WSH AFFILIATE NOTES

High-A Wilmington scored two in the 11th last night to beat Frederick (BAL), 4-3...SS **ELI WILLITS** clubbed his seventh High-A home run in the sixth, a solo shot over the right-center field wall.

FLIGHT RISK: The Rochester Red Wings (18-14, 63-42) capitalized on an opportunity to pick up their 11th series victory of the season Saturday night, beating Syracuse (13-18, 51-55) in a low-scoring pitcher's duel, 3-1...eight Red Wings pitchers saw time on the mound, kicked off by 2.0 scoreless innings by LHP **JARED SIMPSON**...on the offensive side of things, RF **LEANDRO PINEDA** became the first Red Wing in eight years to log a triple and two doubles in the same game, going 3-for-4 to lead the way...Rochester will close out the series this afternoon with LHP **ZACH PENROD** receiving his ninth start of the season on the hill, battling Syracuse's RHP Tobias Myers...

The Red Wings are now a season-high 21 games over .500 for the first time since they finished the 1997 season 83-58.

WRITTEN IN PEN(ROD): Appearing on the hill for the second time this week (9th GS of 2026) will be LHP **ZACH PENROD**...the southpaw tossed a strikeout and allowed three hits over 2.0 innings in game two of Thursday's doubleheader with SYR, lowering his season-long ERA to 3.80 (19 ER/45.0 IP)...in eight games as a starter this season, Penrod carries the lowest ERA (2.77) among all Red Wing starting pitchers (min. 10.0 IP)...additionally, Penrod is holding first-inning batters to a .185 BAA...

Across 12 combined weekend appearances (Sat. 6 Sun., 2 GS), the 29-year-old is 1-0 with a 2.08 ERA (3 ER/13.0 IP), 13 strikeouts, a .205 BAA, and 1.31 WHIP.

PINEDA COLADA: RF **LEANDRO PINEDA** went 3-for-4 at the plate in last night's victory with a triple, a pair of doubles, two runs scored, and a RBI...this is the first time in his professional career that he has logged two doubles and a triple in the same game...he is the first Red Wing to do so since Ryan LaMarre on 5/15/2018 (also vs. SYR)...with only four games played with Rochester, the Venezuela native is tied for second with **CHRISTIAN FRANKLIN** for most triples this season across all Red Wings hitters (2), picking up six hits (4 XBH, 2 3B & 2 2B) in his first 12 Triple-A at-bats...

Pineda now has a combined six triples between Rochester and Double-A Harrisburg this season, one shy of his career-high set in 2022.

THE FRANKLIN FACTOR: CF **CHRISTIAN FRANKLIN** was one of three Red Wings to register at least two hits in last night's victory over SYR, going 2-3 with two RBI and walk, including a double that gave the team an early 2-0 cushion in the bottom of the second...the 26-year-old is currently batting .438/.500/.625 with eight RBIs in this week's series, rounding out his mark of the fifth-highest batting average and seventh-highest SLG, OBP and OPS (1.125) of any Triple-A hitter against the Mets since the start of July (min. 10 AB)...

THE RILEY REPORT: C **RILEY ADAMS** opened the scoring for Rochester last night, racing home for the game's first run on an RBI triple from RF **LEANDRO PINEDA** in the bottom of the second...Adams finished 2-for-4 at the plate and has now registered a hit in all five games of this week's series, with a trio of multi-hit efforts (7/28, 7/31, 8/1) and three XBH (HR, 2 2B)...since 2021, the 26-year-old owns the second-highest OPS (1.115) among all Triple-A hitters facing Syracuse pitching (min. 65 AB)...

Adams also carries the highest OBP (.483), SLG (.619), and OPS (1.102), alongside the second-highest batting average (.333) among all Red Wings in Sunday games this season (min. 20 AB).

RALLYING IN RELIEF: Headlined by last night's pitching extravaganza, where eight different arms saw time on the mound, the Red Wings currently hold the second-lowest bullpen ERA (1.85) in Minor League Baseball since the All-Star break (since 7/19)...the staff is also T-3rd in strikeouts (78), T-11th in BAA (.192), and 16th in WHIP (1.22)...RHP **ZAK KENT** has not allowed an earned run across five appearances (6.0 IP) over that stretch, including a perfect inning last night to extend his scoreless appearance streak to seven consecutive games dating back to 7/12, the longest active streak on the team.

RED WINGS REWIND...

...2003: On this day 23 years ago, OF **RYAN MCGUIRE** connected on the Red Wings' most recent inside-the-park home run in a 6-2 loss at Ottawa...McGuire went on to play 23 games with Rochester that season, after signing with Minnesota on 7/21/2003...he earlier played for the Red Wings as a Baltimore affiliate in 2002, hitting 11 homers with 15 doubles and 46 RBI in 81 games.

Entering his ninth season in professional baseball, first with the Nationals organization after signing as a Minor League free agent on 1/2/2026...originally signed by Texas as an undrafted free agent on 8/2/2018...named Eastern League Pitcher of the Week on 5/19/2024 with Double-A Portland (BOS).

- Held an eight-game streak with no earned runs from 6/20 to 7/19, which is tied for second-longest among all Red Wing pitchers this season...also owning a four-game save streak dating back to 5/5, which ranks first among all pitchers on the team.
- Boasts an average 2.27 ERA (7 ER/26.0 IP) in weekend games (20 app.)
- Ranks second among all Red Wings in saves (4), behind only Eddy Yean (9).
- Picked up the first save of his professional career on 5/5 at SYR and second 5/15 vs LHV.
- Spent the 2025 season with three teams across two levels...began the season on 60-day Injured List...sent on a rehab assignment to FCL Red Sox on 5/24, where he made one appearance, tallying 1.0 IP, two strikeouts, and a walk...reinstated from the IL and assigned to Triple-A Worcester on 5/27.
- Appeared in six games with Worcester, tallying 6.1 IP...struck out two batters in three consecutive relief appearances from 5/31-6/7.
- Designated for assignment on 6/15...traded to Los Angeles-NL on 6/20 and assigned to Triple-A Oklahoma City.
- Has appeared in 7 games of relief in the MLB, all with Boston, logging a 2.25 ERA (1 ER/4.0 IP) with a 1.75 WHIP.
