FRIDAY: The Ponies rallied with three in the ninth inning to pull out the 3-1 win over the Yard Goats on Friday night. Down 1-0, the Ponies finally made inroads against Hartford starter Nick Bush as David Rodriguez's sac fly to right drove home Jake Mangum to tie the game. Later in the frame, Luis Carpio hit a go-ahead RBI single scoring Carlos Rincon. Binghamton got an insurance run when Manny Rodriguez reached on an error scoring Hayden Senger. The two teams have split the first four games of the series.

OLLER OUTSTANDING: Adam Oller allowed just one run on four hits over six and a third innings with no walks and tying a career-high with 10 strikeouts. He ended up with the no-decision as he was in a pitchers duel with Hartford LHP Nick Bush who allowed only two runs over eight and a third frames.

HOME RUN LEADERS ON BOTH TEAMS: With Elehuris Montero's solo home run Friday night, he pulled into a tie with Mark Vientos for most home runs in the Northeast League this year (20). Vientos was off last night but has already hit 3 HR this series, including two on Thursday night. Vientos continues to set a new career high in HR as his previous season high was 12 HR in 2019 with Columbia (A)

MEYER FINDS POWER STROKE: After coming into this series with 1 homer this season, C Nick Meyer has homered in back-to-back games for the first time in his pro career.

MOVING ON UP: With last night's win, the Rumble Ponies moved into fourth place in the Northeast division, the first time they've been in fourth since June 13th. After starting May 4-19, the Ponies have been playing .500 baseball (25-25) in June and July.

EXCELLENCE FROM EDWARDS: RHP Andrew Edwards pitched two and a third innings of scoreless relief last night allowing just one hit. Edwards has not allowed a run in five appearances with Binghamton since being called up from Brooklyn (A+) on July 16. With the Cyclones the lefty had a 1.65 ERA over 23 appearances. He was a 31st round pick by the Mets out of New Mexico State in 2019.

MONTERO MASHING: Yard Goats INF Elehuris Montero had the lone Hartford run in Friday night's contest. He is red hot in July hitting .435 with 12 HR and 27 RBI this month. Montero now has 58 runs batted in on the season, good for 1st in the Northeast League. The infielder came over to the Colorado Rockies as part of the Nolan Arenado trade that sent the 3rd baseman to St. Louis.

COMING UP: Tonight is the fifth game of a 6-game series in Hartford. The Rumble Ponies will return home for a 13-game homestand starting on August 3rd with a 7 game series against the Portland Sea Dogs.
