<u>TODAY'S GAME:</u> The M-Braves continue their penultimate road series on Friday night with game four of a six-game series against the Pensacola Blue Wahoos at Blue Wahoos Stadium. This is the final meeting between the M-Braves and Blue Wahoos. Pensacola leads the season series 17-10, and all-time series 138-132.

ABOUT THURSDAY NIGHT: The Pensacola Blue Wahoos used a five-run sixth inning and smashed three home runs to take game three of the six-game set on Thursday night 8-7 at Blue Wahoos Stadium. In a series dominated by pitching, Mississippi out-hit the Blue Wahoos 13-8 but came up short on the scoreboard. The Blue Wahoos sent nine batters to the plate in the bottom of the sixth inning and ran Fletcher from the game after a solo homer by Nathan Martorella, then a three-run home run by Joe Mack tied the game at 5-5. Starter David Fletcher ended his 15th start by giving up five runs on four hits with four walks and one strikeout in 5+ innings. Yolbert Sanchez logged his 10th multi-hit game in his last 16 by going 3-for-5 with a double and two runs scored. Quintero scored two runs and was 2-for-4 with a walk. Cal Conley was 1-for-5 but swiped two bases, pushing his career-high total to 39 steals this season.

STARTING STUDS: M-Braves' starters this season rank sixth in Double-A with a 3.64 ERA. Over the last 19 games, since August 8, the M-Braves lead Double-A and rank third in MiLB with a 2.32 ERA.

<u>WE'RE BACK IN THIS THING:</u> Having won 10 of 16 since August 11, the M-Braves are in third place, 4.0 games out of first place in the Southern League's South Division, and 2.5 games behind Biloxi for the wild card with 15 games remaining. The 5-1 series win in Biloxi, August 13-18, brought the club from 6.5 back to 2.5 back. The M-Braves play Tennessee, September 3-8, for the final homestand, and then Biloxi on the road, September 15-20 to close the final season in Mississippi.

SHUTOUTS, DONUTS, AND GOOSE EGGS: Sunday's 4-0 shutout win over Chattanooga was Mississippi's fourth over their last 12 games and 15th of the season. The 15 shutouts are T-1st in Double-A and T-2nd in Minor League Baseball. SANCHEZ SIZZLIN': M-Braves INF Yolbert Sanchez has hit in 13 of his last 16 games, leading the league by batting .426

with 10 multi-hit games. Since June 30, Sanchez ranks third in the Southern League, batting .328 in 34 games

FLETCHER'S FEELING GOOD ON THE MOUND AND AT THE PLATE: M-Braves two-way player David Fletcher is 2-1 over his last three starts with a 3.86 ERA (21.0 IP, 9 ER), and at the plate over that same span since August 8, is batting .273 over eight games while playing second bases. The knuckleballer and former two-time MLB Gold Glove award finalist with the Angels has made 14 pitching starts and appeared in 46 total games this season for Mississippi

ROAD SUCCESS/HOME SWOON: The M-Braves are 15-6 over their last 21 road games since the All-Star Break (6-12 at home). After starting the season 6-14 on the road, the M-Braves are 27-15 over their last 42 games away from Trustmark Park, including a 4-1 mark in a home-away-from-home series at Toyota Field, June 13-16. They won a club record nine straight games away from Pearl from May 12 to June 5. The streak included a six-game sweep in Chattanooga, May 21-26.

EMPERORS RISING: The three newest position player additions to the roster from High-A Rome, Ethan Workinger, David McCabe, and Adam Zebrowski have made an immidiate impact. The trio reached base nine times in the 11-1 win in Biloxi on August 18. Zebrowski has hit in six of eight games since being added to the roster, batting .276, including a three-hit game on August 18. McCabe has been on base 21 times in his last 15 games, posting a .344 OBP.

HACKEN-BRAUN: RHP Lucas Braun and RHP Drue Hackenberg have put together two of the top seasons in the Atlanta Braves organization. The two have combined for 42 starts and 263 strikeouts in 230.2 innings. Braun leads the organization in strikeouts (137), and innings pitched (125.1), and is among the leaders in ERA (3rd, 3.38), starts (T-1st, 21), WHIP (3rd, 1.21), opponent's batting average (5th, .239), and wins (T-2nd, 7). *Hackenberg*, promoted to Triple-A Gwinnett on Tuesday is second in the organization with 126 strikeouts and is T-1st with 21 starts. He ranks among the organizational leaders in opponent's batting average (2nd, .220), WHIP (4th, 1.25), innings pitched (2nd, 105.1), and

16-Strikeout Game: Hackenberg became the first pitcher in Minor League Baseball to strike out 16 on July 21 at Pensacola, setting a new club record. He became the 21st Minor League pitcher since 2005 to record 16 or more strikeouts in a single game.

ROSTER SHAKEUP: The M-Braves have made 18 roster moves since July 28. On Thursday, RHP Darius Vines was placed on the 60-Day Injured list, and on Tuesday, RHP Drue Hackenberg was promoted to Triple-A Gwinnett, and RHP Ryan Bourassa was added from High-A Rome.

MCCABE MAKING IT BACK: DH David McCabe had Tommy John surgery in February, returned to action, and made his M-Braves debut on July 30. McCabe hit his first home run on August 9 vs. Pensacola, his first home run since August 18, 2023, while with Rome. In 2023, McCabe led the Braves farm system with 75 RBI and finished T-3rd in homers

M-BRAVES SET SINGLE-SEASON STEALS RECORD: With five stolen bases on July 20 at Pensacola, the M-Braves set a new single-season record for steals in a season (in 88 games), surpassing the previous mark, 159, set by the 2007

Leading Double-A: Mississippi leads Double-A with 211 stolen bases (211-for-265, 80%) through 122 games. The closest club is Montgomery, with 200. The M-Braves are on pace for 237 (1.73 per game) in 2024. Birmingham set the Southern League record with 264 in 1989.

First to 200 Steals: With three steals on August 16 at Biloxi, the M-Braves became the first team in Double-A and 10th in minor league baseball to reach 200 steals in 2024.

Four players with 30+ steals: The M-Braves became the first team in Minor League Baseball to have four players with 30+ steals in 2024. Justin Dean led the way at the time of his August 8 promotion to Triple-A and led Double-A with 47. Cal Conley ranks T-3rd in the Southern League with 39, Cody Milligan is 6th with 35, and Geraldo Quintero is T-9th with 32 ... The M-Braves became the first team with 4+ players with 30+ steals since the 2022 Down East Wood Ducks (5). The most by a team since 2005 was the 2017 Lancaster Jethawks with six players.

M-BRAVES TO THE SHOW: RHP Parker Dunshee became the eighth M-Braves alum, and fourth from the 2024 squad to make an MLB debut this season on August 8 for Atlanta. He also became the 177th alum to debut since 2005. Dunshee joined Roddery Munoz (4/20, MIA), Tyler Ferguson (5/7, OAK), Spencer Schwellenbach (5/29), Justyn-Henry Malloy (6/3, DET), Hurston Waldrep (6/9), C.J. Alexander (6/24, KC), and Tanner Gordon (7/9, COL) and Nacho Alvarez Jr. (7/22, ATL). Overall, 176 former M-Braves have made their Major League debut.

FINAL SEASON IN MISSISSIPPI: On January 9. it was announced that after 20 years. 2024 will be the M-Braves' final season in Pearl, MS. As of the start of the 2025 season, the Double-A affiliate of the Atlanta Braves will be relocating to Columbus, GA.

- Mejia makes his 23rd appearance, and 22nd start of 2024, and 21st for the M-Braves. This will be his
 fifth start against the Blue Wahoos.
- League Leaders: Mejia ranks among the league leaders in ERA (5th, 3.53), strikeouts (4th, 110), WHIP (4th, 1.27), opponent's batting average (4th, .229), and innings (T-7th, 109.2).
- Home Sweet Home: Mejia is 5-3 with a 2.79 ERA over 10 starts at Trustmark Park

LAST TIME OUT

 Mejia suffered the loss, despite his eighth quality, last Saturday in a 3-0 loss to Chattanooga at Trustmark Park. The right-hander gave up three runs on four hits over 6.1 innings, three walks, and seven strikeouts. Mejia exited with one out and the bases loaded in the top of the seventh. Jorge Juan allowed all three inherited runners to score.

2024 NOTES

- Transactions: Mejia was promoted to Mississippi to Triple-A Gwinnett on 5/23, and transferred back to Mississippi on 5/24. In his lone Triple-A start, he suffered the loss on 5/23 vs. Jacksonville (1.1 IP, 5 H, 5 ER, 3 BB, 1 SO, 2 HR).
- Club-Record Scoreless Streak: Mejia set a new club record with 30.1 consecutive scoreless innings for the M-Braves from 4/28 to 6/5. The streak ended in the first inning of his 6/5 start at PNS.
- 2x: Southern League Pitcher of the Week (4/30-5/5 & 5/14-5/19): Tossed 7.0 shutout innings, on two
 hits with one walk, and seven strikeouts on 5/4 to earn Southern League Pitcher of the Week.
- No Hitter: Tossed a seven-inning no-hitter in game two of the Friday, May 17 doubleheader vs. Biloxi (7.0 IP, 0 H, 0 R, 2 BB, 11 SO). His 11 strikeouts were a career hig. It was the fifth no-hitter in M-Braves history, and first individual one since Tommy Hanson's nine-inning no hitter on June 25, 2008 vs. Birmingham at Trustmark Park. The M-Braves beat the Barons 6-0, and Hanson walked three and struck out 14 in the game. There have been three combined nine-inning no-hitters in team history (Julio Teheran & Tyrelle Harris, 8/2/10 vs. Mobile, Ian Anderson & Jeremy Walker, 6/28/19 vs. Jackson (TN), and Bryce Elder & Daysbel Hernandez, 7/10/21 vs. Pensacola.
- Massive May: Over four Mississippi starts in May, was 4-0 and didn't allow a run in 26.2 innings, five walks to 30 strikeouts.

2023 NOTES

Made 23 starts for High-A Rome, going 4-11 with a 4.69 ERA (63 ER/121.0 IP), 28 walks, 110 strikeouts, and 1.23 WHIP ... Ranked among Atlanta farmhands in ERA (7th, 4.69), strikeouts (9th, 110), starts (4th, 23), innings pitched (5th, 121.0), BAA (7th, 260), WHIP, and (4th, 1.23) ... In June, Mejia posted a 2.81 ERA (8 ER/25.2 IP) with three walks and 14 strikeouts for his best month of the season.

2022 NOTES

Appeared at three levels of the Atlanta Braves organization in 2022, going 0-1 with a 3.78 ERA (7 ER/16.2 IP) with five walks and 13 strikeouts over six games (all starts) for FCL, Low-A Augusta, and High-A Rome ... was promoted to Augusta on August 9, and promoted to Rome on August 23.

AMATEUR

Mejia was on the University of Arizona roster in 2019 before moving over to Pima where he had
a 3-0 record and a 3.28 ERA. He then signed on with New Mexico State where he earned National
Player of the Week honors in May of this spring and he helped lead the Aggies to a WAC championship and an NCAA tournament appearance. He collected nine strikeouts in seven innings of work
in an extra-inning loss to Oregon State in the tournament. Other: Father and brother both played
baseball professionally in Mexico.
