HAPPY BIRTHDAY, AMERICA: Tyrone Taylor was the last Nashville batter to hit a home run on July 4 with a two run home run against Columbus in 2023 at First Horizon Park. They were the only Sounds runs in a 19-2 loss. Janson Junk, who is scheduled to start for Jacksonville in game one, allowed nine earned on six hits in the top of the first inning in that game for the Sounds.

FLIGHT CLUB: Brewers no. 5-rated prospect Jett Williams extended his hitting streak to six straight games with a leadoff single in the bottom of the first inning. The six-game streak is a season-long for Williams who had posted two five-game streaks earlier this season. During his current six-game streak, Williams is hitting .318 (7-for-22) with two doubles, four RBI, five walks, and seven runs scored.

BIG CHICKEN: Brewers no. 4 rated prospect Luis Lara ended a 42-game homerless drought with his two-run homer in the bottom of the third inning on Thursday night. The 21-year-old set his single-season career-high with five home runs through his first 26 Triple-A games and had seven on the year through 33 games on May 6 to lead the club and ranked T-10th in the International League. His eight home runs now rank fifth on the team, breaking a tie with Brock Wilken. Despite going homerless over his last 42 games, Lara hit .320 (49-for-153) with six doubles, two triples, and 20 RBI while carrying a .820 OPS. After another walk and stolen base on Thursday, **Lara leads or ranks top 3 in the International League in: OBP (1st, .435), runs (1st, 64), AVG (2nd, .325), hits (3rd, 91), and walks (3rd, 52). His 23 stolen bases are ninth-most in the league.**

JUST A PINCH OF SPICE: Nashville had just six pinch hit opportunities through the end of May (57 G) and have had three in the last two games. Ethan Murray is one of three Nashville players to have multiple pinch hit at-bats this season, joining Freddy Zamora and Greg Jones. Murray has one of the two hits for Nashville as a pinch-hitter this year and has reached base both times after drawing a walk on Thursday night. The Sounds are 2-for-9 with a triple and three strikeouts this season when sending a pinch hitter to the dish. Since the start of the 2021 season, the Sounds are 26-for-152 (.171 AVG) with two doubles, a triple, two home runs, and 13 RBI. The .171 AVG is the fifth lowest in Triple-A over the last six-plus seasons.

RISP-Y BUSINESS: After going 1-for-15 on Thursday night, Nashville is 1-for-20 with runners in scoring position over the last two games and have stranded 16 runners in back-to-back one-run losses. The Sounds rank T-14th in the International League this season, hitting .251 as a team with RISP. **Eddys Leonard and Luis Lara are two of 51 qualified players in Triple-A hitting above .300 this season with RISP.** Leonard leads all Sounds, hitting .323 (21-for-65) with nine XBH and 33 RBI. Lara is hitting .306 (26-for-85) with two doubles and 28 RBI.

BULLPEN BULLIES: The unearned run allowed in the top of the 10th by Reiss Knehr in Thursday's extra-innings loss was the first run allowed by the Nashville bullpen over their last 27.0 IP since last Saturday against Gwinnett. During the span, Sounds relievers have combined for 23 strikeouts, four walks, and 18 hits allowed. Brewers no. 27-rated prospect **Craig Yoho worked his 16th straight appearance with Nashville without an earned run allowed dating back to April 29 on Wednesday.** During the streak, he has allowed just seven hits, with 25 strikeouts and four walks allowed. **Blake Holub has gone straight appearances without an earned run dating back to May 21.** He has gone 8.1 IP overall without an earned run allowed since May 17 (7 H, 8 K, BB). The Sounds bullpen currently leads all full-season minor league teams with a 3.54 ERA (154 ER/391.1 IP) this season.

STREAK-O-NOMICS: Tyler Black extended his on-base streak to 14 straight games after being hit by a pinch in the bottom of the seventh inning Thursday night. His streak dates back to June 13 and is the longest active streak on the team. Ethan Murray has reached base safely in each of his last 11 games since June 17 and has a hit in six straight after drawing a pair of walks in both of his plate appearances on Thursday.

- First pitcher since 1898 to allow two or fewer runs in each of his first 10 career MLB Starts (Stathead)...5-1 with a 2.23 ERA in 48.1 IP**
- Made his Major League debut in 2025 and tossed a quality start in his first career start (6.0 IP, 3 H, ER, HR, 9 K, BB) against the Athletics...Through first four MLB starts was 3-0 with a 1.71 ERA (14 H, 4 ER, 29 K, 6 BB)...One of two MLB pitchers since 1901 to have struck out at least 29 and allowed four or fewer runs through first four MLB starts...Joined fellow Brewer starter Freddy Peralta in the feat.
- Despite making his last appearance for Nashville on 7/26/25 he ended the season tied for second in the International League with 10 wins in 16 games.
- Got a late start to his 2024 season after injuring his oblique during the 2024 Spring Breakout Game...Made his season debut on May 9th in the Arizona Complex League.
- Earned Southern League Pitcher of the Month as well as Brewers Minor League Pitcher of the Month in June 2024 after going 4-0 with a 1.66 ERA in four starts...Held opposing hitter to a .192 AVG and matched his single-game career-high with 10 strikeouts in two of his outings (6/15 vs. TEN and 6/28 vs. PNS).
- From the time of his first start with High-A Wisconsin on 5/24/24 until he was promoted to Nashville (8/8) he led the Brewers farm system with 78 strikeouts.
- Made his Triple-A debut on 8/9/24 and allowed one run on three hits over 4.0 IP but took the loss...Tossed a quality start in his second game vs. DUR (6.0 IP, 0 R, 8 K, 3 H).
- Finished the 2024 season 8th in the Milwaukee farm system in strikeouts (104) and was T-8th in wins (7)...Added to the Brewers 40-man roster on November 19th. 35.2% strikeout rate was fourth best among 661 minor leaguers with at least 70.0 IP in 2023.
- Missed the majority of 2022 after undergoing non-Tommy John elbow surgery in the spring.
- Pitched one season at McLennan CC in Texas and was named NJCAA Division I Pitcher of the Year after going 10-2 with a 1.66 ERA in 17 games (14 GS)...Led NJCAA DI in strikeouts (169) and IP (97.2)...Struck out 17 over 8.0 IP with one run allowed to guide the Highlanders to their first championship since 1983.
