## Sacramento River Cats (32-20) at Reno Aces (24-30)

RHP Spencer Bivens (2-1, 5.04) vs. LHP Mitch Bratt (1-1, 2.35)

**AND THEY'RE LAUGHING DRAWING ACES:** The Sacramento River Cats won last night's game, 7-2, giving them a seven-game road winning streak for the first time since May 2013...they are now 13-3 in their last 16 games...marked their 14th multi-home run game, they are now 14-0 in such games...Sacramento leads the PCL in home runs in the month of May (34), and lead all of Triple-A in home runs since May 19 (19)...Carson Seymour was the starter and earned his third win of the season...allowed one run on five hits with two walks and four strikeouts in 5.0 innings of work...Grant McCray went 1-for-5, extending his hitting streak to seven games, tied for sixth-longest active hitting streak in the PCL.

- ▶ Jake Holton (2-for-5) knocked his fifth home run of the season, a 426-foot, solo-shot to center field...marked his second-longest recorded home run (441 feet, August 4, 2021 with Lakeland), and fifth-longest by a River Cat this season...also knocked an RBI double in the fifth...was his second multi-extra-base-hit game (also, May 19, 2B and HR).
- ▶ Nate Furman (3-for-5) recorded his fifth home run of the season, a 400-foot, two-run blast to right field...also knocked a single to lead off the game, and a double in the third, making him just a triple shy of the cycle...was his first multi-extra-base-hit game of the year...marked his third three-hit game and 10th multi-hit game
- ▶ Hitting coach P.J. Pilittere was ejected in the third inning by first base umpire Ray Valero for arguing an out at first call...was Pilittere's first ejection with the River Cats and first since 2023 when he was ejected with the Rockies for arguing a strike call.

**HOLDING ALL THE ACES:** The River Cats won Wednesday's game, 12-5, their ninth double-digit win...they are now 12-3 in their last 15 games since May 10 after going 11-11 in the 22 games prior to May 10...marked their 13th multi-home game, they are 13-0 in such games...was their second seven-plus-XBH game of the season (also, May 20 vs. SUG, 5 doubles and 4 home runs)...Blade Tidwell was the starter but did not factor into the decision...allowed a season-high-tying five runs on a career-high-tying 10 hits with no walks and six strikeouts in 4.0 innings...was his first 4.0-plus-inning, no walk game since April 27 (1) with Syracuse...Dylan Smith earned his first win of the season...threw 2.0 scoreless innings, allowing one hit and fanning two batters...River Cats pitchers did not walk a single batter for the first time this season...Sac had two games in 2025 where they did not give up a walk.

- ▶ Turner Hill (3-for-5) knocked his first home run of the season, a 389-foot, solo-shot to right field...made him the final River Cat (min. 5 games) to record a home run this season...marked the sixth home run of his professional career, and first at the Triple-A level...also knocked a double in the fourth...marked the sixth multi-extra-base-hit game of his career, and first since July 12...also was his first that included a home run...was his third three-hit game with Sacramento this year.
- ▶ Grant McCray went 2-for-4 with a triple in the fourth, his first of the season...was Sacramento's fifth three-bagger of the year, and first since April 23...extended his hitting streak to seven games.
- ▶ Scott Bandura struck out five times...marked the eighth time in franchise history a River Cats player has been fanned five times, and first since Ka'ai Tom did so on October 1, 2021...no River Cats batter has ever struck out more than five times in a game.

**WHO'S THE NEW GUY?:** Drew Cavanaugh (4-for-4) recorded his second multi-homer game of the season of the season on Wednesday...the only River Cat to have multiple multi-homer games last season was Marco Luciano (3 two-HR games)...two of Luciano's multi-HR games were just six days apart; Cavanaugh's multi-HR games were seven days apart...his first longball in the fourth inning traveled 431 feet; the third-longest homer by a River Cat this season (Berico-to, 459; Eldridge, 434)...his second traveled 430 feet.

- ▶ He has knocked nine extra-base-hits in his last six games since May 20, leading all of Triple-A in that span...he is batting .552 (16-for-29) with five doubles, four home runs, 11 RBI, two walks, two stolen bases, a 1.138 slugging percentage and a 1.732 OPS in seven games since May 20.

**BUDDY SYSTEM:** Infielder Buddy Kennedy has been phenomenal in his debut with the River Cats this season...on Tuesday, he hit his team-leading eighth home run of the season...he is the only River Cat to have a consecutive games with a home run, and he's done it twice...the last time Kennedy homered in three-straight games was May 14-17, 2025 with the Lehigh Valley IronPigs (4-straight).

- ▶ He leads the team (min. 15 games) in OBP (.422), SLG (.543), and OPS (.965), each of which also rank in the top 10 among qualified PCL players...ranks second on the team in batting average (.320) behind Turner Hill (.330)
- ▶ His 40 runs are T-6th in the PCL, his 56 hits are 8th, and his 95 total bases are ranked 10th.
- ▶ Buddy has 22 extra-base-hits this season, ranking T-7th in the league...18 of those XBH have occurred since April 19, and he is 5th most in the PCL and T-8th most in Triple-A since that date...since then, he is batting .325 (39-for-120) with nine doubles, one triple, eight home runs, 24 RBI, 20 walks, a .617 slugging percentage and a 1.055 OPS.
- ▶ Seven of his eight home runs have happened since May 6, and he is first in the PCL and T-3rd in home runs in Triple-A since that date, behind Memphis' Joshua Báez and Charlotte's Jacob Gonzalez (each have 9).

**KNOCK, KNOCKS:** The River Cats were the last team in Triple-A to record a home run, getting their first on April 1...the Cats ranked last in home runs in the PCL through April 28...however, in the month of May, they lead the league in homers at 34...last night was their 14th multi-homer game and fifth in the last nine games...they have recorded 19 longballs in those last nine games since May 19, leading Triple-A since that date.

- ▶ On the other side, the River Cats pitching staff has allowed just 15 home runs in the month of May, leading the PCL and T-2nd in Triple-A...they rank first in PCL and second overall in Triple-A in total home runs allowed on the season (35), behind only Nashville (33).

**BIVENS(S) IN THE MOMENT:** Right-hander Spencer Bivens is set to take the mound tonight against Reno...last pitched on May 23 vs. Sugar Land where he did not factor into the decision of 6-0, shutout victory...allowed three hits and two walks with three strikeouts in 4.1 innings of work.

- ▶ Over 14 appearances this season, he has posted a 5.04 ERA (30.1 IP, 17 ER) with 11 walks, 25 strikeouts and a .265 opponent batting average...in 11 total starts in his career, Bivens has a 2.81 ERA (41.2 IP, 13 ER), 15 walks, 36 strikeouts and a .176 opponent batting average.
- ▶ He spent the entirety of the 2025 season with San Francisco where he made 54 appearances, posting a 4.00 ERA (81.0 IP, 36 ER) with 25 walks, 61 strikeouts and a .269 opponent batting average.
- ▶ Bivens is 1-0 in six games (1 start) against the Aces...has allowed 13 runs (11 earned) on 13 hits, with two home runs, five walks and seven strikeouts across 11.0 innings of work...last faced Reno on May 6 where he gave up four runs (3 earned), one home run, two walks, and fanned two batters in 2.0 innings.
