The two clubs split a six-game series at Classic Park in late April/early May. Lansing is coming in on a five-game losing streak following a 3-9 homestand against Fort Wayne and Beloit in which the Lugnuts were outscored 77-52, including 25-0 the last two Sundays. Left-hander **Mac Lardner**, who started the Nuts' last win and tossed six scoreless innings last Tuesday, gets the start against Captains right-hander **Tanner Bibee**.

Last Game, Sunday: Beloit Sky Carp 11, Lansing Lugnuts 0. The Sky Carp hit two homers and six doubles amid a 16-hit barrage to back seven shutout innings and 11 strikeouts from **Zach King**, finishing off winning five of six games at Jackson Field. The Nuts managed three hits – singles from **Joshwan Wright**, **Gabriel Maciel** and **Matt Cross** – in the losing cause.

On Deck: The Lugnuts play the Captains through Sunday before returning home to host the Great Lakes Loons on Independence Day.

Hit Parade: Beloit closed out the series with the Lugnuts with 18 hits on Friday, 17 on Saturday and 16 on Sunday, totaling 51 over the first three games of the second half.

Controlling the Caps: Offense, however, is something that Lake County has struggled with against the Lugnuts' pitching staff. Though the Caps have five wins in nine meetings, the Lake County lineup has batted just .195 with a .574 OPS in those nine games, with 74 strikeouts compared to 17 walks.

Follow Their Lead: The Lugnuts' best hitters against the Captains have been **Jared McDonald** (6-for-12, one double, two walks, in four games) and **Gabriel Maciel** (4-for-8, two walks, three runs scored, in three games).

No June Swoon: OF **Lawrence Butler** has been fantastic this month, slashing .322/.385/.517 (.902 OPS) with seven doubles, two triples, two homers and three steals. C **Matt Cross** has also been excellent as of late: 9-for-29, one triple, two homers, for a .310 avg. and .586 slugging percentage this month.

Nuts to the Show: 6-foot-2, 280-pound pitcher **Max Castillo** (2018) made his MLB debut for the Toronto Blue Jays on June 19, becoming the 169th all-time Lugnut to reach The Show. He is the 8th former Lugnut to reach the Majors this year, joining Oakland A's pitchers **Zach Logue** (2018) and **Zach Jackson** (2017) and infielder **Christian Lopes** (2013); Toronto Blue Jays utilityman **Vinny Capra** (2018) and catcher **Gabriel Moreno** (2019); Seattle Mariners reliever **Danny Young** (2016) and Boston Red Sox starting pitcher **Josh Winckowski** (2019) as former Lugnuts to make it to the Major Leagues this year.

Hey Now: 2019 Lugnuts catcher **Alejandro Kirk** (Toronto) has garnered over 1.8 million All-Star votes, over a million more than the next closest candidate, and appears to be well on his way to starting the All-Star game for the American League. 2017 Nut **Vladimir Guerrero, Jr.** leads all American League first basemen and 2017 Nut **Bo Bichette** leads all A.L. shortstops. 2015 Nut **Danny Jansen** is third in DH voting, trailing only Yordan Alvarez and Shohei Ohtani while leading J.D. Martinez and Miguel Cabrera.

26 PHIL POHL MANAGER

Born in Bakersfield, Calif., Phil Pohl's family moved to Cooperstown when he was nine years old. He starred at Cooperstown Central High School, where he was honored as the 2008 Gatorade New York High School Baseball Player of the Year.

Pohl was drafted by Tampa Bay in the 44th round, becoming Cooperstown Central's first ever draft pick, but decided to attend Clemson University. He served as a two-time team captain for the Tigers, was honored three times as a member of the ACC Academic Honor Roll, and was selected Second Team All-ACC.

Pohl signed as a 28th-round pick of the Athletics in 2012 and played four seasons of Minor League Baseball, rising as high as Triple-A Sacramento. Upon retiring from playing, he rejoined the organization as the A's MLB bullpen catcher, a position he held through the end of the 2021 season. This is his first season managing.

2017: Bo Bichette and Vladimir Guerrero, Jr., hit back-to-back home runs off Bowling Green reliever Joe Serrapica in the bottom of the seventh, but the Lugnuts fell to the Hot Rods, 10-6. Bichette finished 3-for-5 to raise his batting average to .402, reaching 102 hits for the year.

2019: Hagen Danner notched his second two-HR game of the year, Griffin Conine swatted a two-run shot, and the host Lugnuts beat Lake County, 9-4. Danner knocked solo home runs down the left-field line in the third inning and down the right-field line in the fourth inning, erasing an early 2-0 deficit.

Giant Ties: Mac's godfather is Mike Krukow, who pitched 14 years in MLB (1976-89) with the Cubs, Giants and Phillies, and is in his 30th season broadcasting for the San Francisco Giants. Krukow was honored as the 2015 and 2017 California Sportscaster of the Year.

Templeton High School: Was team captain on the varsity of baseball team all four years of high school, playing first base and pitching... honored as Max Preps First Team All-American, Max Preps First Team All-State and Under Armour Preseason All-American... member of Team USA... posted 1.46 ERA in 272 2/3 combined high school innings.

College Days: Mac majored in business at Gonzaga... pitched in 13 games, six starts, as a freshman: 3-1, 3.99, 49 2/3 IP, 17 BB, 37 K... in college debut, February 18, 2017, vs. Duke: 6 IP, 1 R, 8 K... started WCC championship on May 27: 6 IP, 1 R, 4 K vs. BYU... made 16 starts as a sophomore: 7-4, 2.95 ERA, 100 2/3 IP, 28 BB, 73 K... named to 2018 All-WCC Second Team and WCC All-Tournament Team... started WCC championship game again and earned win: 7 2/3 IP, 6 H, 2 R, 0 BB, 7 K in 17-2 win over Pepperdine... in junior year, started 13 games: 6-4, 5.06 ERA, 74 2/3 IP, 15 BB, 69 K... 2019 All-WCC Honorable Mention... in senior year, made four starts: 2.55 ERA, 24 2/3 IP, 8 BB, 33 K, .202 avg.... opened season with six shutout innings, 9 K, vs. BYU.

Midwest League – uh, High-A Central – Experience: Lardner was signed as an undrafted free agent by the St. Louis Cardinals in 2020 following the five-round draft, spending his professional debut season with the Peoria Chiefs (0-6, 5.91 ERA, 21 G, 14 GS, 67 IP, 22 BB, 73 K... opened season as the Chiefs' No. 3 starter and turned in four scoreless innings, allowing one hit, vs. Cedar Rapids on May 6, 2021, in his pro debut... longest outing was his last: 6 2/3 IP on Sept. 18 vs. theernels... finished with 0.87 GO/AO ratio... allowed .305 avg. to left-handers, .253 to right-handers... pitched at both Pohlman Field and ABC Supply Stadium last year.

The Next Step: Released by the St. Louis Cardinals on March 28, Mac signed with the Washington Wild Things on April 7... said Washington manager Tom Vaeth, "Mac is an important signing for us, being a rookie and left-handed he helps fill the void left by Hennen's departure. Mac was very successful while at Gonzaga with a reputation as a strike thrower with a three-pitch mix. After bouncing between starting and relieving while with the Cardinals, we feel Mac will return to his old form pitching in the rotation."... unfortunately for Washington, the Oakland Athletics signed Mac on May 4.

2022 with the Lugnuts:

- Started against the Dayton Dragons on May 14... tossed perfect 1st inning, striking out Jose Torres and Justice Thompson... allowed leadoff double to Alex McGarry in the 2nd and two-out walk to Nick Quintana, but struck out Allan Cerda and J.V. Martinez to strand two... things unraveled in the 3rd inning, however: two outs, none on, Elly De La Cruz doubled, Justice Thompson singled, Alex McGarry homered, Rece Hinds doubled and Allan Cerda singled, ending his outing... Lugnuts rallied to Mac's defense, beating Dayton 8-7.
- Started at Great Lakes, May 20th... twirled three scoreless innings, limiting the Loons to one hit and three walks while striking out three... stranded Jorbit Vivas single in the 1st inning... walked the first two batters in the 2nd, but set down the next three, including Ismael Alcantara and Imanol Vargas by strikeout... pitched around two-out walk of Vivas in the 3rd inning, finishing outing with strikeout of Jose Ramos... Lugnuts lost, 6-2, as bullpen allowed three runs in 4th and three runs in 8th.
- Started at Beloit, Game 2 of a doubleheader, May 27th... pitched four innings, allowing three unearned runs in the 3rd inning... those were the only runs in the game in a 3-0 loss to the Sky Carp... runs were unearned due to Lardner's own throwing error.
- Started vs. Cedar Rapids, June 2nd... pitched season high 4 2/3 innings, allowing one run in the 2nd inning and departing after allowing two-run homer to Christian Encarnacion-Strand in the 5th... 76 pitches, 45 strikes... bullpen trio of Joe DeMers (1.2), Kumar Nambiar (1.0) and Brock Whittlesey (1.2) combined for scoreless relief in 7-3 win.
- Started at home vs. Fort Wayne, June 15... allowed two runs in both the 2nd and 3rd innings, going five innings in all... earned first Lugnuts win, as Nuts scored three in the 3rd and two in the 5th en route to a 9-5 win behind a 15-hit effort.
- **Last Start: recorded first quality start with six scoreless innings vs. Beloit, June 21st, scattering four hits and one walk... Lugnuts completed seven-hit shutout in 10-0 victory.**
