SEA DOGS SHUTOUT 'CATS' The Portland Sea Dogs (6-4) blanked the New Hampshire Fisher Cats (7-5) 3-0 to record their second shutout win of the season. Zach Penrod, Ryan Zeferjahn, Christopher Troye, and Felix Cepeda combine to silence the 'Cats bats. A pitcher's duel kept the ballgame scoreless on both sides as Penrod carried a no-hitter into the sixth inning. In his two starts this season he has tossed a combined 10.1 scoreless innings allowing three hits and recording 14 strikeouts. Matthew Lugo ignited the scoring with an RBI double (1) in the bottom of the seventh to score Eddinson Paulino who reached with a leadoff walk. With the double to left, Portland got on the board first, 1-0. In the bottom of the eighth, Kyle Teel singled to leadoff before a pair of force outs advanced him to third. Lugo grounded into a force out to allow Teel to score and extend the 2-0 lead. A single from Mickey Gasper would put another runner on before an RBI single from Alex Binelas would drive home Lugo and plate the third run of the day. The Fisher Cats threatened in the ninth but Felix Cepeda came in to record his second save of the season after firing 1.0 inning with a strikeout.

PENROD, PORTLAND PITCHING Across two starts in Double-A, Penrod has pitched 10.2 shutout innings for Portland. He has allowed just three hits while recording fourteen strikeouts and has held opponents to a .091 average against him. Penrod ranks recond in lowest opponent average just behind Doug Nikhazy (Akron) who has held opponents to a .033 average across 10.0 IP. Penrod is one of four starters in the Eastern League with a 0.00 ERA. The Sea Dogs sport the fourth-best ERA across the Eastern League with a 3.54 ERA across ten games and 84.0 IP. Portland pitching has held opponents to a .199 average collectively.

HOME RUN HITTERS Portland launched twelve homers across six games in Reading last week. Eddinson Paulino now leads the team with three on the season. Roman Anthony and Matthew Lugo have each hit a pair while Nick Decker, Max Ferguson, Marcelo Mayer, Kyle Teel, Nick Yorke, and Mickey Gapser all have tallied one. Portland is tied for third in all of Double-A with the Tulsa Drillers (TEX) and the Wichita Wind Surge (TEX) ranks just behind the Somerset Patriots (16) and the Midland RockHounds (14).

MAYER ON FIRE Marcelo Mayer is currently riding an nine-game hitting streak along with a nine-game on base streak coming into today. The top prospect has tallied a .333 average with a .359 OBP over nine games this season. Across those nine games, he has tallied seven runs, twelve hits, two doubles, one homer, five RBI and a pair of stolen bags. He leads Sea Dogs batters in runs and hits coming into the day.

AMONGST BASEBALL'S BEST According to a recent ranking by Baseball America, the Portland Sea Dogs rank second in the "10 Most Talented Minor League Baseball Teams for 2024". Portland comes in just behind the Norfolk Tides (Orioles AAA) who rank first. The Sea Dogs are the only other team besides the Tides to have three Top 100 Prospects on their roster.

PROMISING PROSPECTS IN PORTLAND The top three prospects in Boston's system (according to MLB.com and Baseball America) will begin the season in Portland with Marcelo Mayer (1), Roman Anthony (2), and Kyle Teel (3) headling the Opening Day Roster. Mayer appeared in 43 games with Portland in 2023 prior to a shoulder injury that ended his season in early August. Both Anthony and Teel were promoted to Portland for the final 10 games of last season. In their first glimpses of Double-A, Anthony hit .343 with four doubles, one homer, and three stolen bases while Teel recorded a .363 average with six doubles, two home runs, and three stolen bases. All three prospects were invited to Winter Weekend with the Red Sox in 2023 while also earning invitations to the inaugural Spring Breakout Game. Teel was named to the Spring Breakout First Team at the catcher position.

ROSTER REVIEW The Portland Sea Dogs will begin the season with 22 returning players from the 2023 season. Among the Opening Day roster, 9 players rank in the Red Sox top 30 prospect rankings according to MLB.com to enter the 2024 season.

THIS DAY IN SEA DOGS HISTORY: April 19, 2022 - Devlin Granberg finishes a triple shy of the cycle in a walk-off 6-5 victory against the Binghamton Rumble Ponies at Hadlock Field. He led off the bottom of the ninth inning with a double then scored on a walk-off fielding error by the Rumble Ponies.

PITCHING PREVIEW LHP Helcris Olivarez will take the mound for the Sea Dogs in game four of the series. Olivarez last pitched on 4/13 in Reading for game one of a doubleheader where he tossed 1.2 innings allowing one run one one hit while walking five and striking out three. Opponents are batting .167 against him. He has yet to face the Fisher Cats in his career after being signed as a Minor League Free Agent by the Red Sox in November 2023.

## Sea Dogs Coaching Staff

#### **CHAD EPPERSON - MANAGER**

Epperson returns for his third season as Portland's manager. In 2023, he led the Sea Dogs to an overall record of 73-63 (.537). In 2022, Epperson led the Sea Dogs to a Double-A best 45-24 (.652) record in the second half, securing Portland's first post-season berth since 2014. Before managing the Sea Dogs, Epperson spent 12 seasons as the Red Sox Catching Coordinator. Prior to that, he spent his first eight seasons with the Red Sox as a manager or coach at the minor league level. A manager from 2004-09, he led his club to the playoffs in four straight campaigns beginning in 2006, including Single-A Salem in 2009. A back-to-back California League Manager of the Year with Lancaster from 2007-08, he also managed Wilmington to the playoffs in 2006. The Kentucky native managed Capital City in 2005 and Augusta in 2004 after spending two seasons (2002-03) as Sarasota's hitting coach. He also managed Cook County of the independent Frontier League in 2001. Epperson played nine years in the minor leagues in the Mets (1992-95), Red Sox (1997-99), and Orioles (2000) systems before his coaching career.

#### **CHRIS HESS - HITTING COACH**

Chris returns to Portland after serving as the Greenville Drive's hitting coach in 2023. He was a coach for the Sea Dogs in 2022 and in Fort Myers during the 2021 season. During his time with the Drive, they ranked first in batting average (.259), hits (1,133), doubles (249), second in triples (36) and third in RBI (618) in the South Atlantic League. The Drive were also crowned South Atlantic League champions for the 2023 season. This year will mark Hess' fourth year in the Red Sox organization. Previously, he was an assistant coach at the University of Rhode Island, his alma mater, after three seasons playing in the New York Yankees organization (2017-19). Hess replaces former Hitting Coach Doug Clark who was promoted to be the Hitting Coach for the Triple-A Worcester Red Sox.

#### SEAN ISAAC - PITCHING COACH

Isaac enters his second season as a coach in the Red Sox organization. He led the Sea Dogs to a 4.10 ERA and 30 saves in 2023. His pitching staff finished the year with 1,308 strikeouts, fifth most in the Eastern League. In 2022 he was the assistant pitching coach for the Nashville Sounds, the Triple-A affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers. Previously Isaac served as the Director of Player Development at UC-Santa Barbara. He spent three seasons (2016-2018) as a minor league pitcher in the Angels organization reaching the Triple-A level in 2017 and 2018. In 78 career games, he notched a 9-4 record with a 4.34 ERA. On May 2, 2018, he pitched the final inning of a combined no-hitter for Inland Empire.

#### **MICKEY JIANG - COACH**

The 2024 season will be Jiang's 18th with the Red Sox where he has held several different roles, including work as a consultant with International Scouting (2007-2012). He has been coaching in the Red Sox minor league system since 2009. He previously served as a coach in Portland from 2016-2017 and 2023. He served as a coach with Single-A Greenville in 2022 and with Fort Myers in 2012 and 2018-2021. A native of Taiwan, Jiang received his B.A. in International Trade from Tung-Hai University.

#### KYLE SASALA- COACH

Kyle joins Portland's staff after previously working as the Associate Head Coach at Grove City College from 2016 – 2023. Sasala helped the 2023 Wolverines to a school-record 30 victories, along with a 16-4 conference record. The Wolverines also won 28 games in both 2021 and 2022. In 2019, Sasala assisted head coach Matt Royer in leading the Wolverines to a then-program record 28 victories. He served as the team's interim head coach during the Eastern College Athletic Conference Division III Championship Tournament, guiding Grove City to a runner-up finish. Portland's former coach in 2023, Pablo Cabrera, was promoted to Complex Defensive Coach based out of Fort Myers with the Red Sox.

#### JUSTIN FROMETA - DEVELOPMENT COACH

Justin begins his second season as the Sea Dogs Development Coach and fourth in the Red Sox organization. He previously served as a Baseball Operations Associate and Player Development Associate for the Red Sox. He is a 2020 graduate of Tufts University.

#### **BOBBY STACHURA - ATHLETIC TRAINER**

Stachura returns to Portland for his second season as the Sea Dogs' Athletic Trainer. Stachura has served as the Athletic Trainer for Single-A Greenville for the past four seasons. He started in the Red Sox organization in 2017 as the Athletic Trainer for the Lowell Spinners. He also spent four years as an athletic trainer at the University of Rhode Island. Stachura graduated with a B.S. in Athletic Training from Lasell College in 2013. He received his M.S. from the University of Rhode Island's Department of Kinesiology in 2015.

#### **DONNY GRESS- STRENGTH AND CONDITIONING COACH**

After spending the last two seasons with the Greenville Drive, Donny Gress joins the Sea Dogs for the first time. Previously, Gress spent four years at the University of Kentucky, first as a graduate assistant (2018-2020), before becoming a coaching assistant with the Wildcats' Olympic Strength and Conditioning staff. Joe Hudson has been promoted to Worcester's Strength and Conditioning Coach after previously working with Portland in the same role in 2023.


