**TODAY'S GAME:** The Curve are in the midst of their 25th anniversary season, continuing a six-game series with Harrisburg.

**LAST TIME OUT:** **Bubba Chandler** brought a perfect game into the 5th and struck out 8 to lead the Curve to a 6-0 win. **Connor Scott** smacked a 2-run homer and **Jacob Gonzalez** added two runs batted in.

**BUBBA'S BURGERS:** Right-hander **Bubba Chandler** electrified in his Double-A debut on Friday, September 9 against Harrisburg. Chandler retired 13 straight batters to begin his Curve career allowing just a bloop single in 5.0 innings. Chandler struck out 8 on 69 pitches, 51 strikes. In his last 9 starts between Greensboro and Altoona he's gone 7-1 with a 1.66 ERA (9 ER / 48.2 IP), with just 27 hits, 13 walks and 51 strikeouts. He and **Anthony Solometo** are 2 of the 13 pitchers to reach Double-A at age 20-or-younger. The Pirates and Arizona Diamondbacks (Hansel Rincon and Yu-Min Lin) are the only teams to have 2 pitchers age 20-or-younger to reach Double-A.

**NOTHING SULLEN:** Righty **Sean Sullivan** has been one of Altoona's rocks in the rotation this season and he turned in another brilliant performance on Thursday, September 7 against Harrisburg with a season-high 9 strikeouts in 7.0 innings. Sullivan allowed just four singles and an error behind him led to a run in the sixth inning as he cruised through the evening on just 83 pitches. Sullivan has a 5-0 record with a 2.95 ERA (13 ER / 39.2 IP) in his last 7 appearances, 5 starts. In that time he's struck out 34 batters and walked just 11 while holding opponents to a .234 average against. Sullivan has his name all over the Eastern League leaderboards this season: 6th in ERA (3.98), 10th in IP (108.2), and 6th in WHIP (1.27).

**THE YOUNG LEFTY:** **Anthony Solometo** is the youngest pitcher to reach the Eastern League this season, doing so at 20 years, 6 months and 15 days when he made his debut on June 17 at Somerset. **Solometo** is the 13th player in franchise history to suit up for the Curve under the age of 21 and slots in as the 5th-youngest player in the team's history between **C Ryan Doumit**, who was 20 years, 4 months, 0 days old when he debuted on August 3, 2001, and **LHP Sean Burnett**, who was 20 years, 6 months, 18 days old when he debuted on April 4, 2003.

Solometo has thrown the second-most innings by a pitcher age-20 or younger at the Double-A level this season (50.1) and has walked just 6.5% of batters he's faced. He is one of 13 pitchers to reach Double-A at age 20 or younger this season.

**STREAKING:** Altoona owns the two longest hitting streaks in the Eastern League this season with **Tsung-Che Cheng's** 17-game streak in late-July/early-August and **Matt Fraizer's** 17-game streak which came to an end on Thursday, September 7. Fraizer also reached base safely in 18 straight games in which he batted: .342/.377/.507 with 2 2B, 2 3B, 2 HR and 10 RBI. Fraizer's 107 hits rank 5th in the Eastern League and his 61 runs scored rank T-11th in the Eastern League.

**GET SHORTY:** Righty **Aaron Shortridge** has turned in his best work of the season in the month of August, Shortridge earned a win in all 5 of his starts and recorded a 1.91 ERA (8 ER / 33.0 IP) with just 7 walks and 24 strikeouts. 9 times this season, Shortridge has turned in a quality start. In the month of August, the 26-year-old ranked: 4th in ERA (1.91), 1st in W (5), 1st in IP (33.0), and T-8th in WHIP (1.09). Overall on the season he ranks 1st in the Eastern League with 25 starts, T-1st with 10 wins, and 2nd with 130.0 IP.

**NOT YOUR AVERAGE JOE:** Signed as a minor league free agent on August 10 after six seasons in the Astros system, utility man **Joe Perez** has reached base safely in each of his 23 games played with Altoona, batting .329/.465/.633/1.098 with 3 2B, 7 HR, 17 RBI, and 24 K's. Twice in a Curve uniform he's homered in back-to-back games. His 1.098 OPS is 7th-best among Double-A players since his debut on August 12.

**STRIKEOUTS ARE ALL THE RAGE:** Throughout the 2023 season, Altoona has been one of the league's most-difficult teams to strike out. Entering play on Saturday, September 9, Altoona has struck out 1,049 times, the fewest among Double-A teams and 5th-fewest in minor league baseball. Altoona's was the last Double-A team to reach 1000 strikeouts this season.

**THE MEN FROM THE UPPER CHAMBER:** Managed by Delino DeShields, Harrisburg features the next wave of Nationals stars highlighted by outfielders Robert Hassell III, James Wood and Dylan Crews. Crews and **Paul Skenes** were the first collegiate teammates ever to be selected No. 1 and No. 2 in the draft when they went to start the 2023 draft.

**THE FIRST TO FILIBUSTER:** Michael Cuevas takes the ball on Saturday night. A 22-year-old from San Antonio, TX, Cuevas was Washington's 23rd round pick in 2019 out of Brennan HS. Cuevas makes his 22nd start tonight and has gone 3-7 with a 5.36 ERA. Cuevas works with a low-90's fastball and a good slider and changeup to keep hitters off-balance.

**2023:** Named to Altoona's Opening Day roster, pitched in relief for the first time in his career against New Hampshire on April 6... Went 2-1 with a 3.26 ERA (7 ER / 19.1 IP) in 4 April starts, picked up 14 strikeouts against just 4 walks... Matched his career-high with 7 runs allowed on 5/24 vs. Hartford... Shaved his head on 5/31 in solidarity with cancer survivors at Altoona's Game of Hope... Allowed a career-high 12 hits on 6/25 vs. Bowie... Matched career-high with 9 strikeouts on 7/2 at Harrisburg... Allowed just 1 baserunner in his final 6.0 innings on 7/7 vs. Erie, first Curve starter to finish 7.0 innings since Sean Sullivan on 5/23 vs. Hartford... Allowed a career-high 3 HR on 7/19 vs. Reading and 7/25 at Harrisburg... Matched his career-high with 9 strikeouts on 8/5 vs. Richmond... Tossed his second career complete game on 8/11 vs. Erie, first for ALT since 8/26/19 when Domingo Robles went the distance against Akron... Earned his 10th win of the season with 7.0 IP of 3-run ball at Erie on 8/29, became the first Curve pitcher to win 10 games in a season since Tanner Anderson and Alex McRae in 2017... Turned in the best month of his career in August tossing a career-best 33.0 IP and 5 W with 28 K's... His 1.91 ERA in the calendar month is 2nd among Eastern League pitchers with at least 25.0 IP thrown... Eastern League ranks: T-1st in W (10), T-1st GS (25), 2nd in IP (130.0)...

**2022:** Began season on Altoona's 60-Day IL (Elbow)... Began Rehab assignment with Bradenton on June 7 and made three starts totaling 9.0 innings of one-run ball... Activated to Curve roster on 6/21... Allowed 2 HR in a start twice with Altoona (6/24 @ NH and 7/27 @ BOW)... Finished 5.0 innings for the first time post-TJ Surgery on 8/13 at Binghamton...
