NOTES AND NUGGETS

GOOD TIMES, BAD TIMES

- The 2026 season has been a roller coaster ride for Omaha but things are trending up, with the Chasers coming off series wins over Toledo and St. Paul.
- After an 0-4 start to the year, the Chasers went 12-5 between April 1 and 21, then went 3-11 from April 22 to May 8 ... Omaha has won 11 of the last 18, since May 9.
- Omaha had a winning April, with a 13-12 record on the month ... last year, the Chasers had just one winning month, going 15-11 in August ... with a 13-13 record in May, the Storm Chasers needed to win today for a winning record in back-to-back months for the first time since July and August 2024.
- Prior to last Sunday's win, the Chasers had been under .500 for 29 days, from April 24 to May 23 ... Omaha has spent 18 days at or above .500, 15 of which came consecutively in a 13-game stretch from April 10 to 24.

SERIES SPEAKING

- This week's series loss is Omaha's 3rd of the season and the team's first since dropping back-to-back series to Toledo and Louisville from April 21 to May 3.
- The Chasers have won 5 of their 9 week-long series this season - taking series against Buffalo (4-2), Iowa (3-2), Indianapolis (4-2), Toledo (4-2) and St. Paul (4-2).
- In 4 of this season's 5 series wins, Omaha won the series opener ... in 3 of the series wins - against Buffalo, Toledo and St. Paul - the clubs split the first four games before the Storm Chasers took both remaining contests to claim the series.

COMEBACK KIDS

- The Storm Chasers have trailed at some point in each of their last 9 wins, with Friday's 7-6 victory representing Omaha's 16th overall comeback win this year.
- Over Omaha's last 9 wins (since May 13), the Storm Chasers have trailed for a total of 17 innings, 6.5 of those innings coming in 4 wins last week in St. Paul.
- Omaha's 16 comeback wins rank tied for the 2nd-most in the International League and tied 4th at the Triple-A level ... the Chasers' 100 comeback wins since 2024 rank 2nd-most in the International League and 3rd-most in Triple-A.

CATCH ME IF YOU CAN

- Stealing bases has been one of the strongest areas for the Storm Chasers this season, led by a quartet of baserunning threats.
- Omaha's 83.1% success rate (59-for-71) ranks 4th in the IL and 7th in Triple-A.
- John Rave** leads Omaha in steals (13) ... **Gavin Cross** has 11 steals in as many tries, the 2nd-most steals in the IL without being caught ... **Kameron Misner** has swiped 9 bags, while **Tyler Tolbert** has 8 steals.

PATIENCE IS A VIRTUE

- A constant in 2026 has been Omaha's ability to go deep in plate appearances.
- The Storm Chasers are seeing 4.004 pitches per plate appearance, 3rd-most in the International League and 6th at the Triple-A level.
- Among 193 Triple-A players with 150+ plate appearances this year, **Kameron Misner** is 5th in pitches seen/PA (4.445) while **John Rave** ranks 8th (4.404).

DON'T BRETT, SQUIRES IS HERE!

- Chasers first baseman **Brett Squires** has been on fire across his first two weeks at the Triple-A level, since earning a promotion to Omaha on May 12.
- After a 1-for-15 (.067) start in his first 4 Triple-A games, Squires is 17-for-46 (.370) over his last 12 games with 4 doubles, 1 triple, 6 home runs and 14 RBI.
- Combining his Double-A and Triple-A games, Squires is hitting .294 (53-for-180) with 15 doubles, 1 triple, 13 home runs, 45 RBI and a .975 OPS ... he ranks tied 4th among Minor Leaguers in extra-base hits (29), tied 11th in the Minors in home runs and tied 12th in RBI and total bases (109).
- His 11 extra-base hits since May 16 are tied for 3rd-most of any player in baseball (Majors & Minors), while 41 total bases in that stretch are 3rd-most in the Minors and 4th in baseball ... his .891 SLG since May 16 is the 3rd-best in baseball (min. 30 PA), trailing **Jhonnardo Reyes** (1.000, FCL Twins) and **Jacob Gonzalez** (.980, CLT).

MAYS-TERCLASS

- With one day remaining in the month of May, the Storm Chasers have one of the League's best hitters this month and a trio of strong bullpen arms.
- Luca Tresh** has been one of the International League's best hitters in May, hitting .373 (25-for-67) with 9 extra-base hits and 16 RBI in 18 games, for a 1.000 OPS ... 21 hits in games he's caught this month are tied 4th-most among MiLB catchers.
- Eric Cerantola** and **Jose Cuas** have both been especially effective out of Omaha's bullpen this month ... Cerantola has pitched to a 1.13 ERA (1 ER in 8.0 IP) in 7 outings while Cuas has a 2.38 ERA (3 ER in 11.1 IP) in 11 games this month.

TODAY'S START

- Mitch Spence is making his **8th start** with the Storm Chasers this year and his **9th overall appearance** of the season.
- Playing his **7th professional season** this year ... the Royals are his 3rd Major League organization, after being drafted by the Yankees and spending the last two years with the Athletics.

A NEW SPENCE OF PURPOSE

- QUALITY CONTROL:** Spence threw consecutive quality starts, accounting for 2 of Omaha's 3 this season ... his outing on May 7 @ Indianapolis (PIT) was the team's first quality start of the season ... has pitched at least 5.0 innings in 4 of 7 Triple-A starts with a 2.78 ERA (7 ER in 22.2 IP) in those 4 outings.
- START ME UP:** Spence spent **2021-2023** almost exclusively as a starter in the Yankees' Minor League system before bouncing between roles in the A's organization ... he began both **2024** and **2025** in Oakland's bullpen before transitioning to the rotation each June ... he remained a starter after being optioned to Triple-A last year, though 2 of his 3 MLB appearances in September came in relief.

LAST OUTING: TUESDAY, MAY 26 vs. MEMPHIS

- Made his 7th start with Omaha, his shortest outing of the year ... allowed a leadoff homer to Colton Ledbetter in the 1st, then fired a perfect 2nd ... surrendered a 2-run HR to Joshua Baez and an RBI double in the 3rd ... allowed 9 straight hits to open the 4th without recording an out, with 7 runs scoring before his exit and 2 bequeathed runners also scoring to cap a 9-run inning ... 15 hits tied a modern Omaha franchise record (since 2005), while 13 runs and 13 earned runs set new franchise records.

2026 HIGHLIGHTS

- Was designated for assignment by the Athletics on February 10 and traded to Kansas City on February 12 in exchange for RHP **A.J. Causey**.
- Worked back-to-back quality starts for the Storm Chasers on May 7 and May 15, allowing 6 hits and 4 walks over 12.2 innings (0.79 WHIP) between the two games.

CAREER NOTES

- Spent much of the year in the Major Leagues with the Athletics, splitting time as a starter and reliever ... made the A's Opening Day roster for the second straight year and opened the season as a reliever, making 22 relief appearances with a 4.38 ERA (19 ER in 39.0 IP) and 37 strikeouts before June 2.
- Made his first start of the year June 5 and worked a 1.20 ERA (2 ER in 15.0 IP) in his first three games as a starter ... optioned to Triple-A Las Vegas on July 10 and pitched in 8 games (7 starts) before the Athletics recalled him on September 10 for the remainder of the season.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- Was the 1st overall pick by the Athletics in the Rule 5 Draft on December 6, **2023** ... spent all of **2024** in the Major Leagues with Oakland and posted a 4.58 ERA (77 ER in 151.1 IP) with an 8-10 record and 126 strikeouts to 44 walks (2.86 K/BB) across 35 games (24 starts).
- Pitched part of **2022** and all **2023** in with the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders (AAA) in the Yankees organization, producing an 11-10 record with a 4.33 ERA (103 ER in 214.1 IP) and 201 strikeouts to 69 walks (2.91 K/BB) across 39 Triple-A starts.
- In **2023**, led the minors with 163.0 innings ... also ranked 3rd in MiLB in pitches (2,564) and tied for 3rd in starts (29) ... led the International League in innings and starts and ranked 2nd in strikeouts (153).
- Opened **2022** with the Somerset Patriots (AA) and pitched in 17 games (15 starts) before his promotion to Triple-A on August 2 ... spent all of **2021** with the Hudson Valley Renegades (A+) and put up a 3.94 ERA (46 ER in 105.0 IP) with 118 strikeouts to 37 walks (3.19 K/BB) in 23 games (20 starts) at High-A.
- Made his professional debut in **2019** with the Pulaski Yankees (R) after New York drafted him in the 10th round of the 2019 MLB Draft ... pitched exclusively out of the bullpen and earned 4 saves.

MISCELLANEOUS

- Pitched 3 seasons (**2017-19**) for the University of South Carolina-Aiken (Peach Belt Conference, D2) ... worked a career 17-10 record with a 3.83 ERA (86 ER in 202.0 IP) and 243 strikeouts (10.8 K/9) for the Pacers ... in **2018**, struck out 117 batters in 92.0 innings (11.4 K/9) with a 3.03 ERA (31 ER in 92.0 IP).
- Is the all-time saves and career ERA leader at Green Hope High School (NC).
