**LAST NIGHT:** The Skeeters remained undefeated in '21 with a 10-3 win over the Isotopes. The Skeeters scored 10 unanswered runs to pick up the win. After notching 15 hits on Opening Day, the Skeeters offense outdid itself with 17 hits in Game 2.

**HEY SIRI:** Jose Siri belted a three-run home run Friday night, giving the Skeeters their first-ever home run as a Triple A franchise. The homer tied the game up at 3-3 in the fourth inning. Siri drove in four runs on the night, also becoming the first Skeeters Triple A player to log a four-RBI game.

**ROSTER MOVES:** Following last night's game, the Astros announced the signing of infielder Yadiel Rivera and assigned him to Sugar Land. Infielder Colton Shaver was assigned to Corpus Christi (AA). Rivera has appeared at the MLB level each season from 2015-20 and has logged 192 MLB appearances. He last appeared in four games with Texas in '20. Rivera played in a career-high 111 games in '18.

**DOUBLE TROUBLE:** The Skeeters hit six doubles on Friday after hitting four doubles on Opening Day. The Skeeters' 10 doubles lead Triple A West, with the next closest team at five doubles (Sacramento).

**HIT PARADE:** The Skeeters are hitting .390 (32x82) as a team through two games. Skeeters pitching has held Albuquerque to a .175 average (11x63).

**PUTTING OUT THE FIRE:** Seth Martinez and Riley Ferrell combined for 4 1/3 scoreless and hitless innings to close out Friday's game, striking out seven over that stretch. Skeeters relievers have tossed six straight scoreless innings and own a 1.00 ERA this season (1 ER/9 IP).

**MOVING ON UP:** The Skeeters are in their first season in affiliated minor league baseball as the Triple A affiliate of the Houston Astros. The Skeeters are one of three independent teams rising to affiliated minor league ranks this offseason, along with the St. Paul Saints (AAA, MIN) and Somerset Patriots (AA, NYY).

**A LITTLE ABOUT US:** Through their first nine seasons of existence, the Skeeters played in the independent Atlantic League of Professional Baseball. They won the Atlantic League Championship in 2016 and '18 and appeared in the postseason in five of nine seasons.

The Skeeters still hold the Atlantic League single-season record for wins (95) and winning percentage (.679) from their 2013 season.

**CLOSE TO HOME:** Based on approximate mileage, the Skeeters are located second-closest to the stadium of their parent club out The St. Paul Saints are located approximately 11 miles from Minnesota's Target Field.

**NOW HERE'S A STOREY:** Mickey Storey is entering his third year as the manager of the Astros Triple A affiliate. He led Round Rock to the best record in Triple A in 2019 (84-56) and to the Pacific Coast League Finals. Storey got his first managerial job in the Astros system in 2018 with Class A Quad Cities, winning the Western Division of the Midwest League. Storey appeared at the MLB level with the Astros in 2012 and the Blue Jays in 2013 as a right-handed pitcher. He still holds numerous career pitching records for Florida Atlantic University.

**MAJOR TALENT:** The Skeeters roster features eight players with Major League service time: OF **Ronnie Dawson**, IF **Alex De Goti**, IF **Taylor Jones**, RHP **Nivaldo Rodriguez**, RHP **Peter Solomon**, C **Garrett Stubbs**, IF **Abraham Toro**, RHP **Hector Velazquez**. All but Velazquez have appeared at the Majors with the Astros.

**PROSPECT POWER:** The Skeeters have nine players ranked as Astros top-30 prospects (per MLB Pipeline): RHP **Tyler Ivey** (No. 9), RHP **Shawn Dubin** (No. 11), RHP **Peter Solomon** (No. 14), RHP **Jojanse Torres** (No. 20), IF **Taylor Jones** (No. 21), RHP **Brett Conine** (No. 23), RHP **Austin Hansen** (No. 24), RHP **Nivaldo Rodriguez**, (No. 25), OF **Ronnie Dawson** (No. 29)

**PUT IT ON THE MANTEL:** **Ronnie Dawson**, **Alex De Goti** and **Peter Solomon** each made their Major League debuts with the Astros this season. Dawson went 1x5 with a run through 3 G, De Goti went 2x6 with a run and RBI through 6 G and Solomon tossed a scoreless 2 IP in relief, allowing just one hit and striking out two.

**WELCOME TO ABQ:** The Skeeters are making their first trip to Albuquerque in franchise history. The Skeeters and Isotopes are scheduled to play each other 30 times this season and are both in the East Division of Triple-A West. The Isotopes visit Constellation Field in Sugar Land for the first time from May 27-June 1.

**SHOW BEFORE THE SHOW:** The 24-year-old is set to make his first start and appearance at the Triple A level after spending the pandemic-shortened 2020 season at the Astros Alternate Training Site ... He split time between three different minor league levels in 2019, with Corpus Christi (AA), Fayetteville (A+) and Quad Cities (A)

**PROSPECT CREDENTIALS:** Conine is rated as the Astros No. 14 overall prospect by Baseball America and their No. 22 prospect by MLB-Pipeline. He was also rated as having the "Best Control" in the Astros minor league system by Baseball America

**SPRING TRAINING:** Conine received his first invite to Major League Spring Training camp in 2021 ... Logged a 3.86 ERA (2 ER/4.2 IP) with five strikeouts in two relief appearances

**CONTROL FREAK:** Struck out 134 batters in '19 while allowing just 29 walks (4.62 SO/W)

**PITCHER OF THE WEEK:** Was named Texas League Pitcher of the Week on 8/25/19 ... Went 1-0 with a 0.90 ERA (1 ER/10.0 IP) and nine strikeouts in two starts for Corpus Christi (AA) the week prior.

**INNINGS EATER:** Was fourth amongst Astros minor leaguers in innings pitched in '19 (114.1 IP) ... Recorded the second-lowest ERA (2.20) of Astros minor leaguers with at least 100 innings pitched (16 qualifiers) ... Was fifth amongst Astros minor leaguers in strikeouts (134)

**TRANSITION TO ROTATION:** Conine, who was a closer in his collegiate playing days, has favored well in his move to the starting rotation. Conine has gone 6-3 with a 1.85 ERA (19 ER/92.2 IP) as a starter in his pro career while going 3-2 with a 2.70 ERA (16 ER/53.1) as a reliever

**REVERSE SPLITS:** The right-hander has been exceptionally tough on left-handed hitters throughout his pro career, holding them to just a .201 average (52x259) and .590 OPS

**DRAFT DAY:** Selected by the Astros in the 11th round of the '18 MLB Draft from Cal State Fullerton

**GO TITANS:** Conine played three seasons collegiately at Cal State Fullerton and worked as the team's closer his sophomore and junior seasons before transitioning to a starter at the pro level ... Was voted All-Big West First Team in '17 and '18 ... Was 15/15 in save opportunities in '17 with a 1.39 ERA, which were the sixth-most saves in the nation and the fourth-most in Cal State Fullerton single-season history
