### FRES-NOTES

**GRIZZLIES DROP SERIES TO QUAKES:** The Fresno Grizzlies (17-24, 55-51) were bested by the Rancho Cucamonga Quakes (26-15, 56-49) 8-2 Saturday night from LoanMart Field. The Grizzlies dropped the series to the Quakes, their fifth straight road set without emerging victorious, dating back to June 4-9 at Modesto. Fresno fell to 4-13 all-time at LoanMart Field and for the third consecutive year, cannot win more than two contests in Rancho Cucamonga. The Grizzlies second half road woes continued, plummeting to a 7-19 record (23-11 in the first half). The Grizzlies currently sit six games back of the San Jose Giants in the California League North Division second half standings. Rancho Cucamonga right fielder Jose Meza continued his torrid series with his best game yet. Meza powered a pair of walkoffs, his second time completing that feat this week. He launched a two-run homer in the second, following up with a solo shot in the fourth. He finished his unreal performance with a bases-clearing triple in a four-run fifth. Overall, Meza went 3-for-5 with a trio of extra base hits, six RBI and three runs scored. Over four games, Meza is 7-for-15 (.467 AVG/.500 OBP/1.467 SLG/1.967 OPS) with four clouts, one triple, one double, 11 RBI and six runs. The Grizzlies lineup tallied just two runs on eight hits with seven different starters picking up at least one knock. Tevin Tucker led the charge with a monster mash to left-center field in the top of the third. It was Tucker's third longball of the 2024 campaign. Jason Hinchman boasted a multi-hit contest, yielding a run from a Braylen Wimmer RBI single. Fresno righty Bryan Mena (0-1) suffered the setback after four innings of work. Mena was tagged for a quartet of runs (earned), on five hits and a career-high four walks, fanning a pair. He succumbed to three tatters, the most by a Grizzlies pitcher this season. Jake Madden (1.1 IP), Yanzel Correa (1.0 IP) and Tyler Hoffman (1.0 IP) all tossed scoreless appearances. Correa, in his Grizzlies debut, slithered his way through a game, seizing one strikeout. Hoffman punched out one batter and issued a double play.

**TIME TO SHAKE THE QUAKES:** The Fresno Grizzlies and Rancho Cucamonga Quakes (Los Angeles Dodgers Single-A affiliate) conclude their six-game series tonight at LoanMart Field. This is the second of two 2024 regular season series between the clubs and the only meeting in Rancho Cucamonga. The Quakes started playing in Rancho Cucamonga in 1993 after relocating from San Bernardino. The team moved into the "Epicenter" on April 1, 1993. The Quakes played their first game at the stadium on April 8th against the High Desert Mavericks, winning 7-3. The Quakes continued to play their home games at the stadium, now renamed LoanMart Field. After being an affiliate of the San Diego Padres for the first eight years in Rancho Cucamonga, the team swapped affiliations with the Lake Elsinore Storm, beginning in the 2001 season. For the next 10 seasons, the Quakes were affiliated with the Los Angeles Angels. After that season, the Quakes once again changed affiliations, joining the Dodgers' system. They have been associated with the Dodgers since 2011, where many Dodgers stars go for rehab assignments.

**PACHECO PITCHES:** Tonight, the Grizzlies give the rock to LHP Albert Pacheco. Last year, Pacheco was assigned to Fresno from the ACL Rockies on June 7 and spent his entire season with the Grizzlies. Pacheco made 14 starts, going 7-4 with a 5.45 ERA. Over 72.2 innings, he struck out 69 batters. The 21-year-old signed as an international free agent by the Rockies in 2019.

**HERE COME THE 2024 DRAFT PICKS:** The Grizzlies have added four 2024 Rockies' Draft Picks to their roster. 2nd-rounder OF Jared Thomas (Texas), 6th-rounder LHP Konner Eaton (George Mason), 7th-rounder RHP Fidel Ulloa (LSU) and 13th-rounder LHP Justin Loer (LSU).

**CALAZ JOINS THE GRIZZLIES:** Rockies #11 overall prospect Robert Calaz has been assigned to the Grizzlies as of August 2. The Dominican outfielder has dominated in his two years since signing as an International Free Agent on January 15, 2023 for \$1.7 million (17 years old at the time). Calaz, who is now 18, is coming off a MVP season down with the ACL Rockies, where he led the league in Triple Crown categories (HR, AVG, RBI). Before joining Fresno, Calaz led the ACL in seven different statistical categories over 49 games: batting average (.349), homers (10), RBI (45), OBP (.462), slugging percentage (.651), OPS (1.113) and total bases (112). Calaz has been compared to former Grizzlies' OF Yanquiel Fernandez. Welcome to Growlifornia Robert Calaz!

**ANDY IS DANDY:** Grizzlies' INF Andy Perez ranks among the Top 10 in eight different California League categories. Perez ranks first in hits (120), first in total bases (183), tied for first in triples (7), second in extra-base hits (38), third in RBI (62), fourth in batting average (.289), tied for fourth in doubles (22) and tenth in slugging percentage (.441).

**ANDY PEREZ CLIMBS THE GRIZZLIES CAREER RECORD BOOKS:** Grizzlies' INF Andy Perez logged his 14th career triple August 4 vs. Lake Elsinore. He is now tied with Jason Ellison and Clay Timpner for seventh all-time in Grizzlies Career Triples. Up next for Perez is Jalal Leach, who is sixth all-time with 15 triples.

**MORE RECORDS FOR ANDY PEREZ:** Andy Perez's triple on August 4 vs. Lake Elsinore was his seventh triple of 2024, putting him into the Grizzlies Top 10 Single-Season Record Books AGAIN. Perez tied himself (2023), Preston Tucker (2017), Nate Schierholtz (2007), Jason Ellison (2004) and Calvin Murray (1999), who each recorded seven triples in their respective seasons. The Cuban native became the second Grizzlies player (Nate Schierholtz, 2007-08) to join the Grizzlies Top 10 Single-Season Triples list twice. Up next for Perez are Ben Copeland (2010) and Andrew Stevenson (2019), who are tied for eighth all-time with eight triples.

**TEN OUT OF TEN(A) FOR TRIPLES:** Grizzlies' OF Felix Tena is one triple shy of joining the Grizzlies Record Books in Top 10 Single-Season Triples. Tena looks to catch fellow teammate Andy Perez (2023 and 2024), as well as Preston Tucker (2017), Nate Schierholtz (2007), Jason Ellison (2004) and Calvin Murray (1999), who each recorded seven triples in their respective seasons.

**NEW MAN AT THE TOP OF THE LINEUP:** Grizzlies' OF Caleb Hobson has relished his role as the team's leadoff hitter. When Hobson has been plugged into the leadoff spot, he has reached base 69 times in 184 plate appearances (39 games; 38% he is reaching base in the leadoff spot). In 11 of those 39 games, Hobson has made it on base three or more times, combining to score 33 runs. Part of Hobson's success is in his first plate appearance of the game, where he is 9-for-31 (.290) with a double, seven walks and one hit-by-pitch (7-for-39, 44% of the time he reaches base in first plate appearance). Eight of his nine hits have been singles with three of them landing as bunt singles. Hobson has also swiped 18 total bags as a leadoff hitter, picking up two stolen bases in five of those leadoff games (32/38 in stolen bases on the season).

**RUNNING CLOSER TO THE RECORD BOOKS:** Grizzlies' OF Caleb Hobson has swiped 32 bases this season. Hobson is currently three stolen bases shy of joining the Grizzlies Top 10 Single-Season Records in that category. Tyler Graham (2010), Darren Ford (2014), Jonathan Villar (2015) and Myles Straw (2018) are tied for ninth all-time with 35 stolen bases.
