### Homestand Part Two

The Fightin Phils remain home for the final week of the season's first half against the Hartford Yard Goats, Double-A affiliate of the Colorado Rockies. It is the 17th-of-24 matchups between the teams this season and 10th-of-12 games at FirstEnergy Stadium. Reading took the first series four to two from Apr. 7-12, then the teams split a series at Dunkin' Park from Apr. 28-May 3. Entering play today, the season series is tied at eight.

### Back In the Win Column

The Reading Fightin Phils snapped a four-game losing streak with a 4-2 victory over the Hartford Yard Goats at FirstEnergy Stadium, evening the season series at 8-8. Bryan Rincon set the tone with a leadoff home run in the first inning, and Reading added to its lead in the third when Raylin Heredia singled home Rincon. The Fightins extended their advantage to 4-0 in the fourth on RBI fielder's choices from Riley Tirota and Jordan Dissin. Luke Russo turned in one of the best starts of his career, tying a personal best with seven innings while allowing just two runs on five hits and striking out six. Hartford's only offense came in the seventh on Conner Capel's two-run homer, his sixth home run in three games. Alex McFarlane worked through late traffic in the ninth and struck out the final batter to earn his eighth save of the season. Rincon's leadoff homer proved to be the difference, while Alex Binelas, Pedro León and Luke Ritter each recorded multi-hit games as Reading improved to 29-38.

### Binelas Bombs Away

Alex Binelas clubbed his team-leading 14th home run of the season on Thursday night, a mark that is tied for third most in the Eastern League entering play on Friday. Binelas also ranks second amongst Phillies Minor League players in home runs, trailing Lehigh Valley's Felix Reyes, who has 16. After hitting nine home runs in April, Binelas was held to just one home run in May. But, since the calendar has turned to June, Binelas has lifted four home runs, all coming over the last eight games he's played in. Binelas' single-season career-high in home runs was 25 back in 2022. He hit eight homers over 68 games with Reading in 2025.

### Raking Raylin

Raylin Heredia continued his excellent homestand with two more home runs on Thursday night, along with a hit and RBI on Friday. It marked the second two home run game for him this season, and of his career, with the other coming on May 3 at Hartford. The 22-year old has already hit 12 home runs this season, which is a single-season career-high, surpassing his previous best of eight. Over his last 10 games, Heredia is slashing .375/.419/.800 (1.219 OPS), along with six runs, two doubles, five home runs and nine RBI. Entering play on Saturday, Heredia leads the Eastern League with 21 doubles, while also ranking 8th in batting average (.285), third with 73 hits, second with 34 extra-base hits, tied for ninth with 41 runs and third with 132 total bases.

### Going, Going, Gone

The Fightin Phils are back to hitting home runs at a torrid pace over the homestand, as they lifted an Eastern League-best 18 long balls over their last 10 games. Through 67 games, Reading has hit 83 home runs, which ranks as second most in the Eastern League and they are on pace for 171 this season, which comes after Reading hit 118 in 2025.

### Bring It Brito

Erick Brito's strong run with Reading continued last week as he slashed .400/.478/.700 (1.178 OPS) over six games, along with seven runs scored, three doubles, one home run, four RBI and five stolen bases. The highlight of his week was when he matched a career-high with four hits on Friday night, which featured a game-tying three-run home run in the bottom of the ninth with two outs.

### Stealing Bags and Limiting Them

Since the start of June, the Fightin Phils lead the Eastern League with 28 stolen bases, leading second-place Erie by two stolen bags. Entering play on Saturday, Reading is second to Erie in the league with 108 stolen bases and is on pace for 222 this season. This came after the Fightin Phils swiped 173 bags in 2025. The last time Reading stole over 200 bags in a season was 1983, when they stole a franchise record 272 that season. On the other side of the ball, the Fightin Phils have allowed the fewest stolen bases in the Eastern League at 58 and third in runners caught stealing with 28.

### This Day in Baseballtown History

June 20, 1991: At Reading, Pete Rose makes a surprise visit to Municipal Stadium to honor Mike Schmidt on the night Schmidt's number 24 is retired by the R-Phils. Rose had been banned from Organized Baseball and was not permitted to attend any Major or Minor League games at the time. The R-Phils had planned on retiring Schmidt's number the season before but the game was rained out. As for the game, Reading's Sean Ryan hits a 2-run homer in the 8th to break a 4-4 tie and lift the home team to a 6-4 win over Canton-Akron.

### Hey Hartford

The Yard Goats enter play tonight with a 38-28 and clinched the Eastern League Northeast Division Crown on Friday night, thanks to Somerset's loss at Portland. It is the second playoff appearance in Yard Goat franchise history, with the other coming also thanks to a first half title during the 2024 season. Hartford had a good week against New Hampshire last week, taking five-of-seven games. Following this week, Hartford starts the second half at home against Portland. Hartford's roster features six of the Colorado Rockies Top-30 prospects: Jared Thomas (4), Griffin Herring (9), Roc Riggio (10), Jackson Cox (19), Cole Messina (21) and Konner Eaton (25).

### Goats Pitcher

Righty Connor Staine makes his 13th appearance and 12th start of the season for Hartford on Saturday night. Staine is 4-1, with a 4.09 ERA (25 ER, 55.0 IP), along with 64 strikeouts. He last pitched on Sunday against New Hampshire, allowing three runs over five innings, with five strikeouts. Staine faced Reading twice this season, allowing three runs over 2.2 IP on Apr. 8 and surrendering three runs across five innings on May 3. He spent all of 2025 with Hartford, going 3-8, with a 4.91 ERA over 25 starts, Staine pitched for Spokane (A) in 2024 and began his pro career with Fresno (A) in 2023. The 25-year old was drafted by the Rockies in the fifth round in 2022 out of Central Florida.
