making his South Atlantic League debut on May 7, the former second-round pick is tied for the league lead in steals (19) with Aberdeen OF Matthew Etzel, tied for fifth in runs scored (26), ninth in on-base percentage (.397), and tied for ninth in hits

CALM, COLÓN, COLLECTED: RHP **Jeffrey Colón** was sublime out of the bullpen for the Cyclones on Wednesday night...The 24-year-old stranded the bases loaded with one out in the second inning, hurling 6.2 innings of shutout ball...Colón scattered four hits and struck out a season-best six...The 6.2 innings ball...Colón scattered four hits and struck out a season-best six...The 6.2 innings on the hill was the longest effort by the Las Matas de Farfán, D.R. native since he threw 6.2 innings in a start, taking a no-decision, on May 26, 2023, vs. Winston-Salem...The 6.2 innings of the bump also matched the longest outing by a Cyclone pitcher this year...RHP **Jonah Tong** tossed 6.2 innings of one-run ball to earn the win in a start vs. Hudson Valley on May 21...Colón is the first Brooklyn relief pitcher to toss 6.2+ innings since RHP **Jordan Geber** posted 7.0 scoreless innings to earn the win vs. Aberdeen on May 7, 2023...Colón and Geber are the only South Atlantic League pitchers to throw 6.2+ innings in a single game since the start of the 2023 season since the start of the 2023 season.

JUNIOR MINTS: INF **Junior Tilien** enters play with the longest active on-base streak in the South Atlantic League, reaching in 22 consecutive games since Game 1 of a doubleheader on May 16 at Bowling Green...The 21-year-old has accumulated a .284/.378/.420 slash line with a .798 OPS during the streak, adding three doubles, a triple, two home runs, 11 RBI, and 13 walks...The infielder is the first Cyclone to record an on-base streak of 20 or more games since INF **José Peroza** reached in 31-consecutive games from July 29 until September 2, 2022...Tilien also posted a 10-game hitting streak from May 26 until June 9... He slashed .375/.409/.550 with a .959 OPS in that time.

vs. HUDSON VALLEY: Brooklyn hits the road for the final six-game series of the season's first half against the Yankees' High-A affiliate...Hudson Valley possesses four of New York's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: LHP Kyle Carr (11), INF Roc Riggio (18), INF Jared Serna (19), and OF Jace Avina (28)... The Cyclones captured the first meeting at Maimonides Park, winning 4-of-6...In 2023, Brooklyn went 6-6 against Hudson Valley on Coney Island and 8-4 at Heritage Financial Park...Dating back to 2001, Brooklyn trails the all-time series, 146-149 (.495).

SUERO SUAVE: C Chris Suero has started to find his rhythm offensively in the South Atlantic League...The 20-year-old capped last week's series vs. Aberdeen with his first career multi-home run game, blasting two-run shots in the fourth and sixth innings...In five games against the IronBirds, Suero was 7-for-16 (.438) and sixth innings...In five games against the ironBirds, Suero was 7-101-16 (.438) at the dish with seven runs scored, a double, three home runs, and an eye-poping 11 RBI...Since May 17 at Bowling Green, Suero has reached safely in 20 of 21 games, hitting .288/.429/.466 with a .895 OPS...The Bronx native has scored a whopping 19 runs with a double, four home runs, 18 RBI, and 17 walks...Since that date, Suero is tied for fifth in the SAL in walks (17), tied for seventh in runs scored (19), and tied for eighth in on-base percentage (.429).

JOLTIN' JEFREY: IF/OF Jefrey De Los Santos has been an extra-base machine in recent games...The 20-year-old had a seven-game hitting streak since the beginning of June snapped on Wednesday...He has also tallied multiple knocks in six of his last 11 games...Since May 30 at Jersey Shore, De Los Santos is hitting 349/.417/.721 with a 1.138 OPS, eight runs scored, three doubles, two triples, three home runs, seven RBI, and five walks...Since the start of June, De Los Santos is second in the circuit in slugging (.714), tied for second in triples (2), fourth in OPS (1.150) and batting average (.371), and ninth in on-base percentage (.436)

FETTUCINE WILFREDO: INF Wilfredo Lara has been scorching hot for the Cyclones since May 19...The 20-year-old has appeared in 23 games and tallied a .295/.411/.449 line with a .860 OPS...Lara has scored 18 runs and added two doubles, two triples, two home runs, 11 RBI, 13 walks, and four stolen bases...Lara also had a 13-game on-base streak since May 26 vs. Hudson Valley snapped on Wednesday...He hit .372/.509/.535 with a 1.044 OPS during the stretch.

YOU'LL GET NOTHING AND LIKE IT: RHPs Dakota Hawkins (5.0 IP), Joey Lancellotti (1.0), and Joshua Cornielly (3.0) combined on the first nine-inning no-hitter in Brooklyn Cyclones history in Tuesday's 3-0 win vs. Aberdeen... The only previous no-hitter came on August 23, 2009, when RHP Brandon Moore tossed a seven-inning no-no in a 5-0 win during Game 1 of a doubleheader at Aberdeen...It is one of four no-hitters in Minor League Baseball in 2024...Last Tuesday's effort was the first no-hitter by a Mets minor league affiliate since RHP Joander Suárez hurled a seven-inning one on September 7 at Hartford... It was also the first nine-inning no-hitter thrown in the borough of Brooklyn since RHP Sal Maglie tossed a no-no for the Dodgers against the Philadelphia Phillies on September 25, 1956, at Ebbets Field. on September 25, 1956, at Ebbets Field.

THE CENTURY MARK: RHP Michel Otañez became the 100th player in Brooklyn Cyclones history to make the trip from Coney Island to the Major Leagues, making his Major League debut for the Oakland Athletics on Monday night... The 26-year-old threw 0.2 scoreless innings in San Diego allowing a hit and a walk...Otañez made seven starts for Brooklyn in the 2019 season and 35 relief appearances during the 2021 campaign...In 42 appearances (seven starts), the right-hander held a 5-2 record with a 4.20 ERA (33 ER in 70.2 IP), one save, 58 walks, and 84 strikeouts...Otañez is the second former Cyclone to make his Major League debut in 2024...RHP Christian Scott (2022-23) was the first to do so for the New York Mets on May 4.

ATOP THE HEJ-ES: RHP Josh Hejka earned his first save of the season on May 5 vs. Aberdeen, making his Cyclones' franchise-record-setting 48th pitching appearance in the process...The 27-year-old broke a tie with Hunter Parsons (47) for the most pitching appearances in Cyclones franchise history...In his 59 career outings for Brooklyn since 2019, Hejka has accumulated a 5-2 record with a 2.43 ERA (26 ER in 96.1 IP) and 6 saves, walking just 22 and striking out 84.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to Baseball America and MLB Pipeline...The 'Clones have three of the Top 30 per BA: **Kade Morris** (21), **Jonah Tong** (22) and **Calvin Ziegler** (29)... Ziegler is currently on the full-season injured list...Plus four of the Top 30 per MLB: Tong (20), Ziegler (23), **Wilfredo Lara** (24), and OF **Nick Morabito** (26).

BIRDMAN BIRDMAN: Prior to joining the rotation, Hawkins impressed in a relief role...Among South Atlantic League relievers, the 24-year-old was sixth in strikeouts (34) and tied for sixth in innings pitched (24.2) prior to his first start...He was also first in ground ball rate (62.1%) and swinging strike rate (19.7%), second in strikeout rate (33.0%) and FIP (1.88), fourth in strikeout-to-walk rate (24.3%), seventh in walk rate (8.7%).

2023: Signed with the New York Mets as an undrafted free agent out of Washington State University on July 19, 2023... Assigned to the Florida Complex League Mets on August 11...Made a pair of scoreless relief appearances before being transferred to Single-A St. Lucie on August 26...Did not allow a run on two hits over 6.0 innings with the Mets...Struck out seven without issuing a walk.

WAZZOU WIZARD: The Chehalis, Wash. native had an outstanding career at Washington State University...After starting his collegiate tenure with two years at Lower Columbia College (Longview, Wash.), Hawkins went on to be named All-PAC 12 Honorable Mention in 2023...In 14 starts, he accrued a 5-3 record with a 4.32 ERA (35 ER in 73.0 IP) with 27 walks and 92 strikeouts...His 92 K's were fourth in the conference and ninth-most in a single-season at Washington State.
