LAST TIME OUT

Moosic, PA (May 2, 2023) - The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders topped the Rochester Red Wings 3-1 on Tuesday night. It was a fantastic opener for the RailRiders with both hitting and pitching clicking. Kole Calhoun had a two-hit night in his first game in an SWB uniform.

The RailRiders got on the board first. Ben Rortvedt, on Major League rehab, singled to reach, but was replaced by Elijah Dunham in a fielder's choice. Andres Chaparro tripled to plate Dunham. Calhoun followed with his first hit to drive home Chaparro for a 2-0 lead.

Rochester cut the lead in half with a run in the second. Travis Blakenhorn doubled to reach and came home on Kevin Plawewski's two-bagger.

SWB added an insurance run in the eighth. Dunham singled and stole his fifth base of the season. Again, Calhoun sent in a run with his RBI double for a 3-1 advantage.

Tanner Tully (W, 2-1) got the start going 5.1 innings. The southpaw let up just one run on six hits. Aaron McGarity was able to get out of the sixth clean and tossed a quiet seventh. Colten Brewer threw his first frame with the RailRiders putting up a zero. Matt Bowman (S, 1) slammed the door shut for a 1-2-3 save.

Joan Adon (L, 1-3) tossed six frames out of the gate. He let up two runs on six hits. Gerson Moreno faced the minimum in the seventh. Jose Ferrer gave up one run in his inning of work on a pair of hits.

NEWS & NOTES

BY THE NUMBERS - Scranton/Wilkes-Barre is 1-0 in the month of May! Last night, the RailRiders played their shortest game of the season in two hours and six minutes. Prior to that the quickest contest was on April 13 at home versus Syracuse that was played in 2:10. SWB's best day of the week is Tuesday with three wins. They have a better record when playing at night than during the day. Yesterday, the team recorded just its second victory without hitting a home run. The RailRiders have four wins now on the first game of the series, compared to just one in the final game of the week.

YOU GET A SAVE, YOU GET A SAVE - Across the pitching staff, five different pitchers have recorded saves this season. Greg Weissert leads the team with four, despite some time on New York's roster. Nick Ramirez has three of his own and he is currently in the Yankees bullpen. James Norwood has two in four attempts. Matt Bowman and DJ Snelten each have a save of their own. With 11 saves as a team, the RailRiders are tied for first alongside the Norfolk Tides for most saves in all of Minor League Baseball. Each team in any league has at least one, but many have only one on the season.

FIELDING FAUX PAS - The RailRiders recorded an error in Tuesday's contest to total 36 on the season. Reliever Colten Brewer made a throwing miscue in his first outing of the season. The RailRiders have played nine total errorless game last night. Earlier this summer they did have a five miscue game. Andres Chaparro has eight total. Rochester has made 14 errors during the summer, while the Frisco RoughRiders have the fewest with nine miscues.

CALHOUN CAN HIT - Veteran outfielder Kole Calhoun was added to the RailRiders roster yesterday, getting the call up from the Florida Complex League. Calhoun was signed by New York on April 20th after spending Spring Training with Seattle. He had two hits and two RBIs in the contest last night that helped SWB win. He also made good plays in the field, including an outfield assist to nab a runner at home. Calhoun was drafted and spent the majority of his Major League career (2012-2019) with the Los Angeles Angels. He then played for the Diamondbacks and the Rangers.

AARON AMAZES - Reliever Aaron McGarity tossed another clean outing of 1.2 innings yesterday. He took on a runner at third and the defense was able to nab him at the plate. McGarity has inherited eight runners this season and has only allowed one of them to score. The righty has lowered his ERA to 1.80 in fifteen innings of work. He has let up just five walks to 22 strikeouts. McGarity, 28, was a 15th round pick back in 2017.

THIEFS, ALL OF THEM - The RailRiders have totaled 35 stole bases this season, getting caught just 8 times. Twelve different players have a least one swipe this summer. Estevan Florial leads the way with seven total, while Elijah Dunham has five. Last night, Jamie Westbrook was very excited to steal his first.

TRES THREES - Andres Chaparro recorded his first triple of 2023 last night. He is just the third RailRider to notch a three-bagger this season. Jake Bauers had the first and Estevan Florial has one as well.

ATOP THE YANKS FARM - The RailRiders will showcase top prospect Elijah Dunham (#18 per MLB prospect rankings in the Yankees system) in his first Triple-A season. Randy Vasquez (#14) and Sean Boyle (#29) are both set to be essential parts of the starting rotation after also making their debuts with Scranton/Wilkes-Barre.

PRESEASON PROSPECT RANKINGS: *MLB Pipeline* - NYY No. 20; *Fangraphs* - NYY No. 21; *Baseball America* - NYY No. 12

SHIPPED OUT, SHIPPED IN: The Yankees traded Ken Waldichuk, JP Sears and Hayden Wesneski prior to the 2022 trade deadline, all SWB pitchers. When Sears was traded he was slated to pitch on August 2 for the RailRiders. With those moves, Mitch Spence was called up from Somerset (Double-A) to make his Triple-A debut.

DAY GAME EXPERIENCE: Mitch Spence threw five games during the day last season. His record is 1-1 with a 6.49 ERA in 18.2 innings. He's allowed three home runs. In games beginning before 5PM, he has had 13 walks and 15 strikeouts.

CHANGE IT UP, LITERALLY: At USC-Aiken, Spence only threw a fastball and a slider. He now throws five pitches after spending over three years in the system (view repertoire right). He says he feels "like (he's) completely changed what kind of pitcher (he is)."

2023 HIGHLIGHTS: Pitched a Sunday Day game, Took game one of the doubleheader

PERSONAL/CAREER:

- 2022: Combined with Double-A Somerset and Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre to go 6-7 with a 4.70 ERA (130.1IP, 138H, 73R/68ER, 42BB, 127K, 17HR) in 27 games (25 starts)...ranked among Yankees farmhands in games started (tied for third) and strikeouts (sixth)
- Became a starter in 2021, spending the entire season in Hudson Valley and posting a 3-4 record and 5.29 ERA over 23 appearances. His 20 starts, 105 IP and 118 K led the Renegades.
- Worked solely as a reliever in 2019 with Pulaski, making 16 appearances out of the bullpen, tying for 2nd on the team, going 3-2 with a 3.54 ERA, 4 saves and 29 K over 28.0 IP.
- Attended the University of South Carolina-Aiken, where he started out as solely a reliever with all 16 of appearances coming out of the bullpen as a freshman in 2017. After posting a 7.56 ERA that year, Spence became a starter for the final two seasons (2018-19) of his college career, starting 28/31 appearances. He set career-best college marks as a sophomore with a 3.03 ERA and 117 strikeouts.
- Born in Kirkland, WA, claims Cary, NC as his hometown.
- Attended Green Hope High School in Cary, where he became the school's all-time leader in ERA and saves.
- Avid Carolina Hurricanes fan. Grew up a Seattle Mariners and Seahawks fan, Ken Griffey Jr. his favorite player.

ATOP THE FARM: Sean Boyle stacks up well against the other pitchers in the Yankees Minor League system. Last season, he recorded the most games started (27), most wins (13), most innings (155.1), and most strikeouts (160) among the farm system.

PUZZLER PITCHER: Last season, Boyle brought back an old trend of solving a Rubik's Cube. After getting his teammates invested in Somerset, he brought one to the Major League clubhouse at Spring Training this season. It's become a go to distraction and a competitive outlet. His record solve time is 32 seconds, but he likes to practice before every start.

QUALITY & QUANTITY: Boyle's final ten games in Double-A (2022) were quality starts. Across the three starts prior to the streak, Boyle allowed 21 R (19 ER) over 13.1 IP, equaling an ERA of 12.83. In Boyle's first start vs. Binghamton (5/30), he allowed a career-high 10 runs. In his last non-quality start before the streak vs. the Rumble Ponies on 6/5 he gave up three home runs in the first three innings of the game, before proceeding to retire the final 7 batters he faced to earn his 2nd win of the season.

BOYLE'S NO-NO DUO: In his third career Triple-A start, Boyle threw a seven-inning no-hit against the Worcester Red Sox on August 19, 2021. It was the first no-hitter in the history of Polar Park. Max McDowell was behind the plate that night. Boyle was part of another no-hitter, tossing four no-hit innings in a combined no-no on July 10, 2021 with Hudson Valley (A+) against the Brooklyn Cyclones.

- Did not start playing baseball until he reached the 10th grade
- Pitched a no-hitter in the Blue Chips Prospects 18U Northeast Elite Tournament in high school
