series vs. the Louisville Bats (Cincinnati Reds) at Coolray Field. It is the third of nine meetings between the two clubs this year, all to be played in Lawrenceville. Tonight is ALS Lou Gehrig Day, and Thirsty Thursday™ presented by Michelob Ultra (fans age 21 and older can get select 12 oz. domestic beers for \$2 each).

VS. LOUISVILLE: Gwinnett is 30-21 (.588) in 51 games vs. Louisville at Coolray Field since 2009. The Stripers have won five straight home games over the Bats dating back to 5/14/21 (outscoring LOU 28-13 in that span), and have won the season home series over Louisville in each of the last four seasons (13-3 in that span).

WALK IT OFF: The Stripers tallied their third walk-off win of the year last night, improving to 8-3 (.727) in games decided in the last at-bat. Phil Gosselin's two-run double scored the tying and winning runs in the 10th inning, marking his first career walk-off hit with Gwinnett in his 276th game THE ELDER STROLLS: Bryce Elder set a new single-game with the club. He had a hand in one other walk-off win in club history (but no hit or RBI), hitting into a fielder's choice that resulted in an E6 scoring Brandon Boggs for a 3-2 win in 10 innings on 8/13/13 vs. Durham.

THE GOOSE IS LOOSE: Phil Gosselin went 3-for-4 last night, giving him a hit in 17 of 21 games since 5/1 (.342, 27-for-79, 8 2B, 1 3B, 4 HR, 12 R, 13 RBI, 2 SB, .993 OPS in that stretch). He now ranks ninth in the International League with a .309 average (47-for-152, 11 2B, 2 3B, 5 HR, 23 R, 21 RBI, 3 SB, .875 OPS), and has reached base safely in 36 of 41 games (87.8%) overall.

• 300 Hit Club: Gosselin raised his career hits total with Gwinnett to 302 last night, making him just the seventh player in club history to reach the 300-hit milestone. Over parts of four seasons (2013-14, 2018, 2022), he's batting .297 (302-for-1,016, 62 2B, 10 3B, 17 HR, 136 R, 103 RBI, 10 SB, .774 OPS) in 276 games.

KINGS OF THE "K": Following a seven-strikeout effort from Huascar Ynoa last night (ND, 5.0 IP, 2 H, 1 ER), Gwinnett pitchers lead Triple-A in strikeouts with 528 in 50 games (10.56 SO per game). That's 10 more than Sacramento of the PCL (2nd with 518 SO in 50G). Gwinnett last led Triple-A in strikeouts for a full season in 2011 (team-record 1,223 SO). Kyle Muller (T-3rd, 56) and Touki Toussaint (T-9th, 48) both rank among the IL top 10 in strikeouts through 6/1.

POWER UP: Braden Shewmake (3), Alex Dickerson (4), and Preston Tucker (3) all hit solo home runs last night. Shewmake's second-inning shot (off RHP Randy Wynne) was his first since 4/27 vs. Norfolk, snapping a 24-game drought. Tucker's blast in the sixth (off RHP Pedro Payano) was his first since 5/15 at Durham, ending a 10-game drought. Dickerson also homered off Wynne, his third in 11 games since 5/19 (.278, 10 RBI, .872 OPS).

TONIGHT: The Stripers play game three of a six-game **DEMERITTE RETURNS:** Travis Demeritte returned to the Stripers lineup last night (1-for-4, 2 R), his first game since being optioned by Atlanta on 5/28. He hit .213 (19-for-89, 2 2B, 3 HR, 9 R, 6 RBI) in 26 games during his first career stint with the Braves from 4/22-5/27.

> • GWN Career: Demeritte has reached base safely in 162 of 190 games (85.3%) with the Stripers since 2019, batting .284 (186-for-655, 49 2B, 4 3B, 43 HR, 128 R, 137 RBI, 13 SB, .944 OPS). He is one of three players in Gwinnett history with two 20-homer seasons, joining Stefan Gartrell and Ernesto Mejia.

career high for innings pitched on Monday, working 8.0 IP (2 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 8 SO) in the 2-0 win over Louisville. He carried a no-hit bid through 6.1 innings before Cristian Santana singled to center in the seventh. Elder's previous career high had been 7.0 innings, accomplished eight times (twice with Gwinnett this season).

DESHIELDS KEEPS REACHING: Delino DeShields Jr. ranks ninth in the IL in on-base percentage (.397), having reached base safely in 30 of 37 games with Gwinnett this season. He leads the Stripers in both walks (25, T-15th in IL) and stolen bases (10, T-14th in IL), batting .245 (26-for-106, 4 2B, 14 R, 10 RBI, .680 OPS).

TROMP MASHED IN MAY: Chadwick Tromp ranked among IL leaders in home runs (T-3rd, 8), RBI (T-6th, 22), slugging percentage (T-7th, .632), extra-base hits (T-10th, 12), and total bases (T-12th, 48) for the month of May. He was named the IL Offensive Player of the Week for 5/2-8 after batting .471 (8-for-17) with league highs in homers (4), extra-base hits (7), RBI (12), SLG (1.353), and OPS (1.879). Tromp's monster month included a Gwinnett-record nine-game extra-base hit streak from 5/1-12 (4 2B, 7 HR).

WATERS WATCH: Since being reinstated from the 7-day IL on 5/3, Drew Waters is batting .268 (19-for-71, 5 2B, 2 HR, 11 R, 7 RBI, 1 SB, .730 OPS) in 18 games.

- Start It With a Bang: Both of his homers have come on the first pitch of the game (5/3 vs. CLT off LHP Wes Benjamin and 5/11 at DUR off RHP Tommy Romero), the third and fourth leadoff homers of his Triple-A career.

MANAGER MATT TUIASOSOPO

Matt Tuiasosopo is in his second season as the manager of the Stripers in 2022 ... He was named the seventh manager in Gwinnett history on 3/30/21, making him the first former Gwinnett player to manage the club (played OF/1B from 2016-17) ... In 2021, he guided the Stripers to a 71-58 record (3rd in Triple-A East Southeast Division) ... On 5/4/21 at Charlotte, he became the youngest manager in Gwinnett history (34 years, 11 months, 25 days) ... From 7/8/21-9/21/21, his Stripers owned the best record in Triple-A Baseball (45-19, .703) ... Began his managerial career with Class-A Rome in 2019, earning Atlanta's Bobby Cox Award for Minor League Manager of the Year ... Coached at the Braves' Alternate Training Site in 2020.

TONIGHT'S START: Kyle Muller makes his ninth start with Gwinnett and 10th start overall this season in game three of a six-game series vs. Louisville.

Jesuit College Prep (Dallas, TX).

- IL Leaderboard: Entering play, he ranks among the league's top 20 pitchers in strikeouts (T-3rd, 56), ERA (13th, 3.83), BAA (16th, .247), and WHIP (18th, 1.32).
- GWN Career: Makes his 26th career start with the Stripers ... Is 7-7 with a 3.54 ERA, .231 BAA, and 10.99 SO/9.0 IP ratio (149 SO in 122.0 IP) since debuting in 2021.
- Triple-A Splits: Makes his 11th career start at Coolray Field (3-3, 2.61 ERA, .250 BAA) and 22nd career Triple-A night start (5-6, 3.48 ERA, .235 BAA).
- Hot Stretch: Over his last 21 starts with Gwinnett since 5/27/21, is 7-6 with a 2.95 ERA (35 ER in 106.2 IP), .219 BAA, 44 walks, and 128 strikeouts (10.80 SO/9.0 IP ratio).

PROSPECTING: Muller is currently ranked as the Atlanta Braves' No. 3 prospect by MLB.com ... He is the top-ranked pitcher on Gwinnett's active roster.

2022 WITH GWINNETT: 4/5 at MEM: Was the Stripers' Opening Night starter (ND, 4.2 IP, 4 H, 1 ER, 1 BB, 7 SO in 2-1 loss), making him the first player in Gwinnett history to start consecutive season openers (also on 5/4/21 at Charlotte) ... 4/10 at MEM: Earned his first Triple-A victory since 9/12/21 at Columbus (5.0 IP, 4 H, 2 ER in 5-4 win) ... Went 1-1 with a 3.66 ERA in four starts before being recalled on 5/1 ... 5/14 at DUR: Tied his career high with 12 strikeouts, but took the loss (6.0 IP, 6 H, 4 ER, 2 HR), pitched opposite his older brother Chris (1.0 IP, 2 BB, 2 SO with DUR in 6th) for the first time in his professional career.

2022 WITH ATLANTA: Recalled by the Braves on 5/1 ... Dallas native started that night against the Texas Rangers in Arlington (loss, 2.2 IP, 4 H, career-high 7 ER, 6 BB, 3 SO in Braves' 7-3 loss) ... Optioned back to Gwinnett after the game.

2021 SEASON: Muller made both his Triple-A debut with Gwinnett (5-4, 3.39 ERA, .223 BAA in 17 starts) and Major League debut with Atlanta (2-4, 4.17 ERA, .202 BAA in 9G, 8 starts) ... Posted a 4.60 ERA in his first stint with the Stripers (7 starts) before being recalled for his MLB debut on 6/16 vs. Boston (1.0 IP in relief, 4 H, 2 ER, 1 SO) ... Made his first MLB start on 6/21 at the New York Mets (loss, 4.0 IP, 0 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 2 BB, 3 SO in 4-2 loss) ...
